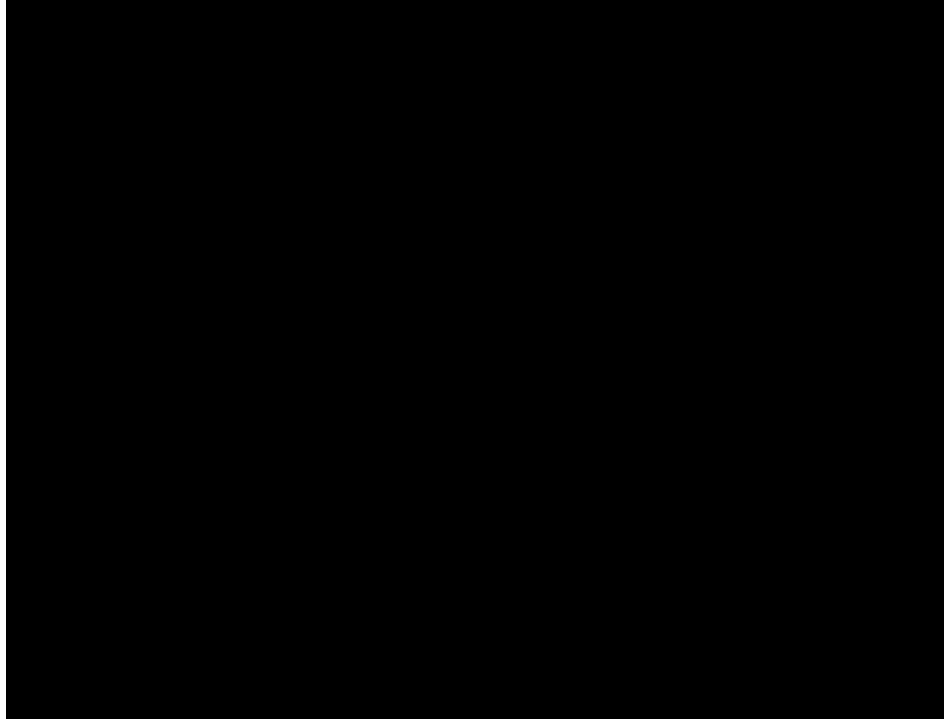

Rand team victorious in North American Swiss

The new North American Swiss Team champions are Rita Rand, Gerald Caravelli, Arnie Fisher, Steve Garner and Richard Colker. They were second going into yesterday's two final sessions, and they moved to the top with two good sessions.

In second place only 5 Victory Points back were John Begley, Mike Lawrence, John Sutherlin, Dan Morse and Hugh Ross. Only fractionally behind them in third place -- two-tenths of a Victory Point to be exact -- were Richard Gabriel, Dick Bruno, Jim Burt, Jeff Schuett and Stanton and Suzi Subeck.

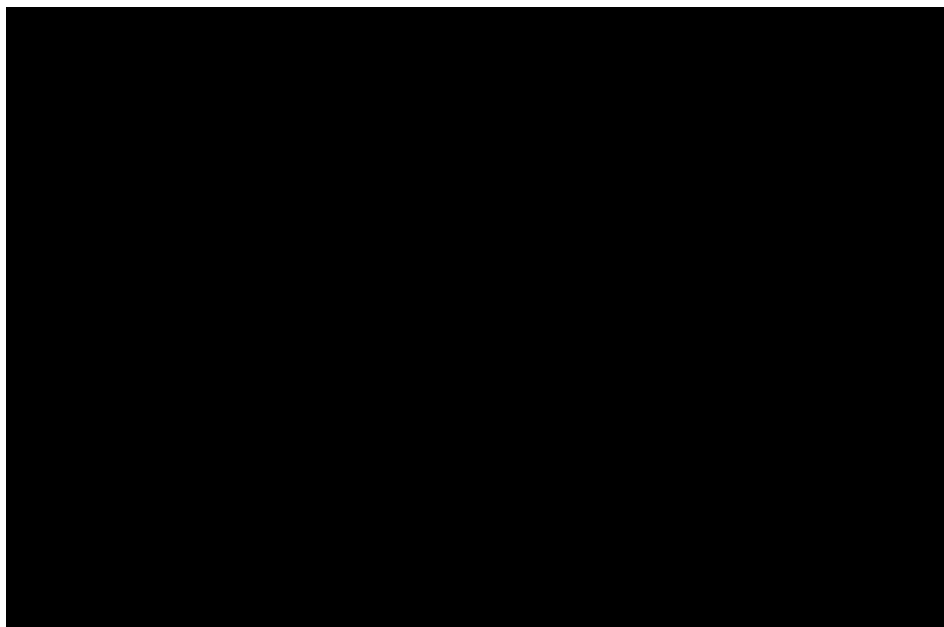
The team captained by Jack Coleman which was seeking its third straight win finished 10th. Playing with Coleman were Mark Molson, Boris Baran, Drew Cannell and Mark Stein.

The United States' No. 2 Junior team for next year's Junior World Team Championship got lots of practice playing in IMP matches -- they lasted through to the end and finished 12th. On the team were Tom Carmichael, Joel Wooldridge, Shannon Lipscomb, Scott Lewis and Chris Willenken.

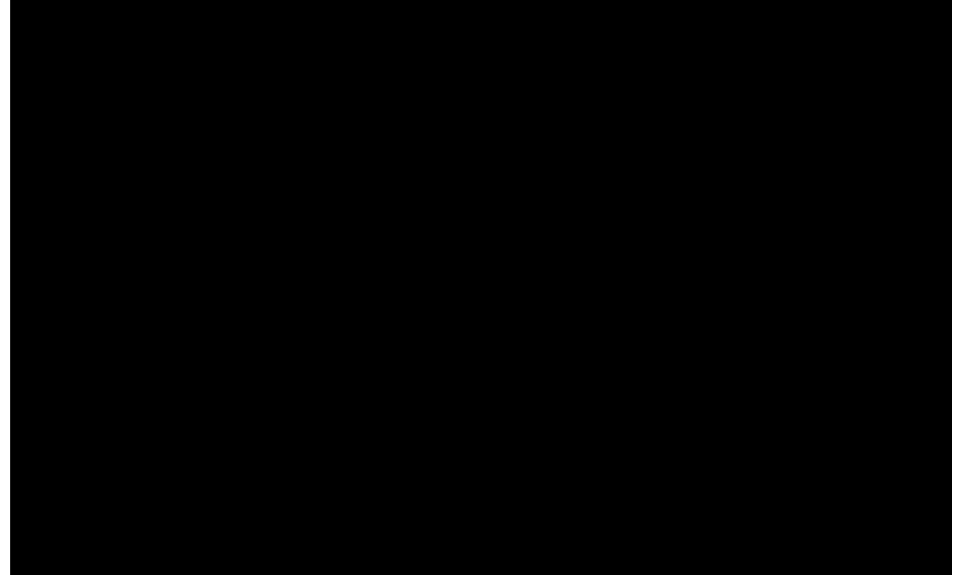
12,984 tables

San Francisco 1996 didn't quite make it to the hoped-for 13,000 tables. The final count was 12,984 -- just 16 short. The tournament ran strong through the first seven days, but attendance fell off sharply starting on Thanksgiving Day.

The '96 edition also did not top the record for San Francisco set in 1990 -- 13,239 tables.

Zia-Martel-Stansby-Rosenberg triumph in close Reisinger

The outcome was in doubt right down to the final board in the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams. Nobody was leaving the packed Pendergraph arena because four teams were still in the running as the last round was played.

The team captained by Zia finally edged the Jimmy Cayne team by just .18 of a board. The Zia team played four-handed -- Chip Martel, Lew Stansby, Michael Rosenberg and Zia played every hand throughout the grueling six sessions.

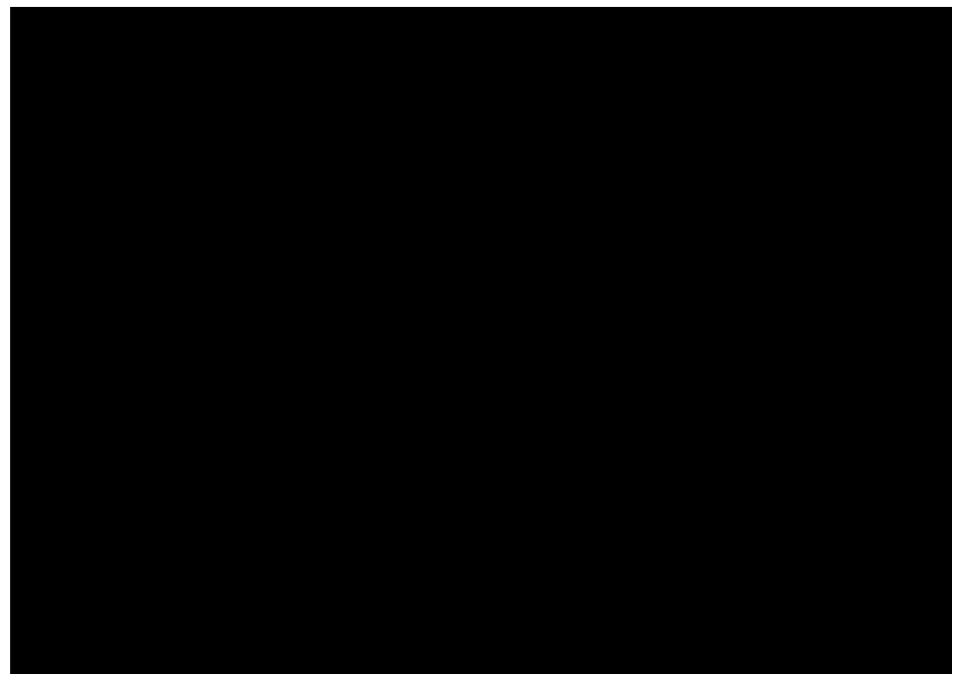
Cayne, Chuck Burger, Mark Feldman, Michael Seamon, Alan Sontag and Mike Passell made up the team that just missed.

Rita Shugart and Edgar Kaplan were right in the thick of it to the very end as well. Shugart finished third, playing with Andy Robson, Tony Forrester, Geir Helgemo, Steve Sion and Eddie Wold.

Kaplan showed tremendous fortitude as he played solidly despite the fact that he was suffering from the effects of chemotherapy. On his team were Norman Kay, Brian Glubok, Sidney Lazard, Bart Bramley and Ron Smith.

It was actually a double victory for Zia -- he won more than enough masterpoints to become the 1996 Player of the Year -- the player who compiles the most masterpoints in North American championship events that do not have an upper masterpoints limit.

All in all, Zia had a terrific tournament. He also won the Open Board-a-Match Teams, worth 125 points, finished sixth in the Blue Ribbon Pairs for another 70 and for 17.14 in the Life Master Open Pairs. Add the 200 for the Reisinger and it looks as if Zia might win the Herman Trophy for the most masterpoints at this tournament. His total is 412.14 for the week.

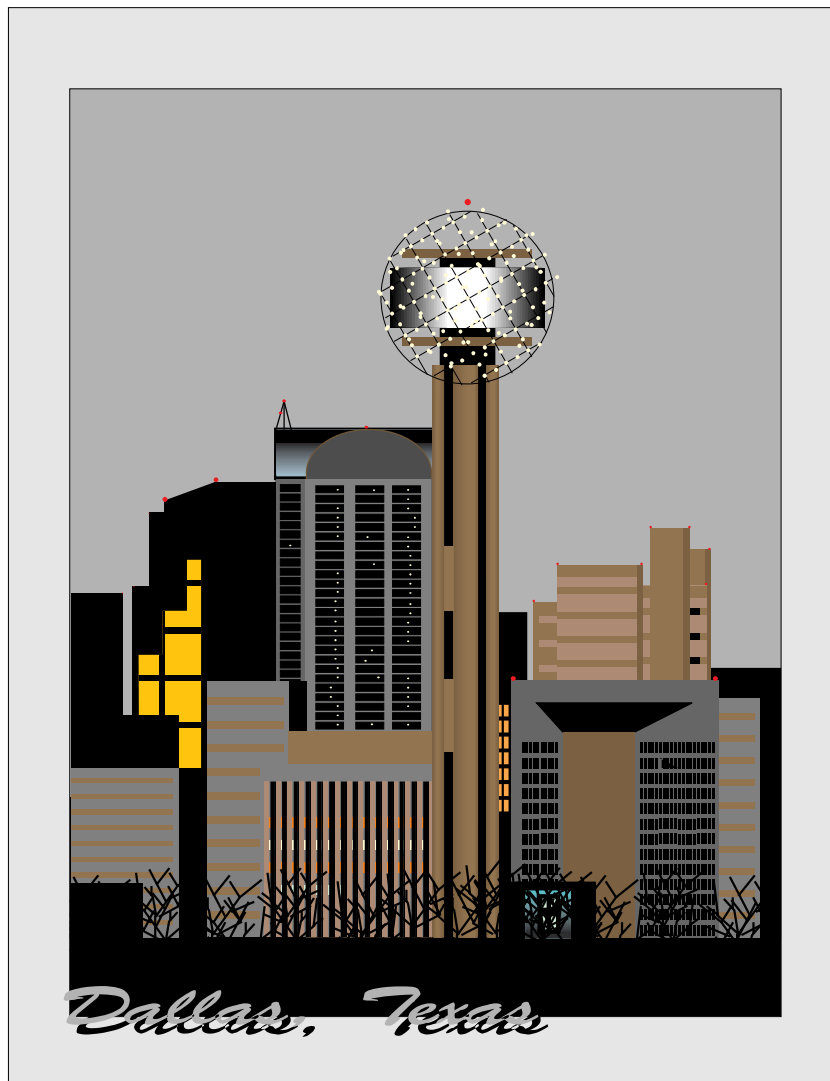
