## Shugart wins Open Board-a-Match

The multi-national squad captained by Rita Shugart posted a huge first final session to cruise to victory in the Open Board-a-Match Teams last night with a score of 41.52.

Shugart, of Pebble Beach CA, played with top internationalists Andrew Robson of England and Carmel CA, Tony Forrester of England and Geir Helgemo of Norway. The fearsome foursome are the defending Reisinger champions and have had several high finishes in recent NABC team events.

The team captained by Nick Nickell finished second with a score of 39.39. Nickell's perennial super-

power made a strong showing in the second final session, but were unable to catch the Shugart squad. Nickell's teammates were Richard Freeman, Jeff Meckstroth, Eric Rodwell, Bob Hamman and Paul Soloway. The Nickell team has been the bridesmaid twice in this event, finishing second in the last year's Open Board-a-Match in Orlando.

This is the second NABC victory for Shugart and partner Robson. For Forrester, this is the third NABC title. He and Helgemo won the 1998 Open Pairs I in Reno. Helgemo has a fourth NABC win, the 1997 North American Swiss Teams.

## Baker takes Women's BAM

The team captained by Lynn Baker took first-place honors in the Women's Board-a-Match last evening. Baker, of Austin TX, led the six-bagger that included Tobi Sokolow, also of Austin, Karen McCallum of Exeter NH, Jill Meyers of Santa Monica CA, Randi Montin of Napa CA and Janice Seamon-Molson of Miami FL.

This is the third NABC victory for Baker, who won the Women's Swiss Teams in 1998 and the Mixed Board-a-Match Teams at this year's Summer NABC in San Antonio playing with Matt Granovetter, Karen

McCallum and Zia Mahmood.

"In San Antonio I had Zia, but today I had five Zias," said Baker as she and her teammates toasted the victory. Sokolow, McCallum, Meyers, Montin and Seamon-Molson each have multiple NABC victories.

In second place was the squad of Susan Miller of Boca Raton, Jo Morse of West Palm Beach FL, Barbara Sion of Las Vegas NV and Suzy Burger of West Bloomfield MI.

The Baker team was first with a score of 33.33, while the Miller quartet was second with 32.29.

## Joan Weinrott named as 2000 Goodwill Member

Joan Weinrott of Bryn Mawr PA yesterday was named ACBL Goodwill Member of the Year for 2000. Goodwill Committee Chairman Aileen Osofsky, in making the announcement, told of the unselfish efforts Weinrott has made in the promotion and advancement of bridge.

Over the years those honored seldom have been present to accept the honor, but Weinrott was right there. But being there wasn't easy. She got up at 5:30 a.m. to go to the Philadelphia Airport only to discover that her plane was canceled because of fog. She went to a different airline, and they were able to get her here on a late-morning flight.

"I'm overwhelmed," said Weinrott. "I knew I was a nominee, but I never expected to be the special Goodwill member."

One of those who nominated her had this to say: "I can think of no one who has so magnanimously given more of herself in countless ways to improve both the

quality of the game and the comfort of the players than Joan Weinrott. But, even more importantly, she is the embodiment of class and refinement. Her all-round demeanor sets lofty ideals and standards for all the bridge world to follow. If her love and enthusiasm for the game and her exemplary behavior both at and away from the table were catching, the world of bridge would be a much better place for all of us."

Another nominator also spoke highly of Weinrott: "In her quiet and unassuming way, Joan is always importantly involved in the background guiding those having the official status or in actually taking charge when matters become difficult. Her services vary from making everyone feel welcome at all events, dealing with hotels and negotiating contracts, teaching bridge and often smoothing feathers. She is unselfishly devoted to bridge."

She will be awarded a plaque signaling her achievement. The other nominees will receive certificates.

## Rosenkranz, Schleifer named to Hall of Fame

The ACBL Hall of Fame Committee announced this week that George Rosenkranz and Meyer Schleifer will be the newest inductees into the Hall of Fame.

Rosenkranz, 83, was named as this year's recipient of the *Blackwood Award*, given to a living member for service to bridge in all facets of the game. Rosenkranz is an 11-time NABC winner, and an ACBL Grand Life Master. He was ACBL Honorary Member in 1990.

Rosenkranz has been Mexico's leading player for decades. He is also a well-known author and theoretician.

Schleifer, who died in 1997, was named the recipient of the *von Zedtwitz Award*, given to a deceased member for service to the game through bridge-playing expertise. He was one of a group of West Coast experts, and his card-playing skill was legendary. Schleifer won the 1966 Life Master Pairs.

I passed as West. North opened 1♠, and that was passed back to me. I doubled, North bid 2♠, and there it rested. Partner Jonathan Lane, who's from New Zealand, led a top diamond and the play went fairly logically (except for declarer leaving a trump out in the East seat) until we were all down to five cards.

North exited with a heart to my 5. With a certain amount of foreboding I wheeled out the ♥10. Not a flicker from pard as North followed, but the crocodile snapped his jaws! Jonathan ruffed my winner and played his diamond. Now, whether declarer ruffed or not, she was going to lose two more tricks. If she ruffed, she would have to lead away from her ♣K.

Well played, Jonathan. Thanks a lot!

# Aggressive bidding requires strong play

When you bid aggressively, you have to play well. Charles Nemes of Hinsdale IL and Charles Sheaff of Oak Park IL got to slam on this knockout teams deal, and then it was up to Nemes to make it.

The opening diamond lead rode to Nemes' jack, and he led the ♥K, getting the bad news. But since he had all bases covered he continued trumps, drawing four rounds and leaving East with the master trump. Next came the ♣Q, covered by the king and ace. Now Nemes was home -- he had all the outside tricks, and East could take his trump whenever he pleased. This was a 13-IMP gain because their opponents stopped in the heart game, making five.

What happens if East instead leads a spade? Declarer can still make it, but it requires picking up the ♦Q, on a finesse if necessary.

David Cordon invited game with his jump in hearts, but fellow Bermudian Jack Rhind said no. The opening club lead went to the queen, and Rhind cashed the ♣A and ruffed a club. He led a trump, and when East put up the 10, Rhind ducked. A diamond came back, and West won with the king when Rhind played low. East ruffed the diamond return and led the trump king. Once again Rhind ducked -- he could make his contract by winning the ace and driving out the queen, but the line of play he chose is more interesting.

Rhind ruffed the club switch, cashed the ♠A-K and led the jack -- and East was caught in a trump coup. He could ruff whenever he wished, but Rhind had the ace-9 over the queen-7.

# Stansby on Stansby

Just before the final session of the Life Master Open Pairs, someone was telling Lew Stansby to keep his partner, his wife Joanna, pumped up for the last session. This was Lew's response: "I don't remember ever playing a session of matchpoint bridge where my partner didn't drop a point -- until today."

# ACBL remembers Kaplan

The ACBL Board of Directors has voted to remember Edgar Kaplan by renaming the Blue Ribbon Pairs the Edgar Kaplan Blue Ribbon Pairs.

The action came at board meetings before the start of the Summer NABC in San Antonio and is effective with the Fall NABC here in Boston.

Kaplan (1925-1997) was a giant in the bridge world and his legacy to the game is incalculable. His career spanned six decades and covered every aspect of bridge. He was a teacher, author, editor, administrator, champion player, theorist, expert vugraph commentator, coach/captain and *the* authority on the laws of the game.

Kaplan was born in New York City in 1925, "a terrible year for wine but a great year for bridge players," he said in a 1996 interview.

He learned to play bridge before he was 10 by watching his parents play. He continued to play during his school years, including a brief time at Cornell University. "I didn't last there very long," he recalled. "I was mostly majoring in bridge."

He left Cornell to join the Army Air Force in 1943 and served until early 1946. When he returned from the service, Kaplan went into business with his father, a dress manufacturer.

Several years later, the elder Kaplan announced plans to retire and the son realized that "when he retired, I either had to take over the business or get out."

He chose to become a partner in the Card School of New York. "It wasn't the correct financial decision but it was better for my disposition."

Kaplan also began establishing himself as a player, writer, analyst, commentator and administrator. He won his first Vanderbilt title in 1953. "I started to get up but my knees were weak. I realized then that I had been under pressure after all."

His greatest thrill was the 1983 Reisinger victory with Oswald Jacoby -- plus regular teammates Norman Kay, Bill Root and Richard Pavlicek.

Kaplan, Kay, Root and Pavlicek had played always as a foursome but they invited Jacoby, a man they admired for his past feats and for his strength and courage in battling cancer, to join their team.

Kaplan said Jacoby had been a very good friend to all the group.

"When I was a young man he played a lot with me. Jake was very good to me when I was a kid. We'd been friends a long time and I'd played on teams with him before, but I hadn't played as a partner with Ozzie in 30 years."

Kaplan and Jacoby, along with Root and Pavlicek, played the first final session and led the field with 23 wins out of a possible 33. Jacoby sat out the second final session and his teammates scored 18 wins -- and claimed the victory. Jacoby died the following year.

In all, Kaplan won 26 North American championships but even with those impeccable credentials, he considered bridge a great leveler.

"Bridge is one of my pleasures," he said, "but bridge teaches you how to endure misery. It's not a game that can be played well -- just in varying stages of badness."

In 1979 Kaplan was named *Bridge Personality of the Year* by the International Bridge Press Association. He was selected as ACBL *Honorary Member* for 1993.

In 1995 he was inducted into the ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame and the WBF Hall of Fame.

Kaplan was the co-inventor of the Kaplan-Sheinwold system -- Kaplan and Kay listed "Timid K-S" as their general approach on their convention cards.

Their results belied the "timid" designation -- they won six Vanderbilts, two Spingolds, eight Reisingers, the 1997 Open Swiss Teams, the 1973 Life Master Men's Pairs and the 1974 Blue Ribbon Pairs.

## Edgar Kaplan Blue Ribbon Pairs: play starts today

The Blue Ribbon Pairs -- renamed the Edgar Kaplan Blue Ribbon Pairs to honor one of bridge's all-time great players, writers, administrators and *the* authority on the laws of the game -- begins today.

Kaplan (1925-1997) won his first North American championship in 1953 -- the Vanderbilt -- and his last in 1997 -- the Open Swiss Teams at the Spring NABC in Dallas. Although suffering from cancer and the effects of chemotherapy, Kaplan played seven of eight matches in the final session of the event.

Kaplan was recognized as the world's foremost authority on the laws of duplicate and rubber bridge. He became co-chairman of the ACBL Laws Commission in 1978 and was co-chairman of the WBF Laws Commission at the time of his death.

Beyond all of Kaplan's accomplishments, what made him an idol to many was his peerless work as a vugraph commentator. His dry wit and flawless timing kept vugraph audiences around the world enthralled. He was droll without being aloof and projected a deep knowledge of the game without being pedantic.

### The play

The Blue Ribbon Pairs ranks with the Life Master Pairs as the most prestigious -- and toughest -- pair events on the ACBL calendar. Like the LM Pairs, the Blue Ribbon Pairs is played over three days and includes two qualifying, two semifinal and two final sessions.

Entry is restricted to winners and runners-up in regional championships -- plus high finishers in North American championships, members of current Grand National district championship teams, members of current official teams representing ACBL and the top 100 lifetime masterpoint holders.

### Last year

Last year's winners, Zia Mahmood and Howard Weinstein, claimed the title by a margin of more than two boards. It was the first Blue Ribbon victory for each.

### The trophy

The event is contested for the Cavendish Trophy, awarded for the National Open Pair Championship and donated by the Cavendish Club of New York in 1928. Since 1963, the trophy has been awarded to winners of the Blue Ribbon Pairs.

Dorothy Truscott and B. Jay Becker won the inaugural event in 1963 -- and Truscott remains the only woman winner.

Bob Hamman has four wins, each with a different partner: Lew Mathe in 1964, Ron Von der Porten in 1986, Nick Nickell in 1991 and Michael Rosenberg in 1993.

Larry Cohen also has four wins: with Ron Gerard in 1981, Marty Bergen in 1983 and 1988 and David Berkowitz in 1996.

Kit Woolsey has three wins: with Steve Robinson in 1973 and 1975 and with Ed Manfield in 1990.

In the 34-year history of the Blue Ribbon Pairs, there has been only one tie: in 1984, Jack Kennedy and Bobby Wolff tied with David Funk and Mark Lair.

Lair waited another 10 years before claiming his second title in 1994 with first-time partner Alexander Weiland.

# Kaplan quips

Quotes from the Rama Room -- as recorded by Betty Kaplan, Edgar's Boswell, at the 6th World Team Olympiad in Valkenberg, Netherlands, in 1980.

- "I don't know what North was thinking of doing, but it's just as well he didn't."

- "I think he'll keep doubling them until he finally beats one."

- "The difference between a brave bid and a foolhardy bid is largely a matter of result."

- "That's unfair. North-South were just having a good time and suddenly East-West turned nasty and doubled."

- "Four hearts is a very good bid -- but on some other hand."

- "West passed, hoping his partner would double but that was too much to hope for in this world. It will happen all the time in the next world."

- "If you average South's bidding on this hand (one too many) and on the previous hand (one too few), he comes out just right."

- "When in doubt, put the opponents on lead. Why should you make the mistake?"

- "It is always a good idea to make only six when you've missed a grand slam. The opponents don't know how good a result they have."

- "Well, it was only sporting for declarer to give East his trick back."

- "He may bid and he may not. I believe that covers all possibilities."

- "If you're a good enough player, you can get away with making mistakes because nobody will believe it."

- "That's the story of my life -- all my life, I've been setting up non-working endplays."

- "Declarer could try a non-working squeeze."

- "After all, East-West have a clear majority of the point count (21)."

- "The defenders made 2NT so it was an accurate contract -- just played the wrong way."

- "I understand some super-modernists are back to leading queen from queen-jack. They call it 'reverse Rusinow.'"

- "He's preserving his options to misguess the diamonds."

- "In order to let the contract make, the defenders must lead a spade. No other line of play succeeds."

- "South's bid implied: I have four spades, four hearts, six clubs and the rest are diamonds."

- "They avoided the trap of bidding a slam on the second hand to compensate for the one they missed on the first."

- "South had five hearts and five clubs, but they were not playing five-card majors so he opened 1♣."

- "I don't understand how declarer made only five spades. I understand why he wanted to make only five spades: It wouldn't be so obvious then that he had missed a slam."

- "To teach the opponents not to preempt against you, you must not only double them, you must also beat them."

- "Some people bid 3NT over their partner's three-level suit bids on the theory that it's more dignified to go down in game."

- "In his 3NT contract, declarer has seven tricks. One more from heaven makes eight and where there's eight, there's nine."

- "I don't think anyone in this tournament can bid diamonds to show diamonds. We lost the club suit in the 1950s. Now diamonds are gone and hearts are sinking fast."

- "Everything gets doubled in the Closed Room except when it goes down."

- "If you want to bid naturally and still sound modern, just say your bid shows the suit below the suit above the one you bid."

- "Now his 3♦ bid shows a singleton diamond. When he rebids diamonds, it will confirm a singleton diamond."

- "Now he has forced North to lead away from his ♦K but unfortunately North didn't have it. It's called the phantom endplay."

- "In the old days, you had to grit your teeth and pass with the North hand. Now you can make a negative double with the result that you go down instead of the opponents."

- "East is wondering why he didn't pass 1♠. So am I."
