Jacobs claims Vanderbilt Trophy

The team captained by George Jacobs put on a show of strength in the second half of the Vanderbilt Knockouts, winning the 64-board contest against Richard Schwartz's team 128-101.

The other members of the Jacobs squad are partner Ralph Katz and Italian teammates Norberto Bocchi, Giorgio Duboin, Alfredo Versace and Lorenzo Lauria.

This is the second Vanderbilt victory for Jacobs, Katz, Lauria and Versace. They won in 1999 playing with Peter Weichsel and Alan Sontag, instead of Bocchi and Duboin for whom this is the first win in the contest.

Jacobs overcame a small first-half deficit. They trailed by 16 after the first quarter, but cut the Schwartz's lead to six by halftime. By the end of the third quarter they led Schwartz by 18 and

Gates in Reno, plays Open Swiss

Bridge enthusiast and Microsoft chairman Bill Gates is attending the Reno NABC this weekend. Gates, who makes occasional appearances at NABCs, entered the Jacoby Open Swiss Teams with partner Sharon Osberg and teammates Barnet Shenkin and Mark Feldman.

At a pre-game press conference, Gates said that he was here to enjoy a weekend of bridge.

Speculating on the difficulty of the event, Gates said, "This will be quite a tough field. I'll have quite a bit to learn this time. This is probably the toughest event I've ever entered."

When asked about his level of participation in ACBL events, Gates indicated that his schedule is hectic, making it difficult to play more often.

"Over time, however, I'm getting to play more," he said.

The Gates team made the cut in the qualifying round of the Open Swiss, and will play in today's two-session final.

An international squad of Swedes, Italians and Americans led by Peter Bertheau were first in yesterday's Jacoby Open Swiss qualifiers. The leaders scored 120 on an 80 average.

In the Machlin Women's Swiss, the team led by Sharon Fellars finished well in front, posting a 127 on an 80 average.

Alfredo Versace, a member of George Jacobs Vanderbilt squad, found the right opening lead on this deal from the final match against Richard Schwartz's team. Versace was playing with Lorenzo Lauria against David Berkowitz and Larry Cohen.

After a Precision 1♦ start by Cohen, Versace overcalled 1♥. Berkowitz and Cohen play that 1♠ here would show the minors, so Berkowitz doubled to show spade length.

Cohen rebid 2♠ to show a maximum (in context) with four-card spade support. Berkowitz then hit upon the clever idea of splintering in a suit in which he actually held two fast losers. This tactic is sometimes useful not only in possibly finding out something important about partner's hand, but also in possibly getting the opponents off to the wrong opening lead.

Cohen rebid 4♠, but Berkowitz inferred from this (correctly) that Cohen had signed off in game because he had concentrated club values. That suggested, in turn, that there was less chance for Cohen to hold wasted diamond values, so Berkowitz jumped to the slam.

Lauria, however, doubled hoping to get a heart ruff, and the spotlight turned to Versace. Should he lead his long suit first or should he try to cash the ♦A to get a look at dummy? The ♦A seems rather tempting, considering that the opponents have splintered in clubs, but Versace eventually settled on the heart lead. Lauria ruffed and cashed the ♣A for down one. At the other table, North-South declared 4♠, making six, and an 11-IMP pickup for the Jacobs team.

Neat defense

Good defense may not be as spectacular as good declarer play, but it wins tournaments. Here's a deal where Jacob Morgan and Marty Harris, winners of the Red Ribbon Pairs, defended well.

Harris led the ♣4 – attitude – to dummy's king. Declarer attacked the likely entry to the South hand by leading a spade to his queen, but Harris ducked – the key play. He followed with the 3, which was a reverse Smith Echo saying that he wanted partner to continue clubs when he got in. A second spade went to Morgan's king, and he did as requested – he returned the ♣J to partner's ace. Harris drove out the ♣Q by returning the ♣10, showing that his entry was in spades.

Declarer led a spade himself, and Harris won to cash his two long clubs. North's first discard was the ♦9 – good diamonds – so Harris switched to his singleton diamond to partner's jack, and declarer ducked. North continued with the ♦K to declarer's ace, and declarer tried the heart finesse. Morgan won his king and cashed his good diamond to set 1NT two tricks.

Dodging bullets

On this deal from the quarterfinal round of the Vanderbilt Knockouts, David Berkowitz and Larry Cohen (of Richard Schwartz's team) dodged a likely significant penalty on this auction against Zia Mahmood and Michael Rosenberg (of Roy Welland's squad).

1NT was 10-12. Cohen, East, was sure that his side was about to get nailed since he was looking at a balanced 4-count. Therefore, he ran immediately to 2♥ — right or wrong — and prayed no one could double.

Zia doubled in fourth seat to show values and this was passed around to Rosenberg, North. Rosenberg pondered this for some time as Cohen nervously observed what part of the bid box Rosenberg's next call might come from. If it were a pass card, Cohen was probably looking at a phone number-sized penalty. Eventually, however, Rosenberg produced the 3♣ card, and East-West were off the hook.

The effect of the mini-notrump was to gobble up valuable bidding space for North-South. Zia and Rosenberg arrived in 5♦, and Berkowitz hit on the excellent lead of the ♦J.

Zia won in hand, cashed the ♠A and ruffed a spade. A club was ruffed in the closed hand and another spade ruff followed. A club ruff was next, followed by the ♦K and a spade to Berkowitz's king, on which Cohen pitched his remaining club, the key play since Berkowitz would otherwise have been endplayed. After East's club discard, Berkowitz safely exited with a club, ruffed by Cohen and now the defense had to come to a heart trick as well to defeat the contract by one trick.

At the other table, North-South declared and made 3NT for plus 600 and a 12-IMP pickup.

Looking at the 3-4-3-3 East hand, it seems a bit hard to believe that the key to success on the deal would depend on getting a club ruff!

Spring attendance record smashed

Reno 2004 still has a day to go, but it already holds the record for the biggest Spring NABC. The total to date is 14,207 tables, 211 more than Reno 1998 which 13,996.

Attendance fell a bit yesterday, as it always does on the second weekend. However, the total of 1198 tables was respectable – 188 in the morning, 544.5 in the afternoon and 465.5 in the evening.

Test your defense

You are East, defending 4♥ on the lead of the ♣9 to the jack and your queen. What is your plan of defense?

Sometimes the easiest problems come in difficult guesses. Here the key to the deal is that declarer surely has three clubs and did not want to play for a club ruff in dummy. So you should go against his wishes by simply returning a club. Partner ruffs with 10 and you still have two aces to win. Down one. The full deal:

You trustingly lead the ♥K and partner encourages, so you play a second heart. Partner

wins the ♥A, cashes the ♥Q and leads the ♥8, presumably suit preference for spades. What two discards do you make? Dummy pitches a diamond on the second heart and a spade on the third.

Well, the key is to bear in mind that partner must be trying to fool the opponents. He can't have the ♠A, but you go along with the pretence that he has the ♠Q. Pitch spades on both hearts and hang on to your low clubs for dear life. Declarer will win the fourth heart, cross to the ♣A and return a diamond. You take the first diamond and return a diamond, leaving it up to declarer to guess which black suit to play on. The full deal:

Gary Near of San Francisco opened an offbeat 2NT on this deal from the first final session of Open Pairs II. Strange things happened thereafter.

Of course the last thing Near wanted to hear from his partner, Dan Freedman of San Francisco, was a transfer bid. But he dutifully bid 3♥. But then North, apparently influenced by the vulnerability, put in an unusual notrump. South had more diamonds than clubs so he bid 4♦. Near couldn't believe his eyes when he saw the 4♦ card on the table, but of course he found the double.

When he opened a diamond and then led a second diamond and his partner showed out, the declarer looked at him and said, "Will you take 1400?"

"Of course I will – as long as you give me my 150 honors!"

OKbridge a sponsor of money contests

Xing Yuan of Ann Arbor MI found the way. West continued spades after winning the ace on opening lead, and Yuan ruffed. He took the ace and king of trumps and learned about the bad break. He led a club toward the king and won the trick when West discarded. A second club went to the jack and ace, and West ruffed and cashed his ♥Q. He led the ♠Q which Yuan trumped. This was the position:

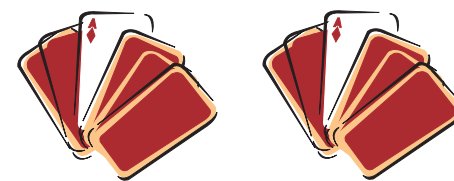

The North players who did trust their partner (too much) led the ♠K and a spade to partner for partner to lead a third spade. West ruffed with the 10, drew three rounds of trumps and reached this ending:

Then he fell further from grace when he returned a second diamond to the 10! Now Cubley was able to discard both of dummy's spades on the good hearts for an unexpected score of plus 150.

Russians enter Junior Collegiate tournament

The eighth annual Junior Collegiate Team Championship field has increased to 13 teams with the addition of a team from M.V. Lomonosov Moscow State University in Russia. The event will be played April 3 and 4 on OKbridge.

Chances are good that another three teams will sign up before the event gets under way, according to Marcia West of the Fifth Chair, one of the sponsors. If so, it will break the record of 14 teams that took part in 2003. The other sponsors are the ACBL and OKbridge.

The event ended in a tie last year between Tbilisi State University in the Republic of Georgia

and Stanford University.

In addition to Moscow, the foreign entrants to date include two teams from Ankara, Turkey; two teams from Istanbul, Turkey; and two teams from Singapore. The American teams are Harvard, Princeton, Georgia Tech, Dartmouth, UCLA and Michigan. Stanford also is expected to submit an entry.
