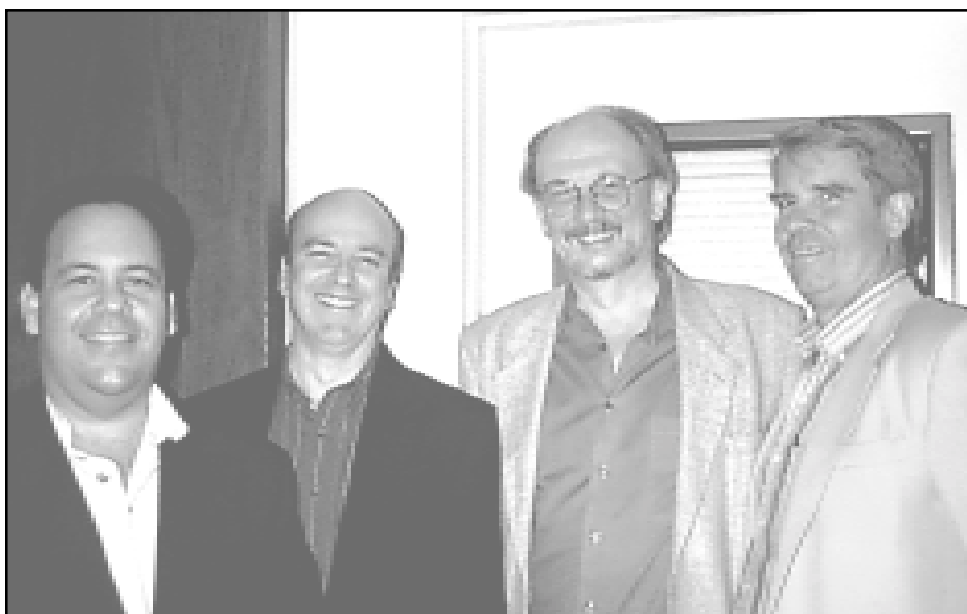

Silverman team strong in NA Swiss final

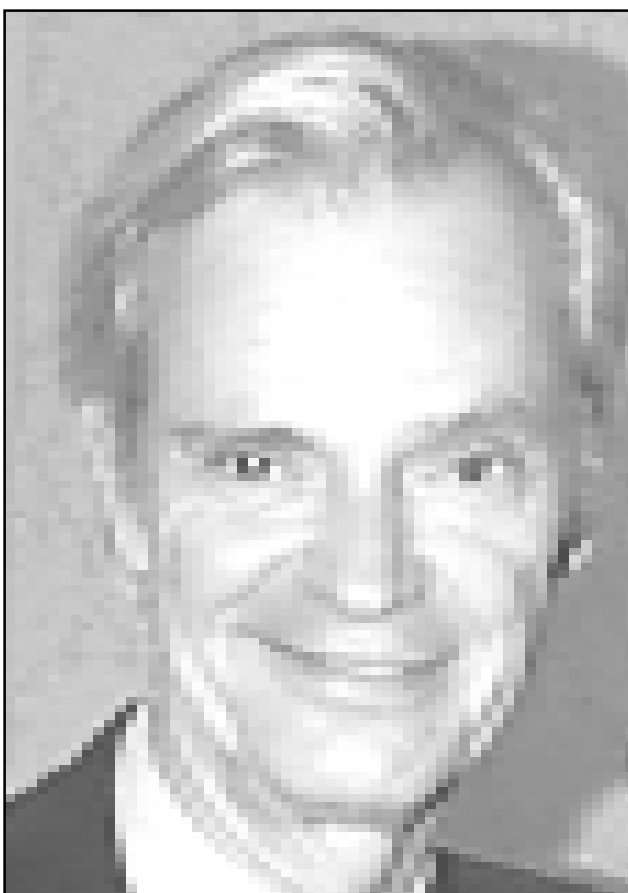
The team of Neil Silverman, Jeffrey Wolfson, David Berkowitz and Larry Cohen won the North American Open Swiss. The squad led throughout both sessions of the final, finishing with a score of 147.57 Victory Points.

Silverman of Fort Lauderdale and Wolfson of Chicago IL, are a longtime partnership, and are members of one of the two teams that will represent the United States in the 2000 Bermuda Bowl. Berkowitz and Cohen are the well-known pairs specialists who have scored many national wins, and were second in the World Open Pairs in Lille, France last year.

In second place with 119.95 VPs was the team of Brian Gunnell, Kyle Larsen, Billy Miller and Curtis Cheek. They were the only team to defeat the winners, but it was a narrow victory and not enough to position the Gunnell squad close enough to the Silverman team who scored several blitzes, including one in the final round.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR! John Mohan is the 1999 Player of the Year, the result of winning 832.78 platinum points at the three NABCs. Jeff Meckstroth was a fraction ahead of Sam Lev for second place, with Eric Rodwell fourth. They were the only four players to earn more than 700 platinum points in 1999.

Shugart dominates in repeat Reisinger win

The team of Rita Shugart, Andrew Robson, Tony Forrester and Geir Helgemo reprised their victory in last year's Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams by completely dominating the 1999 contest, posting a score of 40.05.

The squad led after the first final session by 5.5 points, and continued to pile on the pressure in the second session to win the contest by the amazing margin of 8.15 points. At various stages of the second final set, Shugart and her teammates even challenged the Reisinger record of 10 wins set in 1963 by Edgar Kaplan, Norman Kay, Robert Jordan and Arthur Robinson.

For Shugart of Pebble Beach CA, Robson of Carmel CA, Forrester of England and Helgemo of Norway, this is the second win in a major event at the Boston NABC. The foursome also won the Open Board-a-Match Teams.

District 7 Director Bruce Reeve presented the trophy to Shugart who thanked her teammates, "for their wonderful play."

In second place was the Italian team of non-playing captain Maria Teresa Lavazza, Norberto Bocchi, Giorgio Duboin, Dano DeFalco, Guido Ferraro with 31.90 points. This team, with the addition of Attanasio Failla, will represent Italy in the 2000 Bermuda Bowl.

The wildest hand

One of the most interesting hands to be seen on vugraph was Board 23 from the evening session of the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams.

The vugraph commentators were having a ball with this one. It appears that East-West can make a small slam in either major. But what about North-South? Where are the losers if N-S play in diamonds? The only loser is a heart -- 6♦ is cold. This is what happened when Augie Boehm and Richard Margolis held the N-S cards.

Making of course!

But let's look at the E-W slams again. It appears that 6♠ is fine as long as declarer doesn't cash the ♠K first. But what about 6♥? What if North leads a club to South's singleton ace, and South finds the spade switch? North can ruff, and if he leads a second club, South gets a ruff to inflict a two-trick defeat on a deal that looks like a slam.

The result on vugraph was as prosaic as the commentators were poetic. Both East-Wests got to 6♥, and neither N-S found the killing defense. Can you believe it? Just a push!

But at the other table in the match above, they followed the maximum line.

Drew Casen got off to the club lead, and Lee Rautenberg found the switch to the spade, which Casen ruffed. Casen in turn led a club that was ruffed, so that was a two-trick set. But it didn't matter -- the 1540 plus in the other room was sufficient for Boehm and Co. to win the board.
