Soloway: 65K and growing



Even if you're one of those players who has become completely jaded about acquiring masterpoints, hearing that Paul Soloway has more than 65,000 of them is still an eyebrow raiser.

And even if you agree with

Soloway's own modest observation that "masterpoints are an attendance award," it's clear that something beyond mere attendance is required to amass the number that he has. For Soloway, it's a first-rate talent coupled to a dedicated work ethic. Take a look:

- In world championship events, Soloway has five gold medals, all from the Bermuda Bowl. His most recent victory was in 2003 in Monte Carlo as part of the powerful squad led by Nick Nickell. Later this year, Soloway will be attending his 12th Bermuda Bowl (this year in Shanghai), and will again play with Bob Hamman on the Nickell team.

- In ACBL contests, Soloway has more than 30 NABC titles including the Grand National Teams (2), the Mixed Board-a-Match Teams (2), the Spingold Knockouts (8), the Nail Life Master Open Pairs (2), the Open Board-a-Match Teams (1), the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams (4), the Open Swiss Teams (4) and the Vanderbilt Knockouts (6). He also has hundreds of regional victories.

- Soloway is a member of the ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame, a three-time winner of the Barry Carne Top 500 contest and was ACBL Player of the Year (most points earned in national events) in 1998.

During the past decade, Soloway has averaged more than 1800 masterpoints per year. He leads the No. 2 masterpoint-holder Mike Passell by more than 6600 in lifetime points.

Despite recent health challenges, Soloway is still going strong: he's racked up some 800 points already this year.

GNT finals set

Eight teams will square off today to determine the winners of the four flights in the Grand National Teams.

In the Championship Flight, Florida will square off against New York. Florida (Larry Cohen, Michael Becker, David Berkowitz, Jeff Meckstroth, Warren Spector and Eric Rodwell) advanced by defeating a Washington DC area team. They were in control most of the way and won by a score of 107 to 77 IMPs. The New York squad (Glenn Milgrim, Chris Willenken, Roy Welland and Robert Levin) was ahead of California by 10 at the half and prevailed 170 to 142.

Another New York City area team will face a Michigan team in the Flight A final. NYC (David Gurvich, Michael Lipkin, Sorin Pleacof, Ljudmila Kamenova and Valentin Carciu) cruised to a 143 to 93 IMP victory over Colorado. Michigan (Sheldon Kirsch, Robert Cappelli, Frank Sensoli, Michael Alioto and Barry Lippitt) defeated a Pennsylvania squad 127 to 71.

Flight B features Massachusetts taking on Northern California. The Massachusetts team (Robert McCaw, Florin Constantin, Gregory Ingolia and Lewis Gamerman) advanced by winning a 60 to 52 IMP squeaker. The California team (John Barth, Jiang Chen, Mike Develin, Nongyu Li) posted a 62-43 IMP victory.

Texas will battle British Columbia in the Flight C final. Texas (George Keiller, Don Morgan, John Heath and Alan Dennis) won by 7 IMPs — 55 to 48. British Columbia (Long Xie, Roy Li, Kai Zhou and Baixiang Liu) was behind at the half, but pulled ahead in the second period to win 42 to 24. A different British Columbia squad won this event last year in Chicago.

Morse elected ACBL president



Dan Morse of Houston, Texas was elected president of the ACBL for 2008 at this week's Board of Directors in Nashville. Morse represents District 16, which is comprised by Texas (excluding the Panhandle and El Paso) and Mexico.

Morse was first elected to the Board in 1993, and is currently completing his fifth consecutive term.

Kleinplatz, Horneman lead LM Pairs

Morrie Kleinplatz and Kenny Horneman posted a 56.36% afternoon session and a very strong 69.69% game in the evening to lead the von Zedtwitz Life Master Pairs after yesterday's qualifying round.

Kleinplatz, of Windsor ON, and Horneman, of Columbia MO, had a two-session total of 819.36. Top on a board was 25.

In second with 792.84 are Adam Wildavsky of Jackson Heights NY and Doug Doub of West Hartford CT.

All three of the national-rated Life Master Pairs (the von Zedtwitz, the Bruce LM-5000 and the Young LM-1500) are three-day contests.

Of the 322 pairs who entered the contest, 156 survived to today's two-session semi-final round. That number will be cut in half for the final round on Sunday.

Jones, Fong set pace in Bruce LM Pairs

The Arkansas-based duo of Russ Jones and Jerry Fong turned in the best performance in yesterday's opening round of the Bruce LM-5000 Pairs.

Jones, of Jonesboro, and Fong, of Marianna, paired a 57.15% game in the afternoon with a 64.23% in the evening. Their two-session total was 788 on a 25 top.

In second with 777.50 are Margo Sinclair of New York City and Nikolay Demirev of the Chicago area.

One hundred eighty-eight pairs entered the event, but only 96 made the cut to today's semifinal round. Tomorrow's final will include the 26 pairs who survive today.

Young LM Pairs leaders: Dyer, Anderson

Matthew Dyer of Dorchester MA and Doug Anderson of Quincy MA are the leaders in the Young LM-1500 Pairs after Friday's qualifying round. Dyer and Anderson scored 56.08% in the first session and 59.38% in the second to post a two-session total of 751.50. Top was 25.

In second with 742.50 are Aniko Szabo and Tamas Szabo of Brookfield WI.

Of the 68 pairs who entered, 36 will play today. Sunday's two-session final will feature the 18 pairs who qualify today.

JUST FOR NEW PLAYERS

How do we choose?

There are so many events going on at once at an NABC. How should you choose which ones to play in? You might begin by thinking why you are here: to win as many masterpoints as possible? To be challenged? To try new things?



If your main objective is to win points, you're probably better off staying in the I/N events, which have lower masterpoint

limits. Of course, you received fewer points for winning or placing in limited events, but the competition is not as tough.

You will usually earn more points winning in the C stratum (or on a great day even a higher strat!) of an open event, but your chances of winning are not as great. This is a decision you and your partner will have to make. Remember, the I/N sections will play at a slightly more leisurely pace with less stress. You will see that there are a few events for which you are not eligible, such as the Life Master Pairs and some other national events that require pre-qualification. The NABC offers events at all levels every day!

Do you want to play one session or two? Nearly every scheduled session will have what are called "side games." These are single-session events for players who don't want too long a day, or who want a break. You can play morning and evening and take off the afternoon for sightseeing, if that's what you like.

If you play in an Open Side Game Series, there are overall awards available if you play in more than one session of the same series. Your top two games are kept for the comparison to determine overall winners, so if you play in three or more sessions, you get to count your best finishes. If you

have won some masterpoints in more than two sessions, you get to keep all of the points, of course.

There are three types of events going on most days: One- and two-session pairs games, knockout teams and Swiss teams. The means of deciding who plays who varies, depending on the type of event. All pairs events are stratified, whether I/N or open. The limits of the strata are posted, and you have to tell the person selling the entries which stratum you're buying. If you make an error, the computer will tell the director posting the entries.

There's no point in buying a B or A entry if you are a C. In an stratified event, you compete against all levels during the play, and at the end of the session you are first compared to your own stratum, then to higher ones. The A players must beat everyone. The B players have to outperform the other B and C players, and if they beat the A players as well, they get the A masterpoints. The C players have to beat only the other Cs to get some points, but they can win big and get the B or A points.

Knockouts are multi-session events if you keep winning. Don't sign up for a knockout unless you will be able to attend if you keep winning. You pay for the event one session at a time. KOs are the only event where the points of all four team members are totaled to place your team. There is no stratification, and the limits of your bracket in a knockout are determined by who shows up. If your bracket has 16 teams and you win the first round but lose the second, there may be a playoff available. Again, points are more limited in the lower brackets.



Swiss teams are stratified like pairs games, usually based on the point holdings of the person with the most points. Swiss teams are popular because you have more chances to win masterpoints. In a pairs game, the top 40% of the field wins points. In a KO, you have to win a 24-board match to win points. In a Swiss, if there are four rounds in the session, you have four chances to win points. There are match awards as well as overall winners.

An NABC is a good chance to venture out of your comfort zone. You have a great opportunity to try something new.

Thinking bridge

Opening lead: ♥K.

Bidding commentary: West does better in the long run to make a weak jump overcall (3♥) holding a powerful six-card suit and lacking an outside king or ace. A simple two-level overcall should have at least an outside ace or king. Using up bidding space with weak jump overcalls makes it that much harder for the opponents to untangle their riches.

Defensive commentary: When dummy tables with a relatively strong side suit plus a short side suit, the defense has to decide

whether the long suit is likely to be usable or not. East knows that dummy's diamonds, outside of the ace, are not usable. Translation: This dummy is good only for ruffing hearts. Additionally, East must consider the likelihood of West having only six hearts at this vulnerability. If so, South has three hearts. Another inference: When East sees 10 diamonds between his hand and dummy, the normal division of the other three diamonds is 2-1. If West had the singleton diamond, he probably would have led it, so East assumes South has the singleton diamond, making it even more likely that he has three hearts.

East must overtake the ♥K and shift to a

trump. West cannot switch to a trump without giving up his spade trick. After East overtakes and switches to a spade, if South finesses, West wins and returns a spade and South is down at least two.

If South rises with the ♠A and ruffs a heart, subsequent good defense defeats the contract at least one trick. If East fails to overtake, or if East overtakes and leads a club, declarer can make 4♠ by ruffing two hearts in dummy. The defenders have to realize that any club tricks they have coming are not going anywhere. It's the heart tricks that can be lost.

Ignoring Lightner

On this deal from Friday's bracketed knockouts, Bulgaria's Valio Kovachev made a sensational lead against a doubled slam.

In response to East's Lightner double West led a spade and East ruffed and tried to cash a club. South ruffed, drew trumps, discarded a diamond on a master spade and eventually ruffed a diamond in dummy for plus 1210.

At the other table the bidding followed an identical course:

Kovachev knew that his partner must be able to ruff a spade, and presumably held what he hoped would be a second trick somewhere. However, declarer had jumped to slam without using Blackwood, which strongly suggested he held a void somewhere. That figured to be in Valio's other long suit, clubs.

So after some soul searching Valio led a diamond - and declarer's goose was cooked.

He won the diamond lead and cashed two rounds of trumps. When they failed to break 2-2 declarer took a third round, cashed dummy's top spades and the ♦A. West was known to be down to two spades and one club so declarer attempted to throw West in with a club. That was two down when East took the last three tricks with the ♣A K Q - and 17 IMPs for ignoring Lightner.

Squeeze aficionados may note that on a non-diamond lead, 6♥ can always be made via a criss-cross ruffing squeeze against East.

Qualifications for teams participating in the Grand National Teams Flights B and C were earned in local-level events earlier this year.

Flight B winners will have their names engraved on the Sheinwold Trophy while the names of Flight C winners will be engraved on the Mac Nab Trophy.

Alfred Sheinwold



Alfred Sheinwold (1912-1997) was one of the greatest bridge writers in the history of the game. He was inducted into the Bridge Hall of Fame in 1996.

His syndicated bridge column was considered by many to be the best --- he had a knack for getting his point across to even the least experienced players. He managed this by making sure that every column had only one main point, marking it easier for his readers to focus.

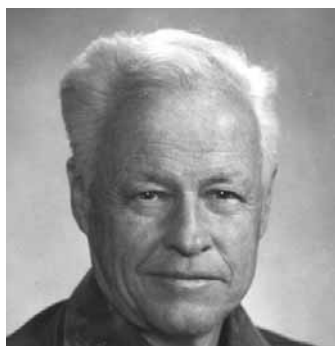
"You could read a Sheinwold column and know in an instant that nobody else could have written it," said Frank Stewart, co-author of the column. "He enlightened and entertained players through seven decades and earned millions of fans."

Sheinwold was an editor of *The Bridge World* from 1934 to 1963 and editor of *The Bridge Bulletin* from 1953 to 1958. He was also the author of perhaps the most successful bridge book ever written, *5 Weeks to Winning Bridge*, a book that sold in the millions.

Sheinwold served as chairman of the ACBL Laws Commission from 1964 to 1975, as chairman of the appeals committees at NABCs and as chairman of the ACBL Board of Governors from 1970 to 1973. He was named ACBL *Honorary Member of the Year* in 1983.

Robin Mac Nab

Robin Mac Nab (1915-1985) served as a



member of the ACBL Board of Directors from 1956 to 1981. He was ACBL president in 1965. He was a past president of the Western Conference, a member of the ACBL Laws Commission and a member of the

executive council of the World Bridge Federation.

Mac Nab, a graduate of Cornell University, was a member of the U.S. Olympic track and field squad in 1936.

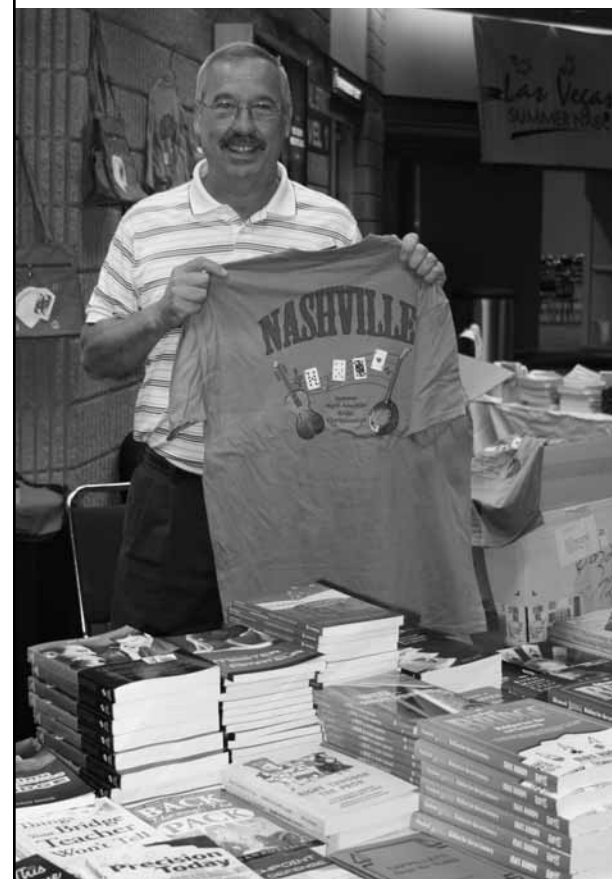

Convention card reminder

Each player is required to have a convention card filled out legibly and on the table throughout a session. Both cards of a partnership must be identical and include the first and last names of each member of the partnership.

If a director determines that neither player has a substantially completed card, the partnership may play only the ACBL Yellow Card and may use only standard carding. This restriction may be lifted only at the beginning of a subsequent round after convention cards have been properly prepared and approved by the director. Further, the partnership will receive a 1/6-board matchpoint penalty for each board played, commencing with the next round and continuing until the restriction is lifted. In IMP team games, penalties shall be at the discretion of the director.

If the director determines the partnership has at least one substantially completed convention card but has not fully complied with ACBL

regulations, the director may give warnings or assign such penalties as he deems to be appropriate under the circumstances.

The objective of these warnings and penalties is the encouragement of full compliance with ACBL regulations.

Entries

All North American championships with no upper masterpoint limitation \$18

(Note: only ACBL members are eligible to play in NABC+ events.)

Other North American championships \$16.50

(Note: only ACBL members are eligible to play in these events.)

Regional championships \$15.50 for ACBL members, \$17.50 for all others

All other events \$14.50 for ACBL members, \$16.50 for all others.

Bid Box Alerts and Announcements

When using bid boxes, ACBL suggests that players tap the Alert strip and say "Alert" at the same time.

When making an Announcement, use the Announcement word --- such as "transfer" --- and tap the Alert strip at the same time.

A player who Alerts or Announces a bid should make sure his opponents are aware that an Alert or Announcement has been made.

Scores as reported in the Daily Bulletin are subject to change because of score changes or corrections. Therefore, the masterpoint awards as shown are also subject to change.

Shuttle service

A system of shuttle services is being provided throughout the tournament to assist you in transportation needs. These shuttles cover the following:



1. Service to or from the Nashville Convention Center and the host hotels in the downtown area (Sheraton, Best Western, Doubletree, Courtyard by Marriott (4th & Church), Hampton Inn (behind Hall of Fame) and

2. Dinner service to restaurant areas.

Please note – While these services are provided as a convenience to help you enjoy your visit with us, we are not equipped to move everybody. All of the unattached host hotels and many fine restaurants are within a relatively easy walk from the Convention Center. The transportation is there in case you find it too steep, too hot, your puppies are just too tired, or you can't believe you ate the whole thing. If it rains, be prepared, because not all will be able to ride.

What to Look For

Service can be provided by any of three shuttles:

1. Large - Anchor 55 passenger – usually white,

2. Medium - White Mini Bus with blue trim (yes, this is a used vehicle),

3. Small- Black 15 passenger van.

Look for signs in the front curb side window (opposite the driver). Each has a "Bridge Buggy" sign as well as another sign to identify the mission (route) it is currently on.

Hotel Service

Service begins at 8 each morning, and it will run continuously through most of the day. There will be planned breaks in service for an hour at 10 a.m. and for a half hour at 1 p.m. Service will be more frequent before and after the bridge events.

Hotels served include the Sheraton, Best Western, Holiday Inn Express, Hampton Inn (4th

and Korean War Veterans), Courtyard Inn (4th and Church) and Doubletree. Guests at the Wyndham should walk to the Holiday Inn.

LAST CALL FOR SERVICE IS 12:45 a.m. Dinner Shuttle

1. Downtown loop that covers lower Broad, 2nd Avenue, Church Street and other locations that are within the nearby area (frequency – about 30 minutes). Operates from 4 to 9 p.m.

2. West End - High concentration of some of Nashville's finest restaurants (frequency – about 40 minutes). Operates from 4 to 9 p.m.

3. Special destinations – look for additional information to come

Convention Center is the Hub

The Convention Center is the hub of the action. The dinner routes will generally operate independently from the hotel service. So, consider the Convention Center a transfer point if you want to get to both destinations. Important: The Convention Center loading and unloading point is the Commerce Street entrance.

LP Field Parking

If not staying downtown, you can park in Lot A / B at the Titans stadium lot at LP Field. This is an existing service for people who work downtown, and is available for us during the tournament.

Just check in with the security guard. Cost is generally free, but if the lot fills, the overflow lot is \$1. They have an existing shuttle service that costs \$1 each way. Look for the bright yellow Park It bus.

There is a change, however, from previous information published (web site, etc.). They will not be altering their route during the tournament. The nearest stops to the convention center are 4th & Church (Courtyard by Marriott) where you can transfer to our hotel shuttle service. Or, you can exit at the next stop, 3rd and Commerce. Both stops are about two blocks away, but 3rd and Commerce is generally uphill.

The yellow shuttle service runs from 7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. Return service is from either of the aforementioned stops. The frequency is normally every 20 minutes, but every 10 minutes at peak, from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. and from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.

After 6:30 p.m. use the Downtown Dinner route, and ask the driver to drop you off at LP Field. After 10 p.m., request service from either the driver of either the Minibus or the Passenger Van as they stand or stop at the Convention Center.

Important – this parking option is not available on either Sunday or the second Saturday. If you are staying at the Ramada Ltd., call Mr. Wilson (the day before, please) for a transportation appointment at 615-525-7024.

Important – the bright yellow buses will not run the first Saturday, but will be replaced with one

of our buses, with service about every 30 minutes. (Free that day!)

Vanderbilt Bridge Club

You can park and ride from the Vanderbilt Bridge Club.

Departure times: 8 a.m. & 11 a.m.

Return service:

1. Through the West End Dinner route (ask the driver to drop you off),

2. Midnight from the Convention Center.

Frequency of Service

Generally, the services are to be provided in a continuous loop, and there will not be scheduled arrival or departure times. No announcement will be made in the hotels. **Please: it is important that you actively look for the bus so that you make the connection!** The bus will wait only a couple of minutes at each "stop," and if no patrons are seen, the driver will move on to the next location. Especially on the dinner routes, be prepared to get the driver's attention. Many of these streets are very busy or narrow, and they are not conducive to any type of long-term stop or blockage of other traffic.

Hotel Service Frequency (note – these are estimates)
