Honorary Member is Sidney Lazard

He is a member of the Hall of Fame. He captained the United States to the Bermuda Bowl championship in Monte Carlo earlier this month. He was honored by the International Bridge Press Association for Best Bidding Sequence of the Year (Romex Award) in Monte Carlo. A few years ago he established a major award for sportsmanship in the name of his late son. And now he has been named ACBL Honorary Member of the Year for 2004.

We're talking about Sidney Lazard, one of the all-time bridge greats. He has won at least one North American championship in each of the past six decades. He has been playing bridge since 1945 - duplicate since 1948. Over the years he has regularly partnered newcomer players at club games in New Orleans and Dallas.

At the world level he has captained the United States to Bermuda Bowl championships twice - 2000 in Bermuda and in Monte Carlo this year. He was a member of the U.S. team that finished second in the Bermuda Bowl in 1959. He had world championship thirds in the 1969 Bermuda Bowl and the

Gold medal for USA1 in Senior Bowl

USA I was the victor in the Senior Bowl at the World Championships in Monte Carlo last month.

The Americans' opponent in the final round was France, which was in second place and which had led through much of the competition. France needed a strong triumph in that final match to win the title. If they won by 20 IMPs, the championship would be theirs. If they won by less or lost, the United States would win.

France led by 10 at the half. All they had to do was to repeat that performance in the second half. But that didn't happen. The boards in the second half were flat - 10 of them were pushes. France made two small gains, but the gold medals went to the Americans. In fact, France edged USA II by only half a Victory Point for the silver medal.

The winners are Gaylor Kasle, Roger Bates, Steve Robinson, Kit Woolsey, Garey Hayden and Grant Baze. The silver medalists are Pierre Adad, Maurice Aujaleu, Guy Lasserre, Philippe Poizat, Christian Mari and Francois Leenhardt, with Yves Aubry as non-playing captain.

Boyce Holleman

Boyce Holleman of Gulfport MS, a force in Mid-South bridge and legal circles for more than five decades, died Friday in Houston TX. He was 79.

Visitation will be from 5-7 Monday at Bradford-O'Keefe Funeral Home in Gulfport. Services will be at 11 a.m. Tuesday at First Baptist Church in Gulfport.

"Boyce loved bridge," recalled longtime friend Patty Johnson, an ACBL National Tournament Director. "He was a great friend of Oswald Jacoby and he loved to play bridge with him. You never saw Boyce that he didn't have 10 or 12 good stories."

Holleman also appeared on television in two episodes of "In the Heat of the Night" - naturally, playing "a distinguished Southern attorney," said Johnson.

"My daddy used to travel in Mississippi and whenever he was in Gulfport, he would check to see if Boyce was going to be in court that day. If he was, Daddy would take the afternoon off and go and watch Boyce in action."

Louise Childs Freed

Louise Childs Freed, a North American bridge champion, chair of the Dallas Spring NABC in 1997 and 'best friend' to many in the bridge world, died Sunday in Los Angeles after a long battle with ovarian cancer.



Her husband, Gene Freed, and former husband, Derrell Childs, were with her. Funeral services will be held in Dallas after the completion of the NABC.

She also leaves two sons and daughters-in-law, Paul and Tippi Ellis of Arlington TX and Mark and Denise Ellis of Boston, and two granddaughters, Sami, 4, of Arlington and Lexi, 2, of Boston.

The granddaughters, said longtime friend Charlotte Blaiss, "were the delight - the total delight - of her life."

Freed won the Senior Swiss Teams at the 2002 Summer NABC in Washington DC. Her teammates were Gene Freed, Childs, Roger Clough, Rebecca Clough and Nels Erickson.

Freed was chair of the last Dallas NABC - "one of the best nationals ever," said District 16 Director Dan Morse. "She was a lovely lady and

Playing for USA II were Dennis Dawson, Arnold Fisher, Zeke Jabbour, Clement Jackson, John Mohan and John Sutherlin, with Carolyn Lynch as npc.

The Americans weren't present at the Victory Banquet — their event had finished a week earlier. So of course they couldn't receive their medals.

ACBL President Al Levy and his wife Beverly took care of that last night. Beverly hung the medals on the players as Al called them forward.

All six of the gold medalists were previous winners of world championships. Baze and Hayden won the Senior Bowl in Paris two years ago. Bates and Kastle triumphed in the 1994 Rosenblum Teams. Bates also won a bronze medal in the World Open Pairs in 1978. Woolsey and Robinson were victors in that memorable 1986 Rosenblum Teams, and they also won the Senior Olympiad Teams in 2000.

The best contract

Michael Polowan made a good bid on Board 10 of the first final session of the Life Master Open Pairs that enabled us to earn 89 out of a possible 90 matchpoints.

Correctly realizing that a nine-trick game might prove easier than 4♥, Polowan tried 3♠. I was delighted to bid the notrump game.

It turns out that it takes a diamond lead to beat 3NT. However, West not surprisingly started with the ♠6. East had to play the 7 to hold me to nine tricks, but he went up with the 10. I cashed six hearts and the ♦A, forcing West to come down to five cards. He kept three spades and two clubs, so I threw him in with the ♠9. After he cashed three spades he had to lead away from his ♣K, so I wound up with 10 tricks.

Those golden 10s!

It's great to have a cooperative partner. Kyle Larsen didn't have much of a hand on this deal from the second final session of the Life Master Open Pairs – but he had two red 10s. That was enough to earn a top on this board for him and Jo Morse, winners of the event.

Nowadays you almost never hear Pass-Pass-Pass after an opening 1NT. West was only 4-4 in the blacks, but he still reopened with 2♠. Morse doubled for takeout, but East redoubled to show cards. Larsen could have bid 3♣, but he decided to pass. When Morse bid 3♦ Larsen was quite sure his side had a fit in hearts, so he bid 3♥, which was doubled.

West led a trump, and East ducked dummy's jack. Larsen led a diamond, and East flew with the ace to lead a club. West switched to a spade, and Larsen forced out the trump ace. East switched back to a club, won by West who led a third club. Larsen ruffed high, drew trumps and passed the ♦Q, East could play his ace whenever, but Larsen would ruff, cross to dummy with the high spade and run the good diamonds for nine tricks and a plus of 530.

A breath-taking adventure

Bracket 2 of the Educational Foundation Knockout Teams was the most exciting event ever for Mike Miller of Temple TX, Jim Bauer and Charles Richards of Dallas, and Ray Baughman of Arlington TX. Three of the four matches were breath-taking.

They got to bed very late on Thursday night when they played their first match. When they compared scores after regulation, they were tied. A four-board playoff followed – tied again. This time it was a two-board playoff. The contract in both rooms on both deals was 3NT, but the Miller team won by scoring an extra overtrick on each deal.

The quarterfinal match was sort of routine, but they thought they were through when they compared halfway through the semifinal. They were down 34! But they returned to the tables determined to make a comeback – and they did. They outscored their foes, 44-4, to win by 6.

In the final they were trailing at the half again. However, the following deal made the difference.

Bauer's 4♣ was a splinter. 4♦ was a cuebid, and then Bauer bid 5♣, confirming a club void. That was all Miller needed. Bauer didn't have high cards in either minor, so he must have aces and kings in the majors to have an opening bid. Suiting thought to action, he leaped to the grand slam. That was worth 14 IMPs when their opponents stopped in 4♠ at the other table, making six. That was enough to win the event.

Action unlimited

Talk about competitive hands! This deal from the second final session of the Life Master Open Pairs often got all the way to the seven level.

In general there were two scenarios – tables at which North made a preemptive jump overcall in spades and tables at which he did not.

In the first, imagine South's dismay when North bids 2♠! Usually East-West found their great heart fit, but there was no way non-vul North-South was going to let East-West play this hand at any reasonable level.

In the second scenario, imagine North's dismay when South bids spades! Once again East-West were going to have to do a lot of bidding to buy the contract.

Often the final contract was 6♥, and often this slam went down. Declarer had to guess to finesse North for the trump queen because the diamond finesse was doomed to fail. Of course the spade save was a good one – North-South lose only one trick in each side suit.

When the event winners, Jo Morse and Kyle Larsen, held the North-South cards, they weren't satisfied to let East-West play at the six level – they went on to 6♠. Morse and Larsen wound up with a fine board when their opponents decided to bid the grand and of course they went down. But they only went down one – declarer guessed the heart situation correctly. Morse and Larsen would have received a very bad score if they had failed to bid once more in spades.

Parking information

The Facts: 4♠ made five, +450 for N/S. The opening lead was the ♣2. The Director was called after the 4♠ bid. There was an agreed huddle before the 3NT bid. South said that with two doubletons she was never passing 3NT. The Director ruled that pass was a logical alternative to bidding 4♠ (Law 16) and that the 4♠ bid was made more attractive by the break in tempo. The contract was changed to 3NT down one, +50 for E/W (Law 12C2).

The Appeal: N/S appealed the Director's ruling. West did not attend the hearing. South explained that she would never stay in notrump with two doubletons. She did not consider bidding 3♠ over 1♠. She said her partnership played in lots of 4-3 fits. North said she knew her partner had 17+ points and she (North) was trying to decide whether to bid 3♠, 4♦ or 3NT. She finally decided to bid 3NT.

The Decision: The Committee determined that passing 3NT was a logical alternative for South. They believed that every South would pass a promptly bid 3NT and that the slow 3NT suggested that bidding on was likely to be more successful than passing. Although this South said she would never pass 3NT, that option was removed once her partner broke tempo. The contract was changed to 3NT down one, +50 for E/W. The Committee also determined that pass was so clearly a logical alternative and that since N/S had raised no new arguments beyond those already discussed with the Director and the Screening Director, the appeal lacked substantial merit. Therefore, N/S were each assessed an Appeal Without Merit Warning.

New Orleans program receives \$1,000

The Senior Companion Program of the New Orleans Council on Aging has received a \$1,000 check as the recipient of the 2003 District 10 Charity Grant from the ACBL Charity Foundation.

The presentation was made Sunday by Jayne Thomas, president of the ACBL Charity Foundation, and Chuck Wilkinson, District 10 Director.

Accepting the check was Joirthel Becknell, program director of the Senior Companion Program of the New Orleans Council on Aging.

Taking part in the presentation were Al Levy, ACBL President, and Sandie Guthans, a member of

the New Orleans unit and the editor of the New Orleans Council on Aging newsletter, *Senior Leader*.

The grant was set up by the trustees of the ACBL Charity Foundation, who authorized each member of the ACBL Board of Directors to designate a charity to receive \$1,000 in 2003.

Wilkinson thanked the trustees of the Charity Foundation. "This program is an excellent way for the ACBL to grant monies to deserving charities at the grass roots level," he said. "This program should be continued, even expanded, in future years."

Bramley, Lazard Win Romex Award

Bart Bramley and Sidney Lazard are the winners of the 2003 Romex Award for the best bid hand of the year. They accepted their prize at the annual meeting of the International Bridge Press Association in Monte Carlo earlier this month. Bramley received an additional award as the author of the prize-winning article. George Rosenkranz is the sponsor of this annual IBPA award.

It is rare to see an auction with seven natural bids reach the top-scoring contract despite intervention when three strains and two different levels are under consideration. This was beautifully handled by both players.

Here is Bramley's report:

The Blues

Sidney eschewed opening 2♣ because the opponents were at favorable vulnerability and he had a spade void. When the opponents jammed the auction, Sidney still had a big problem at his second turn. His delicate 4♦ bid was a great solution, as it was natural, forcing and low. 4♦ may look obvious, but ask around and you'll find out differently.

My 4♥ preference was conservative, but I feared bidding more on a potential misfit. Luckily for us, the 4♥ bid relieved Sidney of any concerns about hearts running. Sidney's next call, the 4♠ cuebid, continued his gradual approach to a complex hand.

Having pulled in a notch earlier, I was comfortable driving to slam over 4♠, but I was still not sure of the best trump suit. I chose the descriptive 6♣ call, simultaneously accepting the slam try, show-

ing a strong suit and offering 6♣ as a choice of contract. Note that 6♣ could be the winning contract opposite

♠ A Q x x x x, ♥ A K 10 x x, ♦ x x or the like.

That was good news for Sidney, who knew that the ♣K was huge, so he confidently bid 7♥. Equally confidently, I converted to 7NT based on possession of the ♠A. I knew Sidney held solid hearts, the ♦A and one of the minor suit kings.

Note that our auction was completely natural except for 4♠, a cuebid of a void, hardly a big contribution to a contract of 7NT. We used no ace-asking bid and cuebid no aces. Every bid but 4♠ showed a suit, and our last several bids were all offers to play. Yet when we reached 7NT we both knew it was cold!

There was a small point in the play. On the spade lead I pitched a heart from dummy. Sidney, who had been looking nervous, perked up and said, "That's a good sign!" I didn't need the seventh heart for 13 tricks, but if hearts had been 4-0, I could still have made the contract with the diamond finesse and a squeeze if LHO had

♠ J x x x, ♥ J 9 8 x, ♦ K 9 x x, ♣ x, a holding consistent with the bidding.

Plus 2220 was worth 42 on a 51 top.

1998 Rosenblum Teams.

In ACBL tournaments he has wins in two Spingolds, two Reisingers and one Vanderbilt. The Reisingers came 38 years apart — 1960 and 1998. He also has taken the gold medal five times in the Mixed Teams. Other victories include the Blue Ribbon Pairs in 2002 with Bart Bramley, the Grand National Pairs with Jack Lanoue and the Pair Trials with George Rapee.

What got Sidney started in bridge? His cousin, Betty Goldstein, was teaching bridge at an Air Force base, and she thought Lazard would like the game, so she got him going. Cards are in Lazard's family tree — "My grandfather Joe was a great card player. My father, Jules, was a good card player, too."

He remembers playing draw poker with his grandfather when he was 6 — they were playing very seriously for matchsticks. He chortled aloud as he asked for two cards. He was about to learn a little something about strategy. His grandfather had two pair, but he was sure that Lazard had to have three of a kind, so he threw away one of his pairs and kept two aces. He drew a third ace and Lazard was devastated.

"I really enjoy bridge," said Lazard. "I like the pure reasoning. I like coming up with the answers. I like to test myself. I like the competition."

He's had some interesting experiences over the years. He remembers what a tough time he had playing against Al Roth and Tobias Stone back in 1963. He got wiped out the first two times he played against them. He was determined to do better the third time — but it was even worse. He came up against them a fourth time, and it was the same old story.

At one point, Roth asked what the requirements were for one of Lazard's partner's bids. Stone said, "He doesn't know. He's quite stupid." Lazard "accidentally" swept a full ashtray into Stone's lap. "I'm also very sloppy," he said.

"After the story got out, I got fan mail from all over the country congratulating me on finding such a fine response to Stone's comment," said Lazard.

He was playing against John Crawford in a Vanderbilt final, and his team was very much the underdog. Crawford asked him to bet on the match. Lazard didn't want to, but he feared his partner would think he had a negative outlook if he refused, so he said OK. Crawford reached into his pocket and pulled out a wad of bills totaling in the thousands. "There's my bet," said Crawford. No happy ending — Lazard lost.

Lazard also recalls the time he was a member of a seven-man team that won an NABC Men's Team event. Seven? You can't have more than six on a team!

What happened is that Lazard passed out during the first of four sessions and was able to return only briefly in the second session. Three different substitutes took his place in the last three sessions, and the combination won the event.

He has enjoyed many, many partners over the years. Here are some of his favorites:

In the Fifties: Bill Hanna, Paul Allinger and John Fisher.

In the Sixties: Edgar Kaplan and George Rapee.

In the Seventies: Frank Hoadley and his son, Sidney Lazard Jr.

In the Eighties: Jack Lanoue

In the early Nineties: Edgar Kaplan and Norman Kay.

In the late Nineties through today: Bart Bramley.

The title of Honorary Member, awarded by the American Bridge League 1927-1936 and by the American Contract Bridge League since 1937, is bestowed for distinguished services to bridge.

she'll definitely be missed."

Blaiss remembered Freed as "the best friend I ever had. It'll be hard to live in a world without her and her 'punching in'. She'd call almost every day and say, 'Just punching in'."

"She thought of everybody else before she thought of herself," said Robin Klar, another long-time friend.

Before Freed married and moved to Los Angeles about three years ago, she was a member of a Dallas women's bridge club that met monthly (a feature photo of the Dallas Girls Bridge Club appeared in the Daily Bulletin during the Dallas NABC).

Its members were Ellen Adams, Sylvia Besinger, Joan Jackson, Petra Hamman, Nancy Passell, Peggy Sutherlin, Beth Bromberg, Grace Hunt, Judy Lottridge and Eileen Smith.

Bromberg spoke of her friend, saying, "It was a privilege to spend time with Louise in her final days. I admired her for her dignity."

Jackson also visited Freed. "Louise was in the hospital the whole time I was there. Every day she would say, 'where should you go for lunch today?' and 'where should you go for dinner today?' I would have been happy with hospital cafeteria food but it made her happy to send us off to nice lunches and dinners."

Freed, added Jackson, was "very perfect Southern lady funny. She was a good, warm, loyal friend."

Amy Downing of Memphis, a former Texas resident, recalls a regional in El Paso in the mid-Seventies. "I was publicity chairman for the regional and I took photos of all the winners. In those days, the *Bridge Bulletin* published pictures of all the regional winners.

"Something happened to Louise and Derrell's picture - of all the winners whose pictures were in the *Bulletin*, only Louise and Derrell were left out. Afterwards, whenever Louise would see me, she'd just shake her finger at me and laugh."
