## Johnson wins Open Swiss

The team captained by Perry Johnson won 92.5% of the available Victory Points in the second final session of the Open Swiss Teams to win going away. On a 20-point scale, Johnson, Jeff Meckstroth, Eric Rodwell and Paul Soloway won 18, 19, 17 and 20 VPs in the final four matches.

In second place were Brad Moss, Roy Welland, Bjorn Fallenius, Fred Gitelman, Steve Garner and Howard Weinstein.

The victory was some consolation to Meckstroth, Rodwell and Soloway, members of the Nick Nickell team which was defeated in the Vanderbilt final Friday. With the Swiss win, Rodwell recorded his 32<sup>nd</sup> North American championship, Meckstroth his 31<sup>st</sup>. Johnson won his third, including a second in the Open Swiss Teams.

## Wei-Sender squad tops Women's Swiss Teams

They needed some help on the final round, but the team led by Kathie Wei-Sender held onto a slim lead with a round to go to win the Women's Swiss Teams. ## District 13 pair takes NAP Flight B title

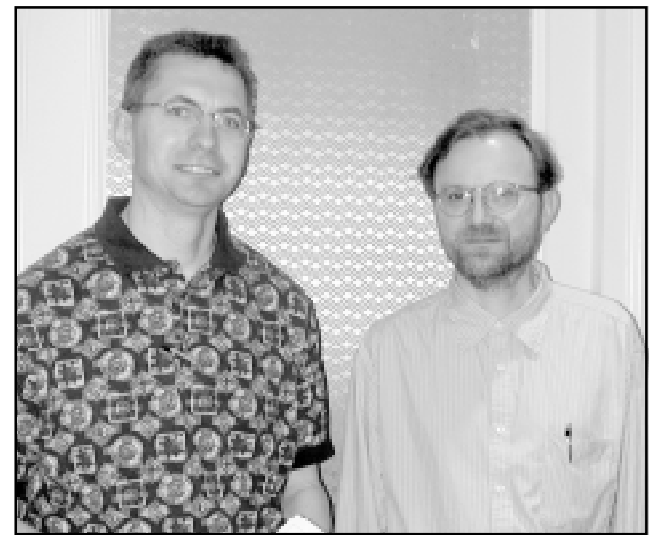
Wieslaw Kalita and Marian Krasowski, both of whom emigrated from Poland in the Eighties, parlayed two good sessions in the final of the North American Pairs, Flight B, to take the championship home to District 13.

Second place went to a District 12 pair – Robert Stayman of Birmingham MI and Frank Sensoli of St. Clair Shores MI.

Kalita lives in Woodridge IL, Krasowski in Prospect Heights IL.

A machine operator, Kalita has been in the U.S. about 18 years. Krasowski, owner of MMK Masonry Inc., has been in the U.S. 13 years.

## NAP Flight C won by District 3 players

Two players from New Jersey, the leaders at the halfway point of the North American Pairs, Flight C, hung tough to win the event representing District 3.

Tops in Flight C were Jacek Leznicki of Verona and Jerry Owczarek of Union, both natives of Poland who emigrated to the U.S. about a decade and a half ago.

Second place went to Kevin Jones and Daniel Kenney of Columbus OH.

Leznicki is an engineer for URS Corp. His partner is a manufacturing engineer. Both played bridge in Poland but did not meet until they arrived in the U.S. They met at a party and have been partners for less than three years.

They don't play a lot – about once a month – and they prefer standard American to more exotic bidding systems.

Mildred Breed, bridge teacher and two-time world champion, topped the 10,000 masterpoint mark on the final day of the 2002 Spring NABC.



Breed lives in College Station TX but will move to Austin this summer. She teaches bridge on the Internet and plays professionally. She has nine North American championships to her credit and has won two world championships – the Venice Cup in Hammamet, Tunisia, in 1997, and the Women's

Olympiad Teams in Maastricht, Netherlands, in 2000.
