Pavliceks top LM Open Pairs

When they folded up their cards after the final board of the Bobby Nail Life Master Open Pairs, Richard Pavlicek and Richard Pavlicek Jr. thought there was no way they could win. On the last round, they went down in a game and let a game make that could have been defeated.

When the scores were tallied, however, the father-son combo found themselves in first, right where they had been, albeit by a tiny margin, after the first final session.

Second place in the event went to Mark Aquino of Jamaica Plain MA and Jonathan Green of Kingston NY.

With the victory, the younger Pavlicek racked up his first North American championship in an unrestricted event (he previously won the Mini-Spangold). Dad added his 11th major championship, but it was his first pairs win after 10 team titles.

If not for Rich's 9-month-old son, Seth, the younger Pavlicek might not have made it to Orlando. He is starting a career as a software engineer for Verity Inc. in Sunnyvale CA, so he hasn't been playing a lot of bridge. He wanted his dad and mother, Mable, to see the latest addition to the family, so they traveled to Orlando for the NABC.

Bridge show debuts in UK

During the World Bridge Olympiad, concluded in Istanbul Nov. 6, a large television production crew spent considerable time and energy filming the tournament for a show to be aired on Sky Sports, a U.K.-based satellite provider.

Zia Mahmood, who was involved in the production, reports that the first of six shows has aired in Great Britain. In all, there will be 22 broadcasts over the next two weeks, highlighting the competition in Istanbul but also featuring interviews and analyses.

Zia said he received a report from a friend who saw the first show. "He gave it a seven out of 10," said Zia.

The production company, New Bridge Assets, plans productions from other tournaments and hopes to find a market for bridge shows in the U.S. NBA is also interested in a similar production on the Cavenish Invitational tournament in Las Vegas next spring.

TD Johnston earns Jane Johnson Award



Veteran Tournament Director Ron Johnston has been selected as the field winner of the ACBL's 2004 Jane Johnson Award, given to the employee who exemplifies the kind of dedication to customer service that

the late head of the Club Membership Department exhibited.

The ACBL selects two employees each year for the Jane Johnson Award, one from the Headquarters staff in Memphis and one from the field. Terry Norton was announced as Headquarters winner earlier this year.

Johnston, of Cedar Falls IA, is an associate national director who has been full time with the ACBL since 1992. He has been working as a TD since the late Seventies.

Johnston's selection was popular among his peers.

New York-Vancouver duo win Non-LM Pairs

Despite playing only two sessions together before Orlando, Jadwiga Polujan and Bernie Weiss caught fire in the second final session to win the Skinny Miles Non-Life Master Pairs with ease.

Their final score of 288.30 (8 top) was well ahead of runners-up William Thorp of Dana Point CA and Dorothy Conway of Ottawa ON.

Polujan and Weiss met at the 2004 Summer NABC in New York, getting together through a mutual friend, and did well, winning a one-session 199er game. Before they departed New York, Weiss asked Polujan if she would be interested in playing in Orlando. She said yes – if she made it to the Fall NABC.

Both players had a long way to go. Polujan lives in North Vancouver BC, Weiss in Manhattan.

Polujan left her native Poland about 20 years ago, and is now a housewife in British Columbia. She played party bridge in Poland before she left,

Hinkley, Schuld top LM Women's Pairs

Cynthia Hinckley of San Juan, Puerto Rico, and Diana Schuld of Glen Head NY were ecstatic at about 11:30 last night. They had just learned that they had won their first North American championship – the Life Master Women's Pairs. They were surprised because they thought they had botched too many boards. On the next-to-last round, one bewailed missing a game. The other said, "It doesn't matter – we're not going to win." They're glad they were wrong.

The finish was very close. Hinckley and Schuld finished only nine points ahead of the runners-up from Israel, Migry Zur Campanile and Pamela Granovetter. Only five points further back were Lisa Berkowitz of Old Tappan NJ and Joann Glasson of Pennington NJ. Those numbers are only a small fraction of top on a board, which was 38.

Frank Schuld, Diana's husband, was the catalyst for this partnership. He had played many times with Hinckley, and he suggested that Diana set up a partnership with her. "You won't have any problems – just play like you play with me."

Hinckley's big moment in bridge came when she was eight months pregnant with her fifth child and needed one black point to make Life Master. She wanted that gold pin before the baby was born,

You can be aggressive with some partners

I took a somewhat aggressive bid on this deal, but I've seen Ralph Cohen play a hand before.

Ralph got a helpful heart lead to the 9 and his 10. He led a club to the king and ducked a club to East. On the diamond shift West took his queen and ace before switching to hearts. Cohen ducked and later was able to cash his clubs and his diamond winner to put the squeeze on East, who of course was unable to protect both majors.

East was very scathing of West's failure to play a heart before cashing the ♦A. Cohen had an answer to that.

"If West wins the ♦Q and leads a heart to East's 8, East would play another diamond to partner's ace so West can lead a third heart," said Cohen. "I can still win the ♥A and the squeeze still bites. Even if West ducks the second diamond, this would be the ending:

"I can cash two clubs and force East to discard a spade and a diamond. Then I can endplay East by putting him in with a spade and forcing him to lead a heart into my tenace."

Maybe West has to duck the first diamond?

Bridge Today Daily - There's More Than One Way to Get a Ruff

Whoever said "there's more than one way to skin a cat" was right, I suppose, but on defense at the bridge table "more than one way" causes confusion. This is one reason why my wife and I wrote a book about 10 years ago, entitled *A Switch in Time*. There are too many signals that all work nicely, but the problem is: Which signal is the right one for this particular situation? Look at board 2 from the final of the main events Saturday afternoon.

This was the auction at one table, but at others East jumped to 3♥ and South never bid, or perhaps a few South players opened 2♠. But all roads led to 4♥ by West and the opening lead was usually the ♠A by North. The question is: which card does South play to get North to lead a club at trick two?

As you can see, if North switches to a low club, South ruffs and can put partner back on lead in diamonds for another ruff, to set the contract. I'm sure many readers have already answered the question with a simple: "Play the spade deuce, a

suit-preference signal for clubs." Oh, how nice and easy that would be. But since when do we give suit-preference at trick one? Especially when partner is interested in continuing the suit led. Let's be honest. Playing standard signals, a low spade says, "I don't have the king of spades, please switch," while a high one says, "continue, please."

Since the low spade asks for a switch, you might wonder which suit it's asking for (in this case, is it diamonds or clubs?) The answer is that the low spade asks partner to switch to the more likely what you might call "the obvious switch." In this case (as in many cases) there is no "obvious switch." If dummy had, for example, two or three low diamonds, the discouraging spade signal would be asking for a switch to diamonds, but here a diamond or a club might be right from North's view (though a diamond switch looks more vital, because dummy's singleton might be discarded on declarer's ♠K). In our book, we suggested a list of rules to identify the obvious switch when it was not completely obvious, and one criteria was that "a singleton in dummy is never the obvious switch." Using this rule, the low spade asks for a club switch.

There is a third signal available: the ♠J, a strange signal. Some call it the "alarm clock, wake up" signal, asking for a ruff. This, too, works well on this deal. In *Switch in Time* methods, the strange signal asks for the strange shift (not the obvious switch, but the fourth suit). I like the *Switch in Time* system of defense because the signals don't change from hand to hand or situation to situation, but you may prefer the alarm clock method for getting a ruff, as in this case. It doesn't matter that much, because there is definitely more than one way to skin a cat. The important thing for bridge partners, however, is to agree beforehand on how to do it.

'It's more challenging than I imagined'

Why do some people decide to take up bridge when they retire? Ruth Baker of New Smyrna FL wanted a challenge. "I wanted to keep busy, and bridge looked as if it would be a good challenge. Little did I know – challenge isn't a strong enough word to describe it."

Baker is here playing in Newcomer games with Betty Plagmann, also of New Smyrna.

Plagmann had been playing cards all her life – pinochle, euchre, cribbage, 500 rummy – "so I knew bridge was going to be a snap. I sure learned different. The game is more challenging than I ever dreamt."

Both have children, and they're disappointed that none of them will try bridge. "We're going after the grandchildren," said Plagmann. "The time to learn bridge is when you're young."

Orlando is their very first tournament – they have played only at the Deland and Daytona bridge clubs. They are enjoying their experience so much that they want to do it again.

Thinking Bridge #3

West leads the ♠10. Plan your defense as East.

The bidding follows routine lines. South's double of the 1♠ overcall shows at least four hearts and seven or more high-card points. North rebids as if South had responded 1♥.

North would normally rebid 1NT but when East has overcalled spades, North should have a spade stopper to make that bid. After the 2♦ rebid, South makes a normal 3NT rebid. A rebid of 2NT would not be forcing. The one who knows, goes.

When partner leads an honor card (the ♠10, in this case), third hand has three options: (a) encourage, (b) discourage, (c) overtake. Playing standard attitude signals, the ♠2 would be low and discouraging; the ♠7, an relatively high spot card, would be encouraging.

You should overtake with the lower equal, the ♠J, when you want the suit continued and have the necessary spot cards — just in case partner has led a singleton honor. (When partner leads the 10 and the 9 is in dummy, partner must have led a singleton or from a doubleton. With 10-x-x, the standard lead is low.)

In this case, the ♠7 is an enormous card with the 9-8-2 in dummy. You can see (hopefully) that if the ♠J is played at trick one, the queen and king will later squash the 8 and 9 — and the 7

will be high.

In other words, you can afford to overtake and should overtake to ensure that spades are played until the ace is driven out. Once it is driven out, you have the ♦A as an entry and are sure to take four spades and the ♦A.

If you do not overtake, declarer can play low. Your partner can search high and low for another spade to lead but he won't find one. Once partner has to lead another suit, declarer has enough time to drive out the ♦A while still clutching the ♠A. He makes 11 tricks instead of eight.

Point to remember: When you are third hand and can afford to overtake partner's honor card lead (without costing your side a trick) and you want the suit continued, overtake. Partner may have a singleton honor.

Good players never signal encouragement when they can afford to overtake.

Everyday resolutions

1. I will not criticize or express disapproval of an opponent's play or bid.
2. I will politely call "Director, please" whenever there is an irregularity.
3. I will not comment that an opponent's error was anticipated or needed for my action to succeed.
4. I will refrain from offering unsolicited advice.
5. I will not discuss previously played boards with my partner in the presence of new opponents.
6. I will stop all cross table conversation as soon as one hand is removed from the next board.
7. I will not engage in lengthy postmortems between hands and between rounds.
8. I will keep cards in my hand until it is my turn to play.
9. I will not take the cards of other players from the board after play.
10. I will remain at the table until the next round is called and will pass the boards immediately.

Before she retired, Plagmann was a farmer in Iowa. Baker was a director of special education in Rensselaer NY.

Rosemarie Pensabene and Howard Heinecke of Summerfield FL are having the time of their lives at this, their first North American tournament. Both used to play bridge but gave it up for about 10 years because of other pressures. "We're back in the game again now that we've retired, and we're very happy," said Pensabene.

"This is a wonderful experience," said Heinecke. "It's a great location, and the playing area is just perfect."

Both had card-playing experience before they discovered bridge. Pensabene started with poker – "When I was a kid, we'd rush to finish dinner and clear the table so we could play poker." Heinecke's game was blackjack when he was a kid.

Trump echo: a mystery?

A logical question for new players involves the trump echo. In most situations when you are giving count, if you play high-low you show an even number. In trumps, however, when you play high-low you show an odd number, almost always three. Why is it different?

Dave Smith, an expert player who works at Headquarters in Memphis, offers this explanation.

If you high-low with three, you save your biggest one in the off chance you can overruff. If you high-low with two, you lose your big one right away. For example, with the 9-2, you save your 9 by playing the 2 first, not to mention that if a high-low shows two, when you complete the echo you're out of trumps.

With the 9-6-2 of trumps, you can play your 6 to encourage while holding on to the 9. In practice this seldom matters but has developed into a conventional usage.

Deep Finesse revises your hand records

One of the greatest tools ever invented to analyze bridge hands is a software program known as Deep Finesse. Once a deal is entered into the program, you can learn the best line of play for both declarer and the defenders.

Until this tournament, it was primarily bridge writers and experts who used the program, but that's all changed now. You probably have noticed how different the hand records look.

All the deals in each set of hand records have gone through Deep Finesse. The program is very practical – it analyzes according to the cards as they are dealt, not according to what might have been. The contracts listed on the hand records are those that can be made with correct play against correct defense as the cards lie.

Want to see how it works? Go to www.deepfinesse.com and enter the deal you want to study. You can try all manner of play methods or defense methods, and Deep Finesse will let you know if you're on the right track.

There's another change on the hand records. You don't have to count the high card points – they've listed with each hand.

Jacobs seeking repeat in Open BAM Teams

George Jacobs and Co. won 21.5 boards out of a possible 26 — an 82.69% result — in the first final session and coasted to a win in last year's Victor Mitchell Open Board-a-Match Teams. He is going for a repeat here.

The Mitchell Trophy

Players will be competing for the Victor Mitchell Trophy, which honors one of bridge's most colorful characters — a champion player, philosopher and mentor to the stars.

Mitchell, a Grand Life Master with more than 10,000 masterpoints, won five North American championships including the Spingold in 1956 and 1959, the Life Master Men's Pairs in 1962 and the Men's Teams in 1962 and 1963. He was named ACBL Honorary Member in 1988 and was inducted into the Bridge Hall of Fame in 1996.

The game

The four-session event was a men's championship until 1990 when it became an open event.

Perhaps the event's high point occurred in 1977 when there were only three winners: Richard Doughty, Ron Smith and Lou Bluhm (plus these players eligible for session awards only: Bruce Ferguson, Sidney Lazard, Leslie West and Irv Kostal).

Lazard was supposed to play with Doughty but after a good first set, Lazard became ill and Kostal took his place for the evening session.

Lazard was better the next day and in his seat for the first final session. Suddenly he toppled over and a call went out for paramedics. They arrived quickly and rushed Lazard to a hospital.

Meanwhile, Doughty had to find another partner and Ferguson was pressed into service. Ferguson, whose team had not qualified the previous day, was technically ineligible but was allowed to play only in the afternoon.

In the evening, Doughty recruited West — his fourth partner in four sessions — and the team went on to victory by a margin of two full boards.

Convention card reminder

Each player is required to have a convention card filled out legibly and on the table throughout a session. Both cards of a partnership must be identical and include the first and last names of each member of the partnership.

If a director determines that neither player has a substantially completed card, the partnership may play only the Standard American Yellow Card and may use only standard carding. This restriction may be lifted only at the beginning of a subsequent round after convention cards have been properly prepared and approved by the director. Further, the partnership will receive a 1/6 board matchpoint penalty for each board played, commencing with the next round and continuing until the restriction is lifted. In IMP team games, penalties shall be at the discretion of the director.

If the director determines the partnership has at least one substantially completed convention card but has not fully complied with ACBL regulations, the director may give warnings or assign such penalties as he deems to be appropriate under the circumstances.

The objective of these warnings and penalties is the encouragement of full compliance with ACBL regulations.

Turn 'em off

Cell phones, audible pagers or any similar communication equipment may not be operated or operable in the playing area during a session of play at NABCs except for health-related equipment or by permission of the director-in-charge of the tournament or event.



Women lead prize money competition

Patricia Tucker of Atlanta used her birthday money to enter the BPT Prize Money Bridge events and she crushed the opposition, leading Frances Egger of Venice Beach FL by 11 matchpoints at the end of the qualifying. Ross Rainwater of Vancouver WA, playing in his first event, was third, one matchpoint behind Egger.

The Stratified game first-round leader is Joe Freeman of Flower Mound TX with a 68% game.

A Junior, 16-year-old Sam Katz of Burr Ridge IL, was the class of the 299er Division with a 58% game.

The final of the Orlando Open continues at 9 a.m. in the Grand Ballroom, Salon XIV. The winner will be a competitor in the \$23,000 Bonus Pool, which continues at the Indianapolis Regional Dec. 10 and concludes in Palm Springs Regional Dec. 15.
