## Alfred Sheinwold, an all-time great, dies in Los Angeles

Alfred Sheinwold of Beverly Hill CA (1912-1997), one of the greatest bridge writers in history and a member of the Bridge Hall of Fame, died yesterday in Los Angeles after a series of strokes.

Freddie, as he was known to his friends, was a personal friend. He was a fascinating person with many interests. Bridge was major, of course -- he contributed a daily bridge column to the *Los Angeles Times* for many, many years. But music was extremely important in his life, and he was very involved with chorales -- he was a talented tenor. He also was fascinated by puzzles -- during World War II his job was to break German codes, and he was so successful at this that he became America's chief code and cipher expert.

Dozens of persons who were closely associated with him are expected to attend his funeral.

## Kraft-Compton lead in cash prize event

James Kraft of Tulsa and Chris Compton of Oklahoma City led by a full board going into this morning's final session of the cash prize game. Tied for second were David Metcalf of Arlington MA and Tom Rozinski of New York City, with James Fellows, Omaha, and Hugh MacLean, Gonzales TX.

Metcalf and Rozinski are the leaders in Strat B, followed by Sali Ma of Cincinnati and Randolph Johnson of Billerica MA.

A total of \$2640 will be given out as prizes when the six-table event comes to a close at about noon today. In Strat A the winners will receive \$460, with \$340 for second, \$250 for third and \$200 for fourth. In Strat B top prize is \$320, with \$240 for second and \$190 for third. Section top winners in both strats will win \$100 per pair, and minor awards will be given to lesser section placings.

## Seven added to Junior Corps, Hirschman earns \$5,000 scholarship

Seven Junior players, including three members of the Texas A&M squad that won the 1996 College Bridge Team Championship, were inducted into the ACBL Junior Corps during the Junior Day reception yesterday.

Aileen Osofsky, chairman of the Goodwill Committee, said the Junior Corps is "under the umbrella of the Goodwill Committee and each Junior Corps member is a model for all the Junior players who come after."

New Junior Corps members are Patricia Longo, Eric Wolff and Hank Eng, the 1996 college champions and members of District 16; Curtis Rudner, District 9; Daniel Rodney, District 6; Josh Heller, District 2, and Christine Carmichael, District 11.

Dan Hirschman, ACBL's youngest Life Master, received the \$5,000 Homer Shoop Preteen Scholarship Award. The award was accepted by his father, Marty Hirschman, and his brother Sam, a former *King of Bridge*.

Dan, who was not present at the Junior Day reception, was notified of the award by phone. "Thank you for considering me and for the honor of receiving the award," he said.

The seventh grade student, an A+ student in Southfield MI, is into computers and role-playing games such as *Dragons and Dungeons*. He still plays some bridge but mostly he likes to caddy "for money to buy my games."

Charlotte Blaiss, ACBL coordinator for Junior games, announced that "very few places are left" for the World Junior Bridge Camp in Italy.

## Greco, Hampson win Open Pairs I title

Eric Greco of Annandale VA and Geoff Hampson of Fenton MI, the youngest pair to win a National American championship in more than 18 years, captured the Open Pairs I last night.

Greco, 21, and Hampson, 28, scored 2602.19 matchpoints, the only pair to top 2600 points. Top on a board was 77.

Runners-up Geir Helgemo of Norway and Tony Forrester of Great Britain scored 2538.11 points, the only other pair to top 2500 points.

David Berkowitz, Old Tappan NJ, and Larry Cohen, Boca Raton FL, were third with 2454.12 points.

Greco-Hampson are the youngest pair to win an NABC title since Jeff Meckstroth, then 23, and Eric Rodwell, then 22, won the Open Pairs title at the Spring NABC in Norfolk VA in 1979.

Greco is a senior at the University of Virginia and a former *King of Bridge* who won the *Youth Player of the Year* title (for players 19 and younger) five years in a row. This was his first NABC win.

Hampson, who plays professionally, won the North American Swiss Teams in 1992 and the Mixed Pairs in 1994. His Canadian team was second in the World Junior Team Championships in 1991.

## Maryland youth is youngest Mid-Atlantic Life Master

**S**cottie Waldron Jr. earned his gold card playing with his dad at a club game in December, becoming the Mid-Atlantic area's youngest Life Master and the fourth-youngest LM ever.

The record for youngest LM is held by Dan Hirschman of Southfield MI, who became a Life Master in 1994 at the age of 10 years, two months and 20 days.

That chopped more than a year off the record held by Joel Wooldridge of Williamsville NY, who became the youngest LM in 1990 at the age of 11 years, four months and 13 days.

Waldron, who lives in Hunt Valle MD, was 11 years, 11 months old when he became an LM. He's played mostly with his dad, and the pair has won two free trips: representing District 6 in the Grand National Teams-C at the Summer NABC in New Orleans in 1995 and in the North American Non-Life Master Pairs in Philadelphia in 1996.

Young Waldron is also an accomplished violinist, winning the state violin competition for his age group. He won't choose between bridge and the violin -- "I like them both and I'm going to keep on playing for quite a while."

With one more event -- the Vanderbilt KO Teams -- to be contested, the team captained by Seymon Deutsch is leading in point standing for the 1997 International Team Trials. Two teams will qualify to represent the ACBL in the Bermuda Bowl, scheduled in October in Tunisia.

DEUTSCH (Zia, Michael Rosenberg, Chip Martel and Lew Stansby) has compiled 181.5 placing points to 166 for the Nick Nickell team (Richard Freeman, Bob Hamman, Bobby Wolff, Jeff Meckstroth and Eric Rodwell).

The top six, seven or eight teams will earn byes based on the conditions of contest, which are available from Rena Hetzer at ACBL, 2990 Airways Blvd., Memphis TN 38116-3847.

## McOrmond-Ballantyne win last-round encounter

Canadians Gordon McOrmond and Aidan Ballantyne won the North American Open Pairs Flight A by more than a board, but the outcome was not decided until they met the runners-up on the last round.

McOrmond-Ballantyne, representing District 19, scored 8 and 5.5 matchpoints (13 was top on a board) in their meeting with JoAnna and Lew Stansby, District 21 representatives.

"There was potential for drama on both boards," said Ballantyne.

Ballantyne found the ♦Q lead and the Canadians gathered in two diamond tricks. Eventually they scored two trump tricks for plus 100.

With any other lead, declarer can reach dummy and pitch a losing diamond on the ♣A. Plus 620 would have earned the Stansbys a 12.

Declarer lost three hearts and a diamond in 3♦ and scored plus 110. Ballantyne noted, however, that he "might" have bid 3♠ and McOrmond "might" have been doubled for minus 200 (or possibly minus 500) for a 1.

This was the first North American championship for the Canadians, who formed a partnership "just for this event," said McOrmond.

They led all the way from the club, unit and district level to the North American final. "Our defense was really steady," said Ballantyne, "but we got a bit lucky in the bidding. That's where I think we won -- on defense."

Impossible problems call for ingenious solutions. Watch Richard Oshlag in action on this one.

Oshlag hoped for a minor-suit game when his partner Paul Munafu raised diamonds, so he concealed his imposing spade suit. As it turns out, Oshlag was headed for a minus in 5♣. However, East not unreasonably bid on to 5♥, doubled. Oshlag regretted not obeying the axiom "bid where you live" when the opening lead was a diamond and dummy's imposing diamond spots showed up.

Oshlag realized that declarer would get three diamond winners by simply ruffing out his ace-queen, so he resorted to a subtle falsecard. At trick one, in perfect tempo, he covered dummy's jack with his ace! Now declarer could no longer safely pass a diamond to North, because the defense could take two spade tricks when North won his presumed queen. Declarer's crossruff thus ended a trick short.

Oshlag's quick falsecard in tempo saved the day, netting N-S 49 1/2 matchpoints on a 51 top.

## Farsighted play

It's no accident that Kerri Sanborn is one of the highest rated woman players in the world. She looks ahead, sees the pitfalls, then takes action to bypass the traps. Watch her on Board 15 from the first qualifying session of the Open Pairs.

South was declarer at 4♥ and Sanborn quickly cashed two spades. Then she took her trump ace! Why? Because she looked ahead and saw the mess she'd be in if she didn't. Say she had led a third spade. Declarer would ruff, clear his hand of clubs via a finesse and tuck Sanborn in with the trump ace. She would be forced to lead a diamond away from her king or to play a spade to give declarer a sluff-ruff and his contract. But after getting rid of the ♥A, Sanborn was guaranteed the setting trick with her ♦K.

Former world champion Fred Hamilton wasn't in the best contract, but he cut his opponents' communication and scored plus 150.

Hamilton, playing with Kyle Larsen, decided to pass at his first turn and await developments. He was somewhat surprised when 3♣ became the final contract. "I probably should have bid five clubs," he commented.

West led his singleton diamond -- to the 9, 10 and king. Hamilton led toward dummy's ♣10 and West, in no hurry to take his ♣A, ducked.

Now Hamilton led dummy's ♥K and, when East did not cover, discarded his ♠9 -- the Scissors Coup, cutting communication for the diamond ruff.

At other tables where South opened 5♣, West doubled and led the ♦7. These declarers faced a similar problem: West surely did not have all three aces or he would have led one. Therefore, he could take the ♣A, lead to his partner's ace and get a diamond ruff.

To prevent this, declarer won the diamond lead in dummy and led the ♥A. When East did not cover, they ditched the ♠9. Now there was no entry to the East hand for the diamond ruff.

Of course, if West held

♠ A J 10 7 ♥ A Q 8 7 ♦ 10 8 7 ♣ A 9, declarer had just created an anti-Scissors Coup! West can win the ♥A, lead a second diamond, win his ♣A and give his partner a diamond ruff.

# Three problem hands

Some hands from the Friday night Stratified Pairs posed a series of problems -- one in the bidding, one in declarer play and one in defense.

First the bidding problem.

♠ 9 8  
♥ A K 9 6  
♦ K 5 3 2  
♣ K Q 10

Vulnerable against not you open a 15-17 notrump. You hear 3♣ on your left, double by partner showing cards. Passing would be an option at other vulnerabilities, but is it right here? And if not, what should you do?

The winning action at the table was to bid 3NT. If you bid 3♥ you get raised to 4♥ and will have to guess well to succeed there. but 3NT on a small club lead was easy. You cash the ♥A and take a diamond finesse. The defense can't prevent you from taking a second-round heart finesse and you come home with 10 tricks for plus 630 for 10 matchpoints out of 12. Plus 620 was worth only 5 matchpoints.

On the next deal, you reach 4♥ on the lead of the ♦6, the unbid suit. Plan the play.

The best line is to take the ♦K and play three rounds of diamonds at once. West wins and probably exits with a club. You put in the queen, and it loses to the king. Back comes a low club to your ace. Now you lead the ♦10, and it is up to East to defend well by nonchalantly ruffing with the ♥2, a difficult play since it seems to be giving up a sure trump trick. If East does this, you will have to guess the trump position to make your contract.

But note that if East does not ruff, the consequences are catastrophic. Declarer can infer that East's failure to ruff marks him with the ♥Q. He can pitch a club from dummy on the ♦10, run the ♥J (!) from hand, draw a second round of trumps, ruff one club and pitch a second club on the ♠A for an overtrick.

The key to the hand as declarer is not to touch trumps at all. If you draw trumps by taking the trump finesse, the defense can exit with a third trump, leaving you with no chance.

And finally, your defensive problem, which

also involves some good declarer play problems.

When East played in 3NT he got the lead of the ♣J. Declarer makes his first good move when he runs this to his king and crosses to a top diamond to play a spade to the jack. This play holds your spade losers to two tricks when North has the doubleton king-queen and when either hand has 10 doubleton. South wins his ♠Q and plays the ♣10. North wins -- what now?

Well, South's play of the ♣10 denies the 9, so playing a third club will set up a winner -- but that is not enough to beat the hand. Play the ♥9 and declarer is caught on the horns of a dilemma. If he puts up the 10 or queen, South wins cheaply and goes back to clubs to establish the defense's fifth trick. If declarer plays the ace and clears the spades, North wins the third round of spades and plays a heart, enabling South to cash two hearts for one down.

## Dallas parking

## Computer maven Adams to retire on April 1

Bill Adams, head of the ACBL's computer division, will retire on April 1 after 27 years of service. He plans to move back to Wichita KS --- "and I may even take up bridge again."

Adams began directing in 1963 while he was a buyer in Boeing's purchasing department in Wichita. Even back in those days he didn't like getting up early. Once in a while he made the supreme effort and went forth to do battle in the morning game. Those were great times.

He became a salaried national director in 1970 and worked out of Phoenix. Three years later he made Wichita his home base again. By this time his matchpointing speed had become so fast that he was nicknamed "Tornado" --- or was that because he was based in Kansas? Only the Wizard knows.

In 1985 he came to Memphis to be the tournament coordinator, and two years later he was put in charge of the new computer division. His infectious humor and witticisms lightened even the most serious management meetings.

The camaraderie with his fellow tournament directors is the dearest memory Adams will take back to Wichita. The accomplishment of which he is proudest is his selection of a nickname for National Tournament Director Johnny Wiser, now retired. "From now on you're Sadderbut," Adams told Wiser. And Wiser to this day is known to directors as Sadderbut Wiser.

Watch out, Wichita! A Tornado is on the way!

## The Alert strip

It is ACBL policy to have players tap the Alert strip and say Alert out loud at the same time. When an announcement is made, once again the player should tap the Alert strip.

When using spoken bidding, players are required to announce and Alert aloud.

If there is some reluctance about complying, players should summon a tournament director rather than get into a hassle with an opponent.

ated with Freddie, including many of his closest friends, were grieved by the news yesterday. Edgar Kaplan, with whom Freddie collaborated in producing the Kaplan-Sheinwold bidding system, was especially hard-hit by the news.

The word of Freddie's death came to us by way of Frank Stewart, former *Bulletin* editor who has been co-author with Freddie of the syndicated newspaper column that bears both of their bylines. Frank is on his way to Los Angeles from his home in Alabama to be with Freddie's family, including his wife Paula, for the funeral services.

Freddie, who was born in London, came to the United States early in life -- but he never lost his rich British accent.

His bridge history covers the full range of the game. His syndicated column was considered by many to be the best -- he had an amazing knack of getting his point across to even the least experienced players. He managed this by making sure that every column had only one main point, making it easier for his readers to focus.

At the time the Kaplan-Sheinwold bidding system arrived on the scene, the bridge world was ready to try weak notrumps and controlled psychs. The system was widely used for several years, and there are still many players who swear by the system today.

He was a fine player, but his greatest accomplishments on the world scene were based on his abilities as a non-playing captain of American teams. He was captain of the 1985 team that won the Bermuda Bowl in Sao Paulo, Brazil, but his captaincy of America's team in the 1975 Bermuda Bowl was the one that made the headlines.

That was the Bermuda Bowl that was held in Bermuda to commemorate the 25th anniversary of the Bermuda Bowl. During the round-robin, it was discovered that two members of the Italian team were engaged in foot-tapping. It never was determined how the Italians were transmitting messages with their feet, but the World Bridge Federation Executive issued a strong reprimand to the two Italians -- but they were allowed to continue to play.

This infuriated Freddie -- he couldn't believe that two players who, it strongly appeared, were transmitting illegal signals would be allowed to continue to play. He announced that he was withdrawing his team from the competition if the Italians were allowed to play.

However, the members of the ACBL Board of Directors who were present overruled Freddie and insisted that the American continue to play. This caused a rift between Freddie and the ACBL that lasted for many years, but which had been totally repaired in recent years. In fact, Freddie was a regular contributor to Daily Bulletins at NABCs up to as recently as last year.

The Americans eventually lost in that 1975 Bermuda Bowl contest, but it wasn't because of foot signals. That was the event in which the Italians got to an abysmal grand slam in clubs that made because of the fortunate position of the king and 10 of trumps.

Freddie was an editor of *The Bridge World* from 1934 to 1963, and he was editor of the *ACBL Bulletin* from 1953 to 1958. He was editor-in-chief of *Autobridge* from 1938 to his death. He also was games editor for *Argosy* and a contributing editor for *Popular Bridge*. He pioneered bridge lessons on television in 1963.

He also was a major authority on backgammon, and he frequently served as chief director for backgammon tournaments in Las Vegas.

He was the author of perhaps the most successful bridge book ever written, *Five Weeks to Winning Bridge*, a book that sold in the millions. He also was the author of 12 other books.

There also was an administrative side to Freddie. He served as chairman of the ACBL Laws Commission from 1964-1975, as chairman of the appeals committee at NABCs, and as chairman of the Board of Governors (1970-1973). He was named ACBL Honorary Member of the Year in 1983.

## Remembering Freddie

**F**rank Stewart, co-author of the Sheinwold column, described Alfred Sheinwold as "simply the best bridge writer I ever knew. What a stylist he was!"

"You could read a Sheinwold column and know in an instance that nobody else could have written it. He enlightened and entertained players through seven decades and earned millions of fans.

"Bridge has lost a rich treasure. What an indelible mark he left on our game."

**Alan Truscott**, bridge editor of the *New York Times*: "Freddie Sheinwold was enormously helpful to me when I came to America. We were close friends for the past 35 years. He was an ornament to the game."

Many of ACBL's top players, along with ACBL officials, remembered Sheinwold as a writer, a player and their non-playing captain.

**Chip Martel**, a member of the 1985 team that won the Bermuda Bowl, with Sheinwold as npc: "I did indeed learn to play bridge from *Five Weeks to Winning Bridge*, so I was exposed to Alfred Sheinwold early on.

"We won one of the most exciting semifinals ever when we defeated Brazil on the last board of the match. It was a pleasure to have Freddie around for his support and guidance when he was our captain."

**Paul Soloway**, a member of the 1975 team that finished in the runner-up spot in the Bermuda Bowl: "He was a true gentleman, a pleasure to be around. It was a pleasure to have him as a captain."

**Eddie Kantar**, another member of the 1975 team: "The bridge world has lost one of its greatest friends and so have I."

**Bobby Wolff**, a member of both teams that Sheinwold captained: "Freddie spanned the history of bridge -- one of the best lecturers, humorists and writers. Bridge has lost someone who is irreplaceable."

**Bob Hamman**, who played with Wolff on both teams that Sheinwold captained, remembers Sheinwold as "a man of real toughness and character that his soft-spoken demeanor belied. He was a man who commanded respect. He will be missed.

"He was our captain in 1975 in Bermuda and 1985 in Brazil and he probably did a better job of captaining the time we lost than the

time we won."

Hamman recalled a favorite Sheinwold story: "A Dr. Sigfreud Fritchauer, an Austrian player who was known as a wonderful card player but a crazy bidder, moved to Los Angeles. Freddie came into the bridge club one day and, not knowing any of the players, sat down to kibitz. After several rounds, he turned to the player on his right and said, 'You must be Dr. Fritchauer'."

**Howard Piltch**, ACBL president, called Sheinwold's death "a great loss. He was one of the greats of bridge -- not just playing, not just writing but promoting bridge and caring about bridge."

**Roy G. Green**, ACBL chief executive officer: "Freddie Sheinwold was truly a magnificent human being, an absolute credit to the bridge community. It was an honor and privilege to have had the opportunity to know him."

**Lew Stansby**, a member of the 1985 team: "We were very fortunate to have Sheinwold as our captain for the 1985 trials and Bermuda Bowl. I remember that he always did more than I expected to help the team."

**Hugh Ross**, another member of the 1985 team: "Freddie was one of the most erudite, entertaining individuals I ever met with an inexhaustible fund of amusing stories. He also attracted controversy because, under a mild exterior, he had a will of iron."

**Mike Lawrence** remembered the Men's Teams at the Portland NABC in 1964 when he played with Harold Guiver and Sheinwold played with Ivan Erdos. "It was my first NABC win and his last. He was a very caring, gentle person. I enjoyed him."

**Edgar Kaplan**, Sheinwold's regular partner a few decades ago, was not available for comment. At last year's Hall of Fame banquet, Kaplan presented Sheinwold for induction and made these comments:

"Freddie Sheinwold has contributed to bridge in so many ways. He's a great player and a great writer. He served the ACBL with the Board of Governors and the Laws Commission, and he set up the structure of the appeals process which was better back in those days."

After pointing out that Sheinwold was 84 years old, Kaplan suggested that Freddie should be called the Grand Old Man of Bridge.

During his playing career he won two North American championships -- the Chicago, now known as the Reisinger, in 1958 and the Men's Teams in 1964. He was second in the Vanderbilt in 1958 and the Chicago in 1959.

Freddie was one of the greats, a worthy member of the Hall of Fame. The bridge world has lost a man who was really special in so many ways.

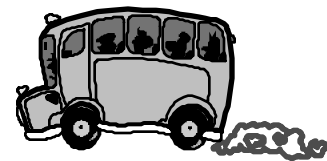

# Rich tradition makes Vanderbilt KO special

No one will be surprised to see a repeat of last year's final in the Vanderbilt Knockout Teams -- ZIA vs. NICKELL.

The two teams have run up an amazing record over the past few years - NICKELL (Nick Nickell, Richard Freeman, Bob Hamman, Bobby Wolff, Jeff Meckstroth, Eric Rodwell) has won four straight Spingolds, three straight Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams and a Bermuda Bowl.

ZIA (Zia Mahmood, Michael Rosenberg, Seymon Deutsch, Chip Martel, Lew Stansby) has also posted some impressive numbers. They have won two Vanderbilts and a Reisinger, been second twice in the Spingold and (without Zia, who was then ineligible to play for the U.S.) won the Rosenblum Knockout Teams at the 1994 World Bridge Championships in Albuquerque.

There'll be one change in personnel, however. Ron Smith of San Francisco will play with Deutsch and Zia, replacing Michael Rosenberg. Rosenberg and his wife Debbie are expecting a baby and Rosenberg is not in Dallas.

A list of Vanderbilt winners and runners-up reads like a Who's Who in Bridge -- or a Bridge Hall of Fame roster.

Howard Schenken won the Vanderbilt Knockout Teams 10 times. John Crawford had nine wins; George Rapee and B. Jay Becker, eight; Norman Kay and Oswald Jacoby, seven; and Edgar Kaplan, six.

Barry Crane never won the event but had two seconds and a third.

The Vanderbilt Trophy for the Vanderbilt Knockout Teams was donated in 1928 by Harold S. Vanderbilt, who won the event in 1932 and 1940.

The Vanderbilt was contested annually in New York -- as a separate championship -- until 1958 when it became part of the Spring North American Championships.

Vanderbilt winners receive replicas of the trophy -- a practice initiated by Vanderbilt from the first running of the event and perpetuated by a \$100,000 trust fund administered by ACBL under the terms of Vanderbilt's will.

Here's a look at Vanderbilt action through the years:

- Oswald Jacoby won his first Vanderbilt in 1931 and his last in 1965.
- Two father-son partnerships have won the Vanderbilt: Oswald Jacoby and son Jim in 1965 and B. Jay Becker and son Michael in 1981.
- Edith Freilich and Billy Seamon are the only sister-brother partnership to win the Vanderbilt. Their team won in 1963 -- the last time a woman won a major open team championship.
- The only "three-peat" in the Vanderbilt came when B. Jay Becker, John Crawford, George Rapee, Howard Schenken and Sidney Silodor won the championship in 1955, 1956 and 1957. Previous winners and runners-up:

## Silver Ribbon Pairs begins today

The Silver Ribbon Pairs -- open only to players who are at least 55 years old and who have pre-qualified by placing first or second in a regional- or national-rated senior event -- begins play today.

The event, which consists of two qualifying and two final sessions, has been won by three members of the ACBL Board of Directors: Joan Remey Moore, District 12 director, playing with Helen Shanbrom in 1993; and Virgil Anderson, District 15 director, playing with Jayne Thomas, District 9 director, in 1994. (Anderson was ACBL president at the time and is the only "sitting" president to win an NABC event in recent years.)

The winners will have their names inscribed on the Leventritt Trophy and will receive a certificate of recognition.

The trophy honors Peter Leventritt of New York, ACBL president in 1954 and assistant treasurer 1945-46. He served as president of the Greater New York Bridge Association and the Card School of New York, which he co-founded.

Leventritt pioneered the use of the *Schenken System* in partnership with its inventor.

He represented North America in the Bermuda Bowl and placed second in 1957, 1961, 1963 and 1965.

His NABC wins include the Spingold in 1956 and 1960, the Chicago (now the Reisinger) in 1941 and 1949, the Vanderbilt in 1953 and 1964, the Life Master Pairs in 1944 and 1951, the Master Mixed Teams in 1949, 1950 and 1959, the Mixed Pairs in 1950 and the Men's Teams in 1966.

## What does 'Stratified' mean?

**Question:** It seems as if there is a bewildering array of events to play in. I'm not exactly sure what is meant by the term "stratified."

**Answer:** A stratified game is one in which players of different *strata* (determined by their masterpoint holdings) play together in an open field, yet are scored against players in their own stratum (or "strat"), with some important exceptions that we'll examine here.

For example, Strat A is for players with more than 1000 masterpoints, Strat B 300-750, and Strat C 0--300. If you and your partner are in the C strat and score better than all other C pairs in the field, you win that strat. Even if you don't win the overall, you still may earn a section top among the C players.

And it gets better. If you score better than any of the B strat players, you would win the B strat, even though you are C strat players. In fact, you could win the event overall, thus earning the A strat masterpoint prize (it happens!)

Here's an illustration: you're sitting East-West in a 15-table event. In addition to you, there are four other C strat pairs, six B pairs and four A pairs. You and your partner score a 60% game,

placing you ahead of the other C pairs, as well as all the B players. Therefore, you place first in B and first in C (note that you receive only the masterpoint award for the *greater* of the two, not *both*).

In order to be a fair contest, the tournament staff ensures that players of different strata are fairly evenly distributed throughout the field. Remember that you *do* play against players from all strata in this format.

The advantage of the stratified format is that it allows newer players the opportunity to compete against more skilled players while still retaining a good chance to earn masterpoints.

## Open Teams event set for World Championship

The first-ever transnational World Championship Open Teams will take place in Hammamet, Tunisia, starting on Oct. 27. All teams will play four matches a day from Monday through Thursday, and either four or eight teams will qualify for the knockout playoffs. Teams that fail to qualify will play an additional two matches on Friday for placings.

If more than 20 teams made up of seniors enter, there will be a separate senior event. If there are fewer, there will be a special senior category within the Open Teams. There also will be special categories for all-woman and mixed teams as long as a sufficient number of such teams enter.

Registration bags will be presented to all members of every team in the Open Pairs.

The tournament will feature the Bermuda Bowl and the Venice Cup. The site is a magnificent hotel with different levels ranging from budget to luxury. The hotel is located in a resort area with a beach front, so it will be worthwhile to make the trip a combined vacation and bridge event.

The official airline is Tunis Air. There will be special fares for North American players. At the moment the rates are not available, but they will be displayed in the *Bridge Bulletin* as soon as they are available.

Those who are interested in competing should contact the ACBL and make their wishes known. The ACBL is required to inform the World Bridge Federation concerning the ACBL's participants.

The entry fee for the Open Teams will be \$600, which works out to only about \$10 per player per session. This is an open event -- there are no restrictions. Teams can be made up with players from different countries as well. Of course all entries are subject to WBF accreditation.
