Narasimham squad romps in Women's Swiss Teams

The team captained by Hansa Narasimhan took the lead in the second round of the final session of the Machlin Women's Swiss Teams and breezed to victory. They had the event won with a round to play.

The winners are Narasimhan, Irina Levitina, Jill Levin, Sue Picus, Debbie Rosenberg and JoAnna Stansby. In the past four major women's team events, the squad has finished third, second, first and first.

Second place in the event went to the team captained by JoAnn Sprung. She was playing with Renee Mancuso, Pam Wittes, Kathy Sulgrove, Peggy Sutherlin and Karen Allison. Sprung and company have won two of the last four major women's team events and finished second in the others.

Sprung was in first place after the first round of the final, and met Narasimhan, who was in second. Narasimhan won by 21 IMPs (18-2 in Victory Points) to take the lead and never looked back. With a round to go, the winners had 124.19 VPs. The closest competitor had 92.46 with only 20 VPs available even with a blitz.

Nebraska pair are tops in NAP-B

For two Lincoln NE players who earn a living with mathematics, a big game in the second final session added up to first overall in the North American Pairs, Flight B. Pete Whipple and Jamie Radcliffe, representing District 14, were ecstatic when the final score was announced and they had claimed first by more than a board.

The winners' score of 524.88 (17 top) was 18.57 matchpoints clear of the runners-up, Joon Pahk and Samuel Jeong of Stanford CA.

Whipple is an actuary for Ameritas Life Insurance in Lincoln. Radcliffe, who grew up in England and now holds dual UK-American citizenship, teaches math at the University of Nebraska.

They formed their partnership about five years ago when they met at the Lincoln Duplicate Bridge Club. Whipple wanted to play the Washington Standard bidding system as written in a book by Steve Robinson. They now have about 70 pages of notes on their system.
