## Jacobs romps to Open BAM win

George Jacobs and Co. won 21.5 boards out of a possible 26 — an 82.69% result — in the first final session and coasted to a win in the Open Board-a-Match Teams.

The team — Jacobs-Ralph Katz, Alfredo Versace-Lorenzo Lauria, Norberto Bocchi-Giorgio Duboin — posted a final total of 40.52 to 36.10 for runners-up Reese Milner, Sam Lev, Brian Glubok, Michael Kwiecien and Jacek Pszczola.

Third, with 35.13, was the Turkish squad of Suleyman Kolota, Yalcin Atabey, Enver Koksoy and Irfan Dogan.

The Jacobs squad has quite a history in the Open BAM. In 2001 they lost the event by less than one-hundredth of a board. In 2002 they finished three and a half boards ahead of the field.

Going into yesterday's two final sessions, the team was third. In the first final session, Jacobs-Katz and Versace-Lauria romped to a spectacular win: 21.5 boards out of a possible 26. In the second final session, the team won 15 out of 26 boards. That was good for a 4.42-board win.

## Steiner squad claims Women's BAM

With one round to go in the Marsha May Sternberg Women's Board-a-Match Teams, the team captained by Carlyn Steiner had a slim lead of .70 of a board. When the round was over, the team had increased its lead to 1.20 boards and claimed the win.

Playing with Steiner were Marinesa Letizia, Jill Meyers-Randi Montin and Tobi Sokolow-Janice-Seamon Molson. They posted a final total of 38.13 to 36.93 for the runners-up: Valerie Westheimer-Judi Radin and Mildred Breed-Shawn Quinn.

The Steiner squad, playing together as a team since the first of the year, has posted an impressive record: second in the Women's Swiss Teams, second in the Wagar Women's Knockout Teams and now first in the Marsha May Sternberg Women's Board-a-Match Teams.

The win was an emotional one for the Steiner squad. Steiner's husband, George Steiner, died earlier this month and a memorial service was held here at the NABC on Sunday night. Steiner returned to her Seattle home early Tuesday to be with her daughter, Joanna.

## Blue Ribbon Pairs: last year's nail-biter

Sidney Lazard and Bart Bramley, standing second in the field, made the most of a rare opportunity on the final round of the Edgar Kaplan Blue Ribbon Pairs last year to romp home with one of the most prestigious titles in the bridge world.

The rare opportunity was the chance to play the first-place pair in the final two boards of the event. The winners took the lion's share of the match-points against Chris Willenken and Glenn Milgrim to win by nearly a full board (51 top).

### The event

The Edgar Kaplan Blue Ribbon Pairs ranks with the Life Master Pairs as the most prestigious — and toughest — pair events on the ACBL calendar. Like the LM Pairs, the Blue Ribbon Pairs is played over three days and includes two qualifying, two semifinal and two final sessions.

Entry is restricted to winners and runners-up in regional championships — plus high finishers in North American championships, members of current Grand National district championship teams, members of current official teams representing ACBL and the top 100 lifetime masterpoint holders.

The Blue Ribbon Pairs was renamed the Edgar Kaplan Blue Ribbon Pairs in 1999 to honor one of bridge's all-time great players, writers, administrators and the authority on the laws of the game.

Kaplan was recognized as the world's foremost authority on the laws of duplicate and rubber bridge. He became co-chairman of the ACBL Laws Commission in 1978 and was co-chairman of the WBF Laws Commission at the time of his death.

He was named ACBL Honorary Member in 1993. In 1995 he was inducted into the ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame and the WBF Hall of Fame.

### The trophy

The event is contested for the Cavendish Trophy, awarded for the National Open Pair Championship and donated by the Cavendish Club of New York in 1928. Since 1963, the trophy has

been awarded to winners of the Blue Ribbon Pairs.

## Missing a Chance

I missed my chance here but so did the majority of the field on offense and defense.

On the ♠10 lead, you cover with dummy's queen to encourage the defense to play three rounds of spades. West should not bite — how could he realistically expect to promote a trump here?

The winning defense is to shift to a diamond — this sets the hand when partner has the ♦K. Of course if partner has the ♦A all defenses work.

But at my table, West did play a third spade. I ruffed high and East pitched a discouraging ♣7. I should have decided that meant he probably had five clubs and, if so, maybe the best play is to pass the ♣Q at once. Then you win the diamond or spade return and run the trumps to squeeze East in the minors.

Of course, there is still a defense when West wins the ♣K. Return a spade and you cut declarer's communications. Would West have done that? We'll never know. I chose to lead a club to the queen and gave up without a struggle.

Joe Grue actually found the play against Joe Kivel. Nicely done!





### White tops 10,000

Michael White, whose first duplicate game produced an unimpressive 33% score, went on to better scores and recently racked up his 10,000th masterpoint.

White recalls that first game, played while a student at Georgia Tech: "I came in last but I had fun and I came back."

He competed as a Junior player while a student at the University of Tennessee and now lives in Atlanta where he plays bridge professionally and sells used books.

He's been active in Mid-Atlantic bridge administration and has represented District 7 in North American competition. So far, he hasn't won a national title but has more than 100 regional wins.

White credits his grandmother, Ester White, for his competitiveness. "She taught me how to play casino when I was four."

He took up bridge in 1984 and plans to continue. "I love the game and I'll play it all my life."

Playing six-handed in the Sunday-Monday Knockout Teams, Ruth Stober and I came into the second half of our first match facing a major deficit - we were down 27 IMPs. We were quite sure we picked up 13 IMPs on the first board, and it looked as if the second board would be a push.

Then along came this deal:

 Ruth, knowing we still needed some pickups, bid the grand slam and guessed the ♣Q. That meant she could pitch her diamond loser on the long club. A diamond lead might even beat 6♠.

Unbelievably, after only three boards, we felt we were in the lead! We just played tight bridge the rest of the way and that was good enough to win the match by 9 IMPs.

### Ditch those hearts

Sometimes the first board is so rewarding that you know you're going to have a good session. Playing with Sam Lev, the mercurial New York superstar, you don't ever want to go down in a contract that can be made. Consider this opening deal from the evening session of the North American Board-a-Match Teams:

Opening lead: ♣ 4

Sam and I bid briskly to 6♠ after I opened 2NT. Sam bid Stayman and invited a slam. I accepted happily, holding superb trumps and a maximum point count.

I rode the club lead around to my hand, winning the 10 with my king. I banged down the high trumps, hoping to make all 13 tricks if the trumps split 3-2. When RHO showed out on the second round, I could see a certain trump loser. The ♥A represented a second trick for the defense.

I now weighed the two possible ways to overcome the heart loser. If the clubs were divided 3-3, I could discard dummy's stiff heart on the fourth round of clubs. This was my plan until I cashed the third high spade and RHO discarded the ♣7.

My hopes for a 3-3 club division were now diminished from fair to almost impossible. Based on the club spots, I decided to play for LHO to follow to precisely four rounds of diamonds. I played the ♦K, the ♦Q (overtaken in dummy), followed by dummy's ♦J. When RHO showed out, confirming the unlikely distribution I was hoping for, I knew I would make the slam. LHO's decision not to lead the ♥A was quite reasonable - he feared that if he led the ace, I might infer that he thought he had a possible trump trick and play accordingly to pick up his jack of trumps.

Once RHO discarded the ♣7 on the third round of trump, I considered a favorable club division too remote to hope for, so I went for the diamond play instead. I made 980 on this hand and we ended up with 19 1/2 of a possible 26 for the session.

To paraphrase Sherlock Holmes: Once you eliminate the impossible, play for the unlikely.

On a diamond lead to the ace and the ♣Q, followed by the ♣A and ♣K, Rose ruffed and drew two rounds of trumps. When East discarded, she could infer that West was 3-1-4-5.

Since East had doubled 1♠, he could have king-fourth or jack-fourth or king-jack-fourth.

Whichever it was, Rose seemed to have the bases covered when she ran the ♥Q. East ducked but the ♥Q scooped up the jack and now Rose could draw the last trump and finesse again in hearts for her 10 tricks and a 75% board.
