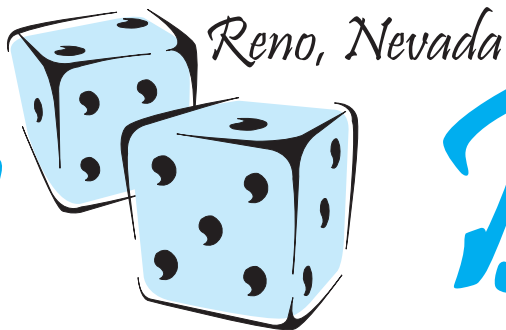

## Fantoni–Nunes lead Open Pairs II

Italian experts Fulvio Fantoni and Claudio Nunes posted a two-session total of 851.50 in the qualifying round of the Wernher Open Pairs II to lead the field of 256 pairs. Top was 25.

Fantoni and Nunes are the current World Open Pairs champions.

In second with 815.62 are Michael White and David Adams of Georgia. Third is Russ Ekeblad and Michael Seamon of Florida with 812.12.

One hundred thirty pairs qualified for today's two-session final.

## Women's quals: Baum–Waller first

Kathy Baum and Peg Waller had the best score in the qualifying round of the Whitehead Women's Pairs. The duo scored 791.50 in yesterday's two-session game to lead the field of 124 pairs. Top was 25.

In second with 785.00 is the mother-daughter pair of Rita Seamon and Janice Seamon-Molson, both of Florida. The third-place finishers in the qualifying round are Brenda Bryant and June Deutsch with 779.

In today's two-session final, the 78 qualifying pairs will compete.



## Cheek passes 20,000

Curtis Cheek has earned his 20,000th masterpoint at the Reno NABC. Cheek, of Huntsville AL, is a professional player and teacher. He won Open Pairs II in 2002 with Eric Greco, and he has six second-place finishes in NABC events: Life Master Pairs (2002), North American Swiss Teams (1999), Grand National Teams (1997), Master Open Pairs (1996), Open Pairs II (1994), Open Swiss Teams (1994).

Cheek also has several hundred regional victories.

## 'Millionaire' pals team up in Reno

Dave Kuschel, of Minot ND, is playing in his first NABC. The story of how he came to be here, however, is somewhat unusual.

"I joined the ACBL in 2000 and currently have 57.34 masterpoints," said Kuschel. "I started playing bridge online about four years ago. I live in Minot and most games are in the afternoon (I work during the day) so I'm unable to play 'live' bridge very often. I have played some unit and sectional games, but never a regional or national."

Kuschel had heard that NABCs were a lot of fun, but he didn't think he'd be playing in one anytime soon.

In October 2002, however, Kuschel was selected to appear on the syndicated version of Who Wants To Be A Millionaire? where a chance encounter with another participant on the show

changed his future vis-a-vis bridge.

"While in New York City for the taping in November of that year, there were eight other contestants in my taping group. One of those contestants was Brian Meyer from Buffalo NY. Our group was together for most of the day so we had time to chat and share stories. Somewhere in the

## New Yorkers top Red Ribbon quals

Howard Gordon of Rochester NY and Stewart Cramer of Pittsford NY scored 812.15 in the opening round of the Bean Red Ribbon Pairs. They topped the field of 300 pairs, and finished ahead by one board. (Top was 25.)

In second with 788.50 is the California-based pair of Jordan Chodorow and Harvey Katz. Next, with 781.00 are Barry and Daniel Wilderman of Great Neck NY.

Today's two-session final will feature the surviving 156 pairs.

The Red Ribbon Pairs is restricted to players with fewer than 2000 masterpoints. Players must pre-qualify to participate.

## Nickell vs. Schwartz, Jacobs vs. Mahaffey

In yesterday's quarterfinal Vanderbilt action, the top-seeded squad and defending champions led by Nick Nickell disposed of the #8-seeded team captained by Dan Morse, 170–86. Nickell led the entire match.

The #2 seed, with captain George Jacobs, nuked their opponents, Malcolm Brachman's team, 75–3 in the first quarter. Brachman never recovered, and Jacobs cruised to a 170–86 victory.

The #3 team (Jim Mahaffey) had a close first set with the #6 seed (Jeffrey Miller), but Mahaffey pulled away in the second quarter and never looked back. Mahaffey advanced 149–93.

## Double slam swing

In a bracket eight team game with our teammates Andy Hellqvist and Greg Morse of Vancouver, my partner Robin Hillyard and I helped to perpetrate the following double slam swing.

We were down 25 after 12 boards on a series of mechanical errors and the usual goofs.

We play what I call the Precision Purple Club, which is to precision what Standard American Yellow Card is to Standard American, *i.e.*, relatively vanilla and natural. I started to develop this system about seven years ago. My hope is that it's simple enough that folks who like to play Precision can use it without too much discussion. Maybe they wouldn't have some of the more advanced treatments, but it would still work well enough.

Why am I telling you this? Because the 2♣ opener (showing 11 to 15 HCP with five clubs and a four-card major or six-plus clubs) has always been a bit of a black hole. We have had some fun (and disasters) developing the different sequences to help us remember what's forcing and what's not. Anyhow, here I am as dealer, vulnerable vs. not, holding

♠Q 10 4 2 ♥10 8 4 ♦7 5 ♣K 8 5 3.

Naturally I passed, as did left-hand opponent. Partner bid 2♣ (Alert!), and RHO bid 2♥. One of our discussions has been that no matter how bad our hand is, you should bid 3♣ if you have any sort of club fit for partner. You should do this with or without interference (but especially with) because partner needs to know about the fit.

So I dutifully bid 3♣ vulnerable. LHO bid 3♥ and partner bid 4♥! RHO doubled, and I (being a complete chicken) passed. Partner bid 5♣. 5♥ from RHO! Pass from your chicken-hearted correspondent. Partner then bid 6♣ which LHO doubled with some glee.

Before the opening lead was made, partner volunteered that he had almost no expectation of making the contract. Here's the full deal:

Naturally he made 6♣ doubled by drawing trumps ending in dummy and finessing the ♠K.

The point of all this? That Precision (or one of its relatives that uses the same 2♣ bid to show clubs) is especially useful in describing big black two-suiter like this. At the other table, the auction was:

(1) Hearts and diamonds.

In the words of the opposing team captain (East), "By the time I got around to bidding spades it was at the four level and partner never supported my clubs."

Interestingly hearts never got explicitly mentioned in our teammates' auction. And 6♥ is down on a diamond lead, if my hand can find it.

Plus 1370 and plus 1510 was a 21-IMP pickup, helping us to win the match.



Second in the Mixed Pairs were Marty Fleisher and Rozanne Pollack.

## Good stop

Peggy Kaplan and Bill Kent won Wednesday's Mixed Pairs. This deal from second final session against Robert and Jill Levin earned the winners 59 out of a possible 64 matchpoints.

Robert Levin opened a weak 2♥ in first chair. Kent doubled in the balancing position and Kaplan bid 2NT. This was intended as lebensohl which typically shows a weak hand and asks partner to bid 3♣ as an escape to a three-level contract.

Kent gambled, however, that since East didn't raise the heart preempt that Kaplan, North, probably had a heart stopper, so he passed. Kaplan put the icing on the cake by carefully scoring eight tricks.

Jill led the ♥K, overtaken by Robert. He cashed two more high hearts as Jill pitched two low spades. A club was pitched from dummy. Robert switched to a diamond. Kaplan, North, won in dummy and played three more rounds of the suit, pitching the ♠10 on the final round. East pitched a spade and a club.

Kaplan continued with the ♣10. East covered with the queen and Kaplan played low from dummy. This was the position:

Each side has scored four tricks at this point, but East can get only one more trick (the ♠A). On a low club exit, Kaplan could play the ♣9 from dummy and then advance the ♠K. If East wins the ace, declarer can't be stopped from getting to the closed hand. If Jill ducks the ace, another round of spades will endplay her in clubs.

Making two, plus 120.

## Super Active Ethics

Mike Cassel congratulates Carole Klein for an act of Active Ethics in the second qualifying session of the Mixed Pairs.

North led the ♣A and switched to the ♦J. This went to East's king and Klein's ace. She led the ♦Q, and partner took a long time before finally playing the deuce. Klein knew her partner had the remaining diamond, but she also knew she that she had acquired this information in an unauthorized manner. So she continued with a third diamond because based on the cards played her partner had a doubleton diamond. This allowed West to ruff and get rid of a losing club on a heart.

Of course this Active Ethics action cost her side some matchpoints, "but this play deserves the highest praise," said Cassel, who called her action "super active ethics."

## Hsu was tops among women in 2003

Although there are many NABC and World women's events, there is no women's Barry Crane 500 race. If there were, Dixie Hsu of San Luis Obispo CA would have been the winner last year with 1221 points.

"It was like a dream come true," said Dixie. "I never even knew I had a chance until Barry Harper told me in October that I should go for it. My Canadian and Indonesian partners pulled me through."

Dixie has an amazing history. Born in Shanghai, she attended college at age 15 – quite startling for two reasons. First, she was so young. Second, she was a woman, and women were not given many chances to advance in China back in those days. She graduated with a degree in economics. At the same time she learned English and social bridge.

Her family fled to Hong Kong in 1948 because of the pending Communist Revolution. They wound up in Bangkok where she worked for UNICEF. In 1959 her family was granted political refugee status and came to America.

Dixie believes America is the greatest country in the world because "it is a land of opportunity, and if you apply yourself you can do anything." In the late Seventies she attended Harvard and received a management degree.

She retired from her position as a corporate planner in 1983. She didn't start playing duplicate until 1997, but she became a Diamond Life Master (2500+ points) in 2002.

Your play in clubs will make the difference between going down one at 3NT or making four overtricks on this deal from the Vanderbilt.

After Peter Boyd opened 1♣, South leaped to 3♥. Steve Robinson made a negative double, and Boyd found the 3NT bid even though he didn't have much of a heart stopper. South led a heart and dummy's king won. Peter called for the ♣Q, covered by the king and won with the ace. He was happy to cash four spade tricks when the jack fell third. Then Boyd took his top diamonds, and it was time to face up to the club situation.

He knew South had started with three spades and two diamonds. He could have six hearts, but Boyd thought it was more likely he had seven. So he led a club and finessed the 8. Thirteen tricks! If he failed to finesse, the defense would have taken the rest of the tricks.

## Learn about appeals

## Grand slam

Ralph Katz and George Jacobs got to a grand slam on this Vanderbilt deal. What do you think of their chances of winning 13 tricks?

Clearly a major suit opening lead solves the problem of the 13th trick. Of course it's necessary that the diamonds behave.

What happens on a diamond or a club lead? If the clubs break 4-3, no problem. Win the opening lead, draw trumps and set up the long club for a spade discard. But what if the clubs don't break? You still have lots of chances. The player with the long clubs might have the long hearts and be subject to a squeeze. The ♥Q could drop. Maybe a simple heart finesse will work. There might even be a club-spade squeeze – or even a major-suit squeeze.

Of course the first problem arises when you have to decide what to pitch on the diamonds when you draw trumps. Probably the best choice is to discard a spade and a heart to keep the clubs available.

So even though a grand slam doesn't look all that great at first glance, the odds of making it are quite good. At the table the clubs and diamonds split so the slam made. This gave the Jacobs team a big pickup since their opponents stopped in the small slam at the other table.

"Not only was it a thrill to sit in the Millionaire 'hot seat', but it's a thrill to play in an NABC! Brian is a great ambassador for the game of bridge, and I'm glad we had a chance to meet in New York."

So how did he and Meyers fare on Millionaire?

"Some of the money I won on the show is being used to attend the Reno NABC. Brian and I both won \$32,000. Yup, we both missed the freebie question for \$64,000."

## New Life Masters: 4th team member makes the grade

Yesterday we told about the team on which three of the four members became Life Masters. The fourth, **Dan Stowell** of Hillsborough CA, said that he hoped to go over the top by the end of the week. ## Hampson goes for another Mott-Smith Trophy

Geoff Hampson is making a habit of edging out regular partner Eric Greco and taking home masterpoint trophies — in 2003 he bagged the Mott-Smith and Herman trophies.

Last year in Philadelphia, Hampson won his first Mott-Smith Trophy when he won 317.41 masterpoints to edge Greco by 1.4 masterpoints.

Hampson won the Herman Trophy, awarded to the ACBL member who earns the most masterpoints at the Fall NABC. Hampson tallied 374.79 points to 373.61 for Greco.

### Mott-Smith Trophy

The trophy was donated by friends in memory of Geoffrey Mott-Smith in 1961 and made retroactive to 1958 to include all the winners.

Mott-Smith (1902-1960) was co-chairman of the ACBL Laws Commission, editor of the ACBL Bridge Bulletin 1935-36, a contributor to The Bridge World, a writer and cryptographer.

During World War II, Mott-Smith served as chief instructor for the OSS in the training of cryptographers and cryptanalysts.

Mott-Smith was regarded as a great player, brilliant theorist and one of the soundest and most lucid of the early writers on contract bridge.
