## Australian star dies in Israeli bridge collapse

Some of you may have read of the bridge collapse that occurred in Israel a week ago as competitors in the Maccabiah Games marched across. When the bridge collapsed, approximately 400 members of the Australian team were making the crossing as part of the opening ceremony, and they all fell into the river.

The fall was not a long one -- only seven were injured seriously enough to be hospitalized.

One of these was Elizabeth Sawicki, 47, of

## Morris Portugal

Morris (Port) Portugal, 81, #48 on the list of all-time masterpoint winners, died of a heart attack July 19 in Los Angeles. The funeral services took place last Wednesday.

After suffering a heart attack at the Las Vegas Regional last year, Port limited his bridge playing to local clubs. His lifetime masterpoint total was 15,539.

He and his wife Helen, who died in 1986, were frequent winners in North American events in the Fifties and Sixties. Port's NABC titles included Mixed Pairs 1953, Mixed Teams 1954 and Life Master Pairs 1960. He also had seconds in the 1947 Men's Pairs, 1964 Vanderbilt Teams and 1965 Mixed Pairs. He won hundreds of regionally-rated events.

Port was a professional bridge player and teacher. He was a member of the ACBL Goodwill Committee. He also was active in unit affairs.

## Florida wins GNT-A

A District 9 team from Florida whose members have a long history with the Grand National Teams took an early lead and held on for a 22-IMP victory in the GNT, Flight A, over a determined squad from District 10. The final score was 115-93.

The winners are Jeff Wolfson, Northbrook IL; Robert Levin, Orlando; Jeff Meckstroth, Tampa; Neil Silverman and Richard Pavlicek, Fort Lauderdale, and Michael Seamon, Miami Beach.

District 10 was represented by Hjordis Eythorsdottir and Curtis Cheek, Huntsville AL; Steve Beatty, Destrehan LA, and John Onstott, New Orleans.

Pavlicek was a member of the winning team in 1973, the first time the event was played. One of his teammates was William (Billy) Seamon, Michael's father. Pavlicek and Michael were partners in the 1997 contest.

Meckstroth, representing District 11, won the GNT-A in 1990 and was second in 1994. Wolfson,

Three young bridge players were welcomed into the Junior Corps, one of several celebrations at a reception honoring ACBL's young players.

The new members are Mark Benford of District 16, Tara Gokavi of District 18 and Ari Greenberg District 23.

Benford, 25, is a contract employee for Shell Services Co. in Houston. He has been playing duplicate bridge about four years.

Gokavi, 16, will be a junior in high school in Saskatoon SK in the fall. Until last spring, she had the distinction of being Canada's youngest Life Master, having earned her gold card at the age of 14 years, seven months and seven days. She is a former winner of the Homer Shoop Award.

Greenberg, 16, won the Homer Shoop

## Meckstroth, Rodwell receive reprimand

The ACBL Appeals and Charges Committee met Monday, July 21, to consider several procedural violations allegedly committed by Jeff Meckstroth and Eric Rodwell at the 1997 ITT.

The committee, after a full and fair hearing, determined (1) that Jeff Meckstroth is guilty of looking in an opponent's hand after becoming dummy, and (2) that both Jeff Meckstroth and Eric Rodwell are guilty of being together in a restroom without an escort while a hand is in progress.

On Board 86 of the match between the Nickell and Katz teams, Meckstroth and Rodwell were alone in the Men's Room after Meckstroth had seen a defender's hand and before Rodwell had begun to play the hand.

The committee imposed a discipline of issuing a reprimand which will be made public, but will not be made a matter of record on either player's disciplinary file. There is no allegation that either player actually spoke to the other, or that Rodwell gained any advantage in the play of the hand.

The committee did not receive any evidence that the violations were motivated by improper reasons and both players apologized for having created the situation which gave rise to the charges. The committee believes that ACBL should be more diligent in conducting this type of event to ensure that players follow established laws and regulations.

## Jerry Machlin

Jerry Machlin of Silver Spring MD, one of the all-time greats among tournament directors, died of kidney failure on July 2 at the age of 84.

Machlin was one of the grandest of the grand old-time tournament directors. He followed in the steps of his Uncle Al --- Al Sobel --- and eventually became the ACBL's chief director, just as Sobel had been for so many years. He began working at tournaments in the Forties at the insistence of Sobel, became a full-time director in 1950 and retired in 1979.

Machlin was as well known for his humor as for his directing expertise. His special *30 Days* and *60 Days* articles in the *Washington Bridge League Bulletin* are classics --- many people subscribed to this magazine just to see what Machlin had to say. He finally put all his stories together in one of the funniest bridge books ever compiled --- *Tournament Bridge: An Uncensored Memoir*.

In his later years he served as treasurer and tournament coordinator for the Mid-Atlantic Conference --- mostly Districts 6 and 7. He originated the newsletters put out by those two districts.

After his retirement, Machlin became a player --- and many of his best stories concern his success --- or lack thereof --- at the table. He delighted in telling of his misadventures.

Throughout his bridge career, his wife Trudy was always at his side. She worked alongside him as a tournament director and took over the District 6 and 7 work when Machlin could no longer handle it.

As one who did his tournament directing in the Machlin era, I can say that working with Jerry was interesting and exciting. I had some of my best times when working two-man tournaments with him. I, along with thousands of bridge players and dozens of directors, will sorely miss him.

## Braunstein calls an end to directing career

**M**aury Braunstein, top-rated tournament director in the ACBL and the World Bridge Federation for many years, ended his directing career right where he started -- in Schenectady NY, his home town.

On June 29, the final day of the recent Schenectady sectional, Braunstein announced that it was his last day as a tournament director.

Braunstein began his bridge career as a player --- and he was a good one back in the Fifties. But when he tried directing in 1954, he discovered he was in his element. He advanced to national director in 1968 after retiring from his work with the state of New York. He was in charge of all nationally rated events at NABCs from 1973 to 1990.

He made his debut as a WBF director in 1972 and a year later was the chief director at the Bermuda Bowl in Guarujá, Brazil. From that point through 1988 he was either chief director or assistant chief director at all world championships.

Braunstein was an expert on movements. He developed the Stanza Movement whereby directors could score the first half of a multi-section grouping while the competitors were playing the second half. That resulted in getting scores out to the players within a reasonable time frame. Once computers came on the scene, this special movement was no longer needed. He also developed several other game movements, notably for individual events.

The bow tie became Braunstein's trademark. He was never seen at a tournament without one. As a result, everyone attending his goodbye party in Schenectady on Aug. 17 is expected to wear a bow tie.

Braunstein also was famous for his quick wit. Perhaps the most outstanding example was the way he handled a situation where two priests were playing too slowly at table 7. Braunstein went to the table and said, "Our fathers, who are at seven, hurried be thy game." This really did happen -- it is not apocryphal.

When asked about his favorite memory, Braunstein was quick to respond, "Harry Goldwater! What a man! He never was anything but a pleasure. He was always a friend. And his stories! I could listen to his stories for hours."

Braunstein also remembered many tournaments he and I worked together -- there must have been at least 500.

One time, Braunstein walked into the lobby of a hotel at a Central Massachusetts sectional -- and I told him to stop right there. "You're standing in the primary playing area," I told him. "The secondary area was the corridor to the rooms," he remembers, "and the third was a concrete cell under the lobby. Those were the days."

Braunstein's main territory was New York and New England, although he also had frequent assignments to eastern Canada. He also was a personal favorite in Bermuda. The Bermudians thought so much of Maury that they brought him to the Islands annually for their tiny sectional.

Maury remembers the time that a major hurricane swept across Bermuda, bringing devastating winds and torrential rains. This occurred just as the annual sectional was about to start. Just hours after the hurricane passed, Maury waded -- yes, waded -- to the bridge clubhouse and got things ready for the tournament. Of course he knew nobody would be there, but he was going to be ready, just in case.

Well, as you know, nothing stops a bridge player who wants to play bridge. At game time 36 players sat down to play. Every one of them got to the game either by wading or by boat.

All of us looked forward to the post-game parties in Maury's room where we talked about rulings and traded stories.

## Colorado quartet wins NLM Swiss

What a surprise! Four players trooped into the Daily Bulletin office, announcing they had won the Non Life Master Swiss Teams, a nationally-rated event. This event was supposed to conclude on Sunday, but the winners arrived a day early!

What happened? Only 14 teams signed up, so the event was cut to one day. After eight matches, the winners were Paul Perkowski, Denis Murphy, Bonnie Bagley and John Ledet, all of Colorado Springs. The victory was particularly poignant for Bagley -- she earned enough masterpoints to go over the top as a Life Master.

They had to come from behind -- at the halfway mark they were tied for fifth. But they won 62 out of a possible 80 Victory Points in the evening to cement their title. They had to win their last match by at least 3 to clinch the crown, and that's exactly what they won by. Their record showed five wins, two losses and a tie.

Their 109 points gave them a 4-point edge over runners-up Peter Grenier, Dallas; Frank Bischoff, Wheeling IL; Lynn Wood, Richardson TX, and Wanda Blankenship, Carrollton TX.

Only two points further back in third place were Albert Busch, Espanola NM, and Lloyd Smith, Binging Su and Danan Fan, Los Alamos NM.

Perkowski, a satellite systems engineer, was partnered by Ledet, an engineering manager. Bagley, a homemaker, played with Murphy, a Canadian Air Force officer assigned to NORAD at Colorado Springs.

## Stealth virus research receives Charity grant

The ACBL Charity Foundation has awarded a \$5000 grant to help fund research into the causes and treatment of so-called stealth viruses, believed to be the cause of a variety of chronic illnesses.

The grant was made to the Stealth Virus Trust Account, part of Public Health Foundation Enterprises Inc., of City of Industry CA.

The grant was awarded to Dr. John Martin in honor of Chris Hasney, a Sierra Vista AZ man who suffers from chronic fatigue immune dysfunction syndrome, believed to be a stealth virus disease.

Martin is the founder of the Center for Complex Infectious Diseases.

In his application, Martin said stealth viruses may be responsible for such conditions as autism, attention deficit disorder, chronic fatigue syndrome, fibromyalgia, depression in young adults and dementia in the elderly.

The foundation's officers are Carol Sanders, president; Jim Zimmerman, vice president; Virgil V. Anderson Jr., Joan DeWitt McKean and Glenn Smith. Don Moeller is secretary-treasurer.

Award (a college scholarship) three years ago. The Malibu CA resident will also be a junior in high school this fall.

Another highlight of the reception was the introduction of Toronto's Gavin Wolpert, who succeeded Gokavi as Canada's youngest Life Master. He earned his gold card this spring at the age of 14 years, six months and 19 days.

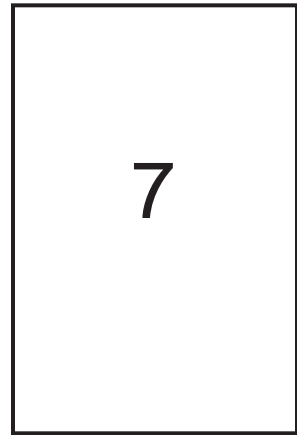
Jonathan Steinberg, who represents District 2 on the ACBL Board of Directors, introduced Wolpert and could not resist telling a story about the youngster.

At the Summer NABC in 1993, Steinberg recalled, Gavin was there with his brother Darren, a successful player, and their parents, Hazel and Meyer. "Gavin said he was never going to play bridge," said Steinberg. "I guess he changed his mind."

ACBL President Howard Piltsch, addressing the gathering, told the young players about the organization's plans for marketing bridge. "We have two major target groups," Piltsch said. "those 50 and over and youths aged 10 to 11."

Piltsch said he hopes that one day a member of the group he was speaking to could be bridge's Tiger Woods, a reference to the 21-year-old golfing phenom.

Piltsch said young people figure prominently in ACBL's plans for the future. "We lost the last two generations of bridge players," he said. "We hope and expect not to lose this one. We want to give you the impetus to

say to people that you love bridge."

In his parting comment to the youngsters, Piltsch said, "I hope you learn to love bridge one-tenth as much as I do, and if you make as many friends as I have through bridge, you'll be very blessed."

Aileen Osofsky, emcee for the reception, recognized Lisa Kow, 19, for her plans to start a bridge class for the caddies on Monday. Kow, an ACBL-accredited teacher, has been teaching bridge at the University of California at Davis for some time -- and she has four classes scheduled for the fall.

A few of the young players at the reception reported on the Junior Bridge Camp in Italy that concluded only days ago.

Kow, who was in Italy, praised the ACBL Board for funding the bridge camp. "It gives people a great incentive to encourage bridge," she said.

Another bridge camp attendee, Joel Wooldridge of Williamsville NY, said the event was "an excellent mix of bridge play and social atmosphere."

Jade Barrett, whose Team Havoc organization in Vancouver WA has funded some Junior activities, encouraged the youngsters to help foster "more of an atmosphere for bridge development" with their actions and demeanor.

Charlotte Blaiss, who handles Junior affairs for the ACBL Education Department, said the program is thriving at present with approximately 1700 members.

Many of the Juniors, Blaiss said, are teaching bridge in their high schools and colleges and generally spreading the word about the game.

The School Bridge Lesson Series is at an all-time high, Blaiss said, with more than 175 schools scheduling lessons so far this year -- more than twice as many as last year. That represents more than 5000 students in elementary and high schools signed up

for bridge lessons.

Since its inception in 1989, the School Bridge Lesson Series has graduated tens of thousands of youngsters from ACBL beginning bridge classes.

The program has been more successful than anyone dreamed, Blaiss said. "The schools are now approaching us."

Melbourne, a member of the bridge team. She appeared to be doing well -- she was writing notes telling how badly she wanted to get out of the hospital and into the bridge game. She was writing because couldn't talk -- there were tubes in her mouth.

Two days ago her bodily functions just stopped. Despite all efforts of the physicians there, she died shortly afterwards. She had swallowed a good deal of the contaminated water from the river and apparently was fatally poisoned. She never recovered from the respiratory problems caused by the contaminated water. Two other members of the Australian contingent -- ten-pin bowlers -- also died.

Arrangements were made for shipping her body back to Melbourne. The funeral will take place tomorrow in Melbourne.

Bob Richman, an American who has moved to Australia, was with the Australian team. He then came here for the championships. However, as soon as he learned of Sawicki's death, he took off for Australia.

Elizabet, as she was known on OKbridge, was well-known to North American players who compete on the Internet. Karen McCallum of Exeter NH remembers her especially well -- Elizabet was one person who could penetrate Karen's serious attitude.

"She made me relax and laugh," said Karen. "You couldn't be around her and be serious. She livened every encounter."

Karen remembered a hilarious occurrence during the Chevron Pairs while she was in Australia. It's an unusual tournament -- one session a day at the table, the other session in the surf. You can come in and play any time, and it's best if you have a bottle of champagne with you.

One session was special -- the unusual condition was that you had to play with whomever you slept with the night before. Elizabet showed up with TWO men, both of whom were happily married and clearly NOT candidates for this event.

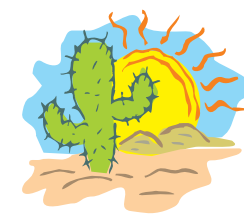

Richard opened 1NT as dealer and played it there. South led the ♠3 to the 4, 8 and 10. Seeking to pull the wool over the opponents' eyes, Kaye played the ♦8 at trick two, to the 3, jack and queen. North shot back a diamond to the 9 and South's king. Taken in, South abandoned diamonds and returned the ♠6 to the 2, 9 and jack.

Kaye then ran five rounds of hearts, discarding the ♠K from dummy on the last heart trick. South pitched the ♠Q early in the run of the hearts. North, feeling the pressure and thinking that South still had another spade, let go of the ♠A. Lo and behold, the ♠7 was good and Kaye had scored up plus 180 for making 10 tricks. That was good for 22 out of 25 matchpoints.

Dummy came down, and I could see we could make 10 or 11 tricks in hearts, but only eight tricks were visible in notrump.

East led the ♣5 to the 6, 10 and ace. I followed with the ♦9 -- the Curse of Scotland -- from my hand. It held the trick, as everyone ducked smoothly. Hmmm.

So I played another diamond to East's queen. Now came the belated spade switch to the queen and ace. Having figured out the layout of the diamond honors, I played ♥A, ♥K and a third heart to dummy, exiting with the ♦J to LHO, who now cashed the ♠K and conceded the rest for making four. Whew! Plus 430 was good for 21.5 out of 25 matchpoints.
