New York pair wins NABC Women's Pairs

Susan Wexler and Margie Gwozdziński, second in the same event a year ago, won the NABC Women's Pairs by a margin of almost three boards.

The New Yorkers scored 825.64 to 754.79 for runners-up Suzy Burger of West Bloomfield MI and Barbara Sion of Las Vegas, who won the Life Master Women's Pairs at the Fall NABC in San Francisco.

Joan Remey Moore, Troy MI, and Brenda Bryant, Ferndale MI, were third with 751.52, followed closely by Nell Cahn, Shreveport LA, and

California pair NAOP C victors

Tom Franklin of Martinez CA and Mike Corker of Concord CA, representing District 21, today reign as North American Open Pairs Flight C champions (non-Life Masters). They finished one board ahead of Weiming Hu of Portland OR and Alex Lo of Gresham OR, representing District 20.

The winners have been a partnership about a year, and they play Standard American. "I couldn't believe we won," said Franklin, a civil engineer for the state of California. "I thought we were out

Schwartz tops Cayne in Vanderbilt final

The team captained by Richard Schwartz jumped out to an early lead -- largely due to a 59-20 win in the second quarter -- and held on for a 156-128 victory over the Jimmy Cayne team in the Vanderbilt Knockout Teams.

SCHWARTZ (Mark Lair, Steve Robinson, Peter Boyd, Paul Soloway, Bobby Goldman) led 34-17 after one quarter. Then came the decisive second quarter, which Schwartz won 59-20 for a 93-37 halftime lead.

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Allan Falk and Lloyd Arvedon

Open Pairs II champs are 2 for 2 at NABCs

Lloyd Arvedon of Medford MA and Allan Falk of Lansing MI, playing together for only the second time, won Open Pairs II -- their second NABC title.

Arvedon and Falk scored 1242.63 matchpoints for an 18-point lead over runners-up Sidney Lazard of New Orleans and Bart Bramley of Chicago, who scored 1224.46.

Jeff Meckstroth of Tampa and Eric Rodwell of Napierville IL were third with a score of 1220.53.

Childs also was highly appreciative of all the hard work done by all her committee chairman and their staffs.

She also expressed thanks to the Hyatt for the outstanding cooperation she received. And then there were the organizations that made special gifts to the tournament: Southern Maid Donut Co., Almond Growers Marketing Board, Bridgford Food, Dole Co., Interstate Bakeries, Pioneer Flour Mills, Silverado Foods, Frito Lay and Victor Packing Co.

Usually the chairman of an NABC has a long history of chairmanships for sectionals and regionals, but Childs stepped right in and took over without any such previous experience. "I know a lot of the players, and I've been playing in Dallas for 25 years. When they asked me to take the job, I said yes."

Bridge is a major part of her life. She is a Diamond Life Master with more than 5000 masterpoints. She started out playing home party bridge, but a friend suggested duplicate. She tried it, and the rest is history.

She scored more masterpoints than any other woman in District 16 (Texas and Mexico) in 1993, and last year she was #3 on the list.

She is a secretary in a tax office, "so I don't play much in the early months. But I start hitting the sectionals and regionals after the tax season is over."

All in all, Dallas 1997 has been a good time, says Childs. "There were some tough times, but the overall picture has been bright. I'm glad I had the chance to have this experience."

"It felt great," said Drewett. "We were scared to say anything -- we were afraid of jinxing ourselves."

"But we knew everything was going our way during that afternoon session," said Twiss, a consulting actuary. "We wound up with 66%." □

Simon, North, played the hand after a limit auction. She ducked the ♣K opening lead, won the return and drew three rounds of trumps on which East discarded a diamond and club. Two rounds of diamonds followed, and then a heart was ducked to West, who returned the ♦K. Simon ruffed as East threw a heart perforce. This was the position:

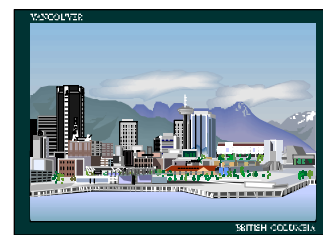

Simon led her last heart, and when East played the jack, it was up to West to find the defense -- overtake the heart and play a diamond for the ruff and discard. When West left East on lead, she had a choice of poisons. A heart establishes the suit, and any club play gives declarer a trick in the suit. Best is the ♣7, but declarer can run this to her hand.

The NABCs will return to the West Coast in March, 1999 when Vancouver, British Columbia, will host another North American Bridge Championship, its first since 1974. The

Is this a record?

Irina Levitina of Teaneck NJ is the only person ever to win world titles in bridge and chess. Six month ago, in Rhodes, Greece, she was a member of the winning American women's team in the World Women's Team Olympiad. Before coming to the United States she won four gold medals for her native Russia in World Chess Olympics.

Here she had no partner for the Mixed Pairs, and I arranged for her to play with my Vanderbilt partner, Ken Barbour of Scottsdale AZ. Their opening session in the qualifying was a disastrous 39%, which would prompt many to make plans for a different partner and event the following day. But they did some arithmetic, and decided that they would need 64% in the evening to qualify. Their evening score was exactly 64%, and they did qualify for the final.

This 25% improvement is one of the most remarkable recoveries ever recorded.

Skill + luck = success

Allan Siebert was missing a few high cards -- the A, K, J and 10 of trumps -- but he combined skill and luck to land his 3♥ contract in the second qualifying session of Open Pairs II.

North led the ♠Q and Siebert (West) won the king in his hand. He led the ♣J to South's king, and South shifted to a low diamond.

Assuming the finesse was off, Siebert went up with his ace -- and North, hoping his partner had the ♦Q, jettisoned his king!

Now Siebert led a low heart to the 8, 3 and ace. South got out the ♦J and Siebert won his queen. He led another low heart and North took his king. He returned a spade to dummy's ace and Siebert cashed the ♣A, as everyone followed, and continued with the ♣Q, pitching a losing spade as North ruffed.

North, down to one heart and three spades, returned a spade. Siebert ruffed in his hand, picked up the last heart with dummy's queen and pitched his losing diamond on the ♣10.

There are two easy ways to make seven -- get a diamond lead from West or take the successful diamond finesse. But John Blubaugh and Buddy Hanby came by the Press Room to tell us that they went the more difficult route, executing a successful squeeze operation. Incidentally, it was crucial that they make all 13 tricks -- they bid the grand.

Active Ethics

As John Coates of Toronto was counting his cards in a knockout match, Bob McPhee saw the faces of two of Coates' cards. He immediately called the director.

Director Tom Marsh of San Antonio came over, heard the story and instructed that bidding and play continue with him supervising. All parties agreed at hand's end that the unauthorized information McPhee had received had no visible effect on the outcome of the deal, so the result went into the record books.

Coates dropped by the *Daily Bulletin* office to tell the story because he was so proud of his partner. Of course this was what any player should do under the same circumstances, but the fact is that McPhee ACTUALLY DID IT!

The defense had discarded well -- East counted on partner to protect diamonds. But each declarer now led to the ♦A and back to the ♦K. Now, and only now, did the declarers lead the last club.

West had to keep his last diamond to cover dummy's 5, so he pitched a spade. So the declarers sluffed dummy's diamond. The pressure of course was too great for East -- he had to save his ♥J to cover declarer's deuce, so he too shed a spade. So the declarers took the last two tricks with dummy's ♠K and 4. A really exciting hand.

Heading for 11,000

Dallas 1997 has an excellent chance of topping 11,000 tables. The total to date is 9467 with two days to go.

Open Pairs II

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Arvedon and Falk almost were the partnership that wasn't. Arvedon woke up Friday morning with 102-degree fever. "I was really feeling terrible," he said. "I almost withdrew."

Luckily, he was feeling better by gametime and the pair went on to record their second NABC win -- in the same event. They won Open Pairs II at the Spring NABC in Cincinnati in 1994.

Arvedon says Falk is "very easy to play with, which I like. It's important in any partnership to feel you have the capability to go out and be creative."

Arvedon is a school fund-raising representative. Falk is an attorney and the author of *Spingold Challenge*, *Team Trial* and *The Bridge Player's Toolkit* (with the late Jim Jacoby).

The Facts: 2♠ made three, plus 140 for E/W. South bid 1NT, announced as 12-14 HCP and after two passes East doubled to show a hand of at least the high-card strength of the 1NT bid. West, who had not heard the announcement, Alerted the double and without being asked volunteered that it showed a one-suited hand, the E/W agreement versus a 15-17 HCP 1NT opening. South redoubled as the start of some type of possible runout. West then bid 2♣ (unnecessarily in view of the redouble) to allow partner to bid his suit. East then bid 2♠. The Director was called after the hand was over by N/S. The Director ruled that East had taken advantage of the unauthorized information from the Alert and awarded Average Plus to N/S and Average Minus to E/W.

The Appeal: Both E/W and N/S appealed the Director's ruling. East stated that he knew from the Alert and the volunteered explanation that his partner had not heard the announcement of the range of the 1NT bid. East stated he had every right to keep from being "shot in the foot" and elected to bid 2♠. N/S stated that they did not think Average Plus was an adequate result for them.

The Committee Decision: The Committee quickly decided there was no bridge reason for not passing partner's 2♣ call except for the unauthorized information available from the explanation of the Alert. East, in fact, had stated that was why he had bid 2♠. The Committee changed the contract to 2♣ down two, plus 100 for N/S.

It was emphasized to E/W that the Alert procedure was 100% for the benefit of the opponents and that they must never use this information in the subsequent bidding or play. A matchpoint procedural penalty, they were told, would have been applied in addition to the score adjustment except for the fact they seemed totally unaware of their responsibilities in these situations. They were also advised it is good practice not to explain the meaning of an Alerted call until requested.

The Facts: 4♠ doubled went down two, plus 300 for E/W. There was a break in tempo before South doubled 4♥. The Director ruled that pass was not a logical alternative for North and allowed the result to stand.

The Appeal: E/W appealed the Director's ruling. N/S claimed that South's pause before the double was 8 to 10 seconds and E/W thought the pause was 30 seconds. E/W thought pass was a logical alternative for North.

The Committee Decision: The Committee went through several steps to decide this case. First was the length of the break in tempo. The Committee believed the actual break was somewhere between the two estimated times and decided there was a clear break in tempo before the double.

Next was whether the slow double had suggested one action would be more successful than another. The Committee agreed that the speed of the double made it clear that South was uncertain about the decision to double.

Finally, the Committee had to decide if pass was a logical alternative for North. A logical alternative is an action which some number of North's peers would seriously consider without the unauthorized information. The Committee unanimously decided that it was clear from North's initial actions that he was planning on bidding until he got doubled and never intended to defend at the four level. Had the auction continued to the five level things may have been viewed differently. The Committee agreed that passing 4♥ doubled was not a logical alternative and allowed the table result 4♠ doubled down one, plus 300 for E/W to stand.

The cost of doing business with WBF

At the Board of Governors meeting last Sunday, the subject of expenses for the ACBL representatives came up. The speaker said that the cost of sending four representatives to the World Championships in Beijing in 1995 amounted to approximately \$37,000.

The cost of doing business with the WBF approached that figure, but a large proportion of the total -- more than \$15,000 -- consisted of dues to the WBF.

The actual cost of sending the ACBL representatives to Beijing was \$19,768. And last year the bill for sending five reps to the championships in Rhodes, Greece, was \$19,507. In round numbers airfare to China was \$2000 and to Rhodes \$1000. In other words, total costs for 1996 were approximately the same as they were for 1995.

The Facts: 5♣ doubled made five, plus 550 for N/S. 4♣ was Alerted and explained as an eight and one-half trick hand with hearts trump (N/S were playing Namyats). East, prior to his final pass, called the Director. The Director was recalled at the end of the play. The opening lead was the ♥Q. The Director awarded N/S Average Minus and E/W minus 550.

The Appeal: Both sides appealed the Director's ruling. N/S thought that West should have known what had happened and passed 4♥ for a good result. N/S stated they were aggressive preempters and that a hand did not exist that 4♥ could be bid naturally that had not bid some number of hearts earlier in the auction. South thought that this information with regard to opening style allowed him to act on what he thought was authorized information and bid 5♣.

West did not think that once 4♥ was passed to him that there was a likelihood that South would run from 4♥ doubled. West thought the double of 4♥ was a reasonable bid and that South should not be allowed to bid 5♣.

The Committee Decision: The Committee decided that South was in possession of unauthorized information from the Alert procedure. While the Committee had a great deal of sympathy with South's dilemma, it considered the statements South made about their aggressive bidding style to be self-serving and that there could have been some hands with long hearts that North may not have chosen to open. South had to act as if he had not heard partner's Alert.

The Committee decided that the final contract should have been 4♥ doubled. The Committee changed the contract to 4♥ doubled, down three, plus 500 for E/W -- for the non-offending side, the most favorable result that was likely had the irregularity had not occurred and for the offending side the most unfavorable result that was at all probable (Law 12C2).

Since this was a National event, both sides were required to pay a deposit of \$50 prior to the appeal. The Committee decided that both appeals had merit and both deposits were returned.

VANDERBILT ROUND OF 2 RESULTS
