

Moss foursome ahead in Reisinger

The four-man team captained by Mike Moss of New York had a 2.5-board lead after two qualifying sessions of the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams.

Moss and Bjorn Fallenius, also of New York, are playing with George Steiner of Seattle and Nels Erickson of Meadview AZ. They finished the day's play Friday with a score of 37.

In second with 34.5 was a California team -- Daniel and Linda Friedman and Michael Michlmayr of Orinda and Robert Munson of San Diego.

The Nick Nickell team, gunning for a fourth straight Reisinger, were 6.5 boards off the pace entering today's semifinal sessions. Nickell is playing with Richard Freeman, Eric Rodwell, Jeff Meckstroth, Bobby Wolff and Bob Hamman.

Zia out front in 1996 Player of the Year race

A win in the Open Board-a-Match Teams and a strong showing in the Blue Ribbon Pairs have propelled Zia into the lead in the 1996 *Player of the Year* contest.


The award goes to the player who wins the most masterpoints in nationally rated events.

Zia, of New York and Pakistan, moved ahead of David Berkowitz, the leader coming into the Fall NABC, with a total of 632.14 masterpoints.

With only the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams left to play, Berkowitz trails Zia, 1991 *Player of the Year*, by 11.87 masterpoints.

Zia picked up 125 MPs for winning

Elected to represent the ACBL in World Bridge Federation affairs were Joan Gerard (named to a second term) and Cecil Cook.

Gerard, Cook elected WBF representatives

Joan Gerard, representative to the Board of Directors from District 3, and Cecil Cook, representative to the Board from District 23, were elected to three-year terms as ACBL representatives to the World Bridge Federation Executive Council. The elections took place at last week's meeting of the ACBL Board of Directors.

This will be Gerard's second term with the WBF, and Cook will be serving his first term.

Gerard has had a good chance to see bridge from a number of angles because her service with the WBF. As a result, she has a very positive outlook about bridge in general and the ACBL and the WBF in particular.

"The future of bridge is bright, and world bridge has to be a major part of that future."

"The WBF is taking steps similar to those being taken by the ACBL -- setting up a pro tour, adding various special events, a tournament of champions, and so forth. The WBF is still behind



the ACBL in some areas -- smoking, masterpoints, special events -- but we're catching up fast.

"For instance, the WBF is adding special events that have a broad base of interest. The first was the Transnational Mixed Teams that took place in Greece. And next year in Tunisia we are adding a Transnational Open Teams. This team event will start when the Bermuda Bowl and the Venice Cup move into the knockout phase."

"The WBF chooses its locations well -- they're always great places to go. They're chosen so that it is possible to combine a vacation with bridge."

Gerard was ACBL president in 1992 and chairman of the Board in 1993, the year she began her stint with the WBF. She also was co-chairman of the world championships that were held in her district in 1981.

Cook, who was president of the ACBL in 1994 and chairman of the Board in 1995, has a vital interest in

Chilcote squad wins Senior Knockout Teams

The team captained by Mary Chilcote outscored their opponents 63-12 in the second quarter and cruised to a 174-118 victory over the squad led by Howard Hertzberg in the Senior Knockout Teams.

Two members of the Chilcote team -- Zeke Jabbour of Boca Raton FL and Russ Arnold of Miami -- won the event for the third straight time.

Chilcote, of Cleveland OH, was also playing with Billy Eisenberg, Boca Raton; Fred Hamilton, Fresno, and Tommy Sanders, Nashville.

Hertzberg, of Alpine NJ, was teamed with Robert Ryder, Caldwell NJ; Bill Esberg, Elberon NJ; Simon Kantor, Agawam MA, and Marty Baff,

Beachwood OH.

The victory was the first North American championship for Chilcote, a bridge teacher and proud grandmother of eight. She came close in the Mixed Pairs in 1970, missing out on first and finishing second "because I forgot a convention."

The error was doubly frustrating because the convention she was playing was the Weiss convention (for handling opening three bids), created by Larry Weiss, who just happened to be Chilcote's partner in the Mixed Pairs.

Naturally, Chilcote was pleased at the outcome, although after six days of play she was tired. "I'm just glad it's

Griscom team leads in NA Swiss Teams

The team captained by John Griscom of Nashville led 40 teams into today's two-session semifinal of the North American Swiss Teams. Griscom, Coley McGinnis, Linda Hanson, all of Nashville; Alan Copeland, Midland TX; and Derrell and Louise Childs, Garland TX, had a 10 Victory Point lead over Larry Mori, Charlton NY; Robb Gordon, New York City; Dennis Sorensen, Gresham OR, and Mark Tolliver, Portland OR.

Only one point further back in third place were Ron and Linda Smith, Chattanooga TN; Jim Robison, Las Vegas, and Mark Perlmutter, San Francisco.

The Jack Coleman team, seeking to win this event for the third straight time, made the cut without any problem, but they are well off the pace. They are tied for 16th, 29 Victory Points behind the leaders. Coleman is from San Francisco, but the rest of the team is Canadian -- Boris Baran, St. Lazare PQ; Mark Molson, Cote St. Luc PQ; Drew Cannell, Winnipeg, and Mark Stein, Montreal.

Attendance record? Maybe!

Attendance was somewhat off yesterday, no doubt because of the Thanksgiving holiday. The total to date is 11,308.5 tables, which is only slightly ahead of San Francisco 1990, which had 11,088 tables at this point.

Will San Francisco 1996 beat 1990? It's going to be close. Tom Quinlan, the head director here, has projected a possible tie at 13,239 tables.

The Facts: 7♥ doubled by East made seven, plus 1770 for E/W. 4NT was not Alerted and showed a spade control (by partnership agreement). N/S called the Director, and were told by that Director and a second Director that the double of 7♥ would be canceled. Sometime before the end of the afternoon session, N/S were told by a third Director that the double was not canceled, as there was no requirement to Alert 4NT, which meant that there was no infraction by E/W. The Director(s) therefore allowed the table result to stand.

The Appeal: N/S believed that they were told by the Screening Director that current ACBL regulations did not require an Alert of 4NT, and that therefore they had no case. When a fourth Director was consulted, N/S were told that they would lose their deposit if they took their case to a Committee. Nonetheless, N/S believed that appearing before a Committee was the only avenue available to them to protest the treatment they had received and to express their opinions about the new Alert regulations.

The Committee Decision: The Committee found that under current ACBL regulations the 4NT bid did not require an Alert and that there was therefore no basis for score adjustment. The Committee agreed that this seemed to fly in the face of the original purpose of the Alert procedure, which was to make the opponents aware of an "unexpected" or conventional agreement. The Committee members understood the frustration felt by the N/S pair. Although any protest was substantially without merit since the Laws (or Regulations) were specific on this issue, the Committee nevertheless elected to return E/W's deposit and bring the circumstances of this appeal to the attention of the Director-In-Charge of the tournament.

A SECOND LOOK

Appeals Case 14 raises an important issue, one that might well send the regulators back to the drawing board.

The point raised by the N/S pair in this case is well taken. The Alert procedure was not intended to place the opposing side (the side not making the call that might require an explanation) at a disadvantage. The "No-Alert" rule for bids of 3NT and beyond (after a player's first turn to bid) was intended to prevent the "involved" side from conveying unauthorized but potentially undetectable information through the use or non-use of Alerts.

In this case, there was no suitable "official" solution available to North. If he had asked for an explanation of the E/W bidding and had been given the correct information, he might well have decided not to double the slam, but in the asking, it might have been alleged by E/W that North had shown interest in a spade lead, dummy's first-shown suit. Sort of a Lightner Non-double.

While it might then be argued that E/W's "unusual" agreement had created the need for their opponents to seek clarification and that N/S should not then be saddled with responsibility for generating unauthorized information, this sort of fractious situation is not one that the sponsoring organization should wish to endorse through its regulations. Many experts believe, nonetheless, that allowing anyone to ask a question at his turn to bid is the most palatable solution to this complex problem.

The situation can be remedied, but perhaps not entirely. If we wish to retain the "No-Alert" rule because its benefits seem to outweigh its deficiencies, we could add a provision that would protect the "uninformed" side where there is no current legal obligation to do so. We could oblige the side that is about to buy the auction (they have made a bid and two passes have followed) to volunteer to provide the information that their opponents might require before they close out the auction.

In Case 14, either West or East would be obliged by Regulation to ask North if he wished an explanation of the entire sequence. If North accepts the offer, he would know without prejudice to his side that East's 4NT shows a spade control and that West's 6NT is natural. Then North would be able to double 7♥ or pass it out, but would not have to ask a potentially prejudicial question. He must not ask about any particular call, but his opponents must provide explanations of all but the strictly standard calls.

While this would be the ideal procedure for slam-zone auctions, the introduction of this procedure would not deprive a player from asking a proper question at any of his (other) turns to call.

There might still be problems earlier in the auction. A player contemplating a lead-directing double or a penalty double might wish to ask about a particular call, conveying unauthorized information when the explanation leads him to pass rather than double. Since we can't force a player to ask about all his opponents' calls, we are going to have to deal with these situations on a case-by-case basis.

Treadwell treads well

Dave Treadwell continues to be the hero of the oldest generation -- he keeps doing things right time after time. Here he took a shot at a reasonable slam, then found the way to make it on this deal from the first qualifying session of the North American Swiss Teams.

The opening spade lead went to the ace and Treadwell won the spade return. He cashed two of dummy's top trumps, then left one outstanding as he called for the ♠J. East didn't cover, so Treadwell let it ride, pitching a heart. The ♠10 was covered and Treadwell ruffed it.

Next came the ♦A and the ♦K followed by a third diamond which he ruffed with the king. This was the position at this point:

Treadwell led a club to the jack on which West comfortably threw a heart. But then Treadwell called for the last trump, and West was caught. He couldn't throw the diamond so he had to bare his ♥K. Treadwell recognized what was happening -- he led the ♥J and went up with the ace, dropping the king to make his slam. That was worth 12 IMPs when his opponents stopped in 3NT at the other table.

Hard charge by Berkowitz-Cohen

David Berkowitz of Old Tappan NJ and Larry Cohen of Boca Raton FL have forged a remarkable record in major pair events this year, one of the factors that contributed to Berkowitz's lead in the 1996 *Player of the Year* contest going into the Fall NABC.

Berkowitz and Cohen won the Open Pairs II at the Spring NABC in Philadelphia and followed with a victory in the six-session Life Master Open Pairs at the Summer NABC in Miami Beach.

They entered the 1996 Blue Ribbon Pairs as the defending champions. They started slowly, qualifying 60th after the first day of play, but they moved up steadily. They were 16th after four sessions and, going into the final 26 boards Thursday night, stood fourth in the field.

With one round to go, Berkowitz and Cohen trailed by a substantial margin but still nearly managed to pull out a win, earning 70 out of 76 matchpoints. Here's what happened:

Cohen led the ♦3 to the 5, jack and ace. West was looking at 26 high-card points between the two hands but only seven top tricks. There was a lot of work to do.


West won the ♦A and fired one back. Cohen ducked to Berkowitz's jack, and Berkowitz pushed the ♣9 through declarer's hand. West went up with the ace and played a heart to dummy's ace, followed by a low spade from dummy, hoping Berkowitz might have the ♠K without the jack and be tempted to play it.

Berkowitz was well armed in spades, however, and he inserted the 10 and got off play with another club, ducked by declarer to Cohen's 8. Cohen got out with a heart to dummy's king, and declarer tested hearts, finding that suit splitting 4-2.

Hoping to endplay Berkowitz in spades, West cashed the ♣K and floated the ♠9 to Berkowitz's jack. Unfortunately for declarer, Berkowitz still had a club and played it to Cohen's hand, which was good. Down three for plus 300 and 35.5 out of 38 matchpoints.

That's right -- that's Richard Freeman, the mathematical genius of the Quiz Kids, at the far left.

Berkowitz got off to the excellent lead of the ♣J, establishing two tricks in the suit immediately. Cohen had a problem, however, when East cashed four rounds of spades. Cohen could let go a club and a diamond, but when East played the fourth round of spades, Cohen was down to

and was in a quandary for his discard. Cohen was fearful of throwing a heart because if declarer had 5-4-1-3 shape, a heart pitch would allow the contract to make. Cohen didn't imagine that East would bid 3♦ with the shape he actually had, so in order to assure the defeat of the contract, Cohen discarded the ♦A. Declarer then followed with the ♥K and the ♥J. Cohen won the second heart and cashed two clubs and two diamonds, but that was it for the defense.

Plus 200 was good for another 35.5 matchpoints, and Cohen was upset that his discard might have cost him and Berkowitz the event. That was not the case. For one thing, another North-South pair had scored plus 800 on the deal, so the most Berkowitz and Cohen could have gotten was 37, another 1.5 MPs, and they were 2.9 matchpoints out of first.

Nor would a different score have affected the winners of the event. Jim Krekorian and Bob Blanchard were allowed to play -- and make -- 2♦ on the East-West cards.

On their way

New Yorkers Jim Krekorian and Bob Blanchard, winners of the Blue Ribbon Pairs, are a regular partnership who have knuckled down to serious play over the past couple of years. Their efforts paid off with an impressive showing in one of the toughest pair events in the world. On this deal from the second final session, Krekorian made a risky call and was quite appreciative of Blanchard for holding just the right hand.

Krekorian knew he was taking a chance with a negative double on the East cards because it "promised" four spades. Krekorian was therefore a bit nervous when he heard Blanchard leap to 4♦. He grew more tense when North led a couple of high hearts, forcing Blanchard to ruff in the long trump hand. Krekorian envisioned his partner losing control if he had started with only four spades.

Blanchard showed that he is a good partner, however, by holding five spades and timing the play nicely. After ruffing the heart at trick two, Blanchard cashed the ♦A, followed by the ♠A and the ♠K. Next came the ♦K and a diamond ruff, establishing that suit. Blanchard then ruffed a heart to his hand and ran the good diamonds. The opponents took one trick each in clubs, hearts and spades.

The board occurred late in the second final session, and Krekorian knew they were having a good game. "When Bob showed up with five spades," Krekorian said, "I felt that we were OK."



The defense was helpless even though everyone was out of trumps. Grace still had the top spade -- and of course dummy's clubs now were all good -- and accessible -- the ♦9 was there as an entry.

Tchamitch might have bid 3♥ instead of 2♥, but he didn't like his doubleton diamond honor and dull shape. When Kilstrup freely bid 3♥, Tchamitch decided to make the opponents pay for balancing.

Kilstrup didn't disappoint her partner. On the opening lead of a low spade, she put in dummy's queen, cashed the ace (discarding a club) and followed with the ♥A and a heart to the jack. As the dispirited opponents slumped lower in their chairs, Kilstrup played a diamond to the queen in dummy and followed with a low club.

South went up with the ace and played another trump, but Kilstrup won, played a diamond to the ace, noting the fall of the ♦J from South. Now a club to the king and the ♦10, ruffing out North's king. Plus 680 was good for nearly all the matchpoints.

Miles had managed a coup by reaching the best partscore. He received the ♥J lead and he won the ♥A to lead the ♠A and a second spade to the jack. Next came a heart to the king and heart ruff, dropping all the outstanding hearts. A diamond to the jack and king saw West exit with a second diamond. Now declarer won in hand and led a heart, ruffed and overruffed. Finally a spade to the king endplayed West to lead clubs into the tenace for a valuable overtrick.

Miles had to read West for his 4-3-2-4 shape. If West had had a third diamond, then Miles would have had to cash the diamond to remove West's exit before playing the fourth heart.

However there was a defensive resource: West had to cash the ♠K before exiting with his second diamond. Then he cannot get endplayed with this card, and declarer is held to nine tricks.

Praising her supporting cast of superstars, Chilcote said, "I had great teammates who gave me the courage and confidence to do this."

The Senior KO was sponsored by the U.S. Playing Card Co., which provided trophies for the winners. Roy G. Green, chief executive officer of the ACBL, praised the sponsor and Hamish Bennett, a Bay Area player who worked hard to build up attendance in the Senior KO. The turnout this year was the largest ever.

The Chilcote team's lineup in the event was indeed impressive, with seven world championships and dozens of North American titles.

Eisenberg, a bridge pro, was an original member of the Aces, the team developed by the late Ira Corn. Eisenberg won five Bermuda Bowls with four different partners and represented the U.S. in three others. He has more than a dozen North American championships to his credit and numerous wins in European tournaments, including the prestigious *London Times* invitational.

Arnold, a businessman, won the Bermuda Bowl in 1981 and now has nine North American championships.

Hamilton is also a former Bermuda Bowl winner (1976) with nine major titles to his credit.

Sanders, a businessman and former ACBL President and Board Member, has represented the U.S. in international competition on many occasions and was non-playing captain of the winning Bermuda Bowl team in 1981. He has 11 North American championships, including three wins in the Vanderbilt Knockout.

Jabbour, a bridge pro, won the *Barry Crane Top 500* in 1989 and is perennially among the leading masterpoint winners in ACBL tournaments.

Slams and games of course are important in IMP matches, but partscores definitely have their place as well. rounds of trumps, but he abandoned the suit, noting that he would be in serious trouble if the defensive trumps were 4-2.

He switched to a club, winning the ace and continuing the suit to Jabbour's queen. Jabbour forced declarer in spades, and declarer knocked out Mary's ♣K as Jabbour ditched a diamond. She led a diamond to Jabbour's ace, and he got out with a diamond to the king.

Declarer was in bad trouble at this point. If he led his good club, one of the opponents would ruff in, so he had to lead a diamond and hope. He ruffed with the 10, but that wasn't good enough -- Jabbour was able to overruff with the jack. Back came another spade, and declarer had to use dummy's last trump to win the trick. That made Mary's last trump -- she had saved the 2 for last! -- good for the setting trick. □

world bridge. He attended the world championship in both Albuquerque in 1994 and Beijing, China, in 1995.

"Bridge appears to be making quite a surge in many parts of the world," said Cook. "I found it most interesting that so many countries have enough interest in the game to send teams to a championship like the recent Olympiad."

"It's enlightening to note that so many other countries have instituted programs similar to those already in progress in the ACBL -- education programs, activities for Juniors, etc. All this is good for bridge."

"It's also a good sign that the WBF is moving toward more events for players just below the top rank. "The transnational events are a major step forward."

"I am looking forward to working with representatives from the rest of the world to make bridge ever more interesting and popular throughout the world." □
