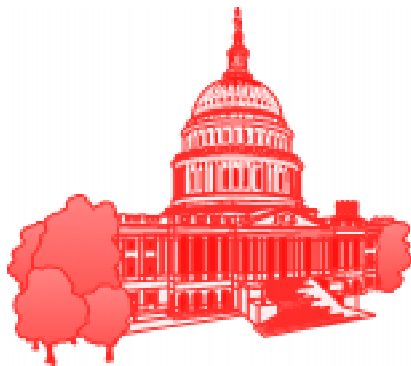




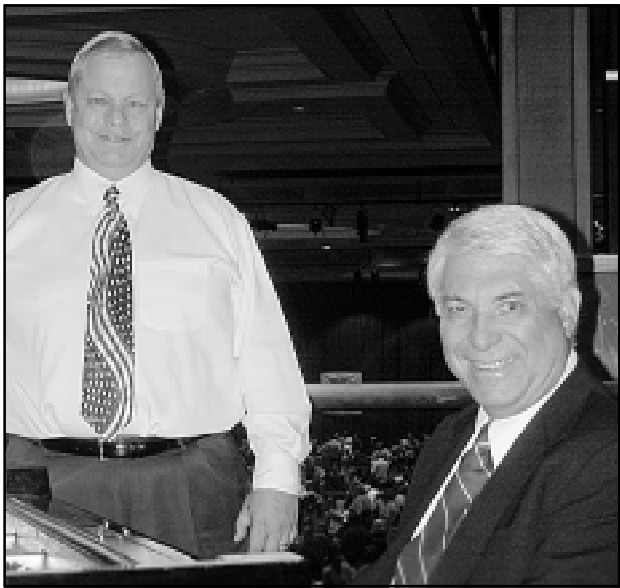

GNT champs crowned today

The final round in all four flights of the Grand National Teams will be contested today. In the Open Flight, the District 9 (Florida) team of Russ and Sheila Ekeblad, Jeff Meckstroth, Michael Seamon, Eric Rodwell and Mark Molson will face the District 17 (Southwest) squad of Lou Ann O'Rourke, Roger Bates, Garey Hayden, Billy Miller and Marc Jacobus.

In the semifinal round, District 9 defeated their District 3 (upstate New York, New Jersey) opponents 109-95, while District 17 made short work of their

Alan Stauber of Cross River NY and Clifford Meltzer of Las Gatos CA lead the Life Master Pairs qualifiers into today's two semifinal sessions. Their score of 2115.48 put them approximately a board ahead of Peter Schneider of LaCanada CA and Bruce Ferguson of Boise ID, who had 2058.04.

The field will be sliced again tonight with approximately half the semifinal pairs qualifying for tomorrow's two-session final.

Other leaders included: Samuel Cohen - Jim Hilton, 2039.11; Eugene Saxe - Thomas Smith, 2037.82; Weizhong Bao - Hailong Ao, 2036.09.

Then Goodale asked everyone to join him in singing "America the Beautiful." Everyone sang from the heart. It was beautiful. The color guard then took their leave and the players settled down to the business of playing cards.

Goodale was accompanied on the piano by Marshall Kushner, who also is an ACBL tournament director.

Wearing two hats isn't all that easy

"It's a nightmare!"

Blind player sees bridge as latest challenge

Eddie Timanus is no stranger to competitive games. The 33-year-old resident of Arlington VA is well-known to fans of the television game show *Jeopardy* as a five-time champion of the program, a feat that trivia buffs revere the same way sports enthusiasts glorify winning the decathlon.

Timanus, a sports writer for *USA Today* who covers the collegiate beat (especially lacrosse), has now set his sights on tournament bridge. Why should this be unusual (or difficult) for such an obviously gifted young man? It's because Timanus is totally blind.

Despite being born without sight, Timanus developed a fascination with all types of games, and by the time he was in junior high school Timanus had developed a group of friends who shared his interests. One member of that group - Joe Hertz of Sterling VA - has remained good friends with Timanus and is his bridge partner here in Washington.

Although Timanus has long been familiar with rubber bridge, Hertz persuaded him to give duplicate a try at the Arlington regional last year. The pair entered the 0-5 masterpoint Newcomer Pairs on Friday afternoon where they finished fifth overall with a 59% game. In the evening game,

they finished second overall, again with a 59% effort.

"I earned my first red points," said Timanus, who plays with the help of Braille cards (there are raised "dots" on the corners of the cards) and an "electronic bidding box" produced by Baron Barclay. The other players at the table announce their bids and their cards as play proceeds.

Due to a slight bidding misunderstanding and partner's flair for the spectacular you find yourself in the rather optimistic contract of 7♥!

West leads a trump and East follows with a low trump. Plan the play. *Thanks to Eddie Kantar for the problem.*

The contract is 3NT. West leads the ♥3. You play the 9. East plays the 10, which you duck. East continues with the ♥K, West playing the 2. Where do you go from here?

Kantar's answer: First, avoid taking any finesses if you don't have to. Finesses never work in quizzes, by the way. You can avoid all finesses and ensure your contract providing West has no more than five hearts and fewer than four spades.

Play the king, queen and 9 of spades to dummy's 10, retaining the ace as a later entry. Now the ♥J, discarding a diamond. East can take two more hearts, and you discard another diamond and a club, and dummy two diamonds. West must now break from one minor or the other, either play giving you your ninth trick.

Smoking restrictions

Players are advised that smoking is prohibited everywhere inside the Marriott Wardman Park except for the lobby level bar area. Players wishing to smoke must do so outside.

In the exhibition halls (downstairs), players may use the doors to the loading dock at the end of Exhibition Hall C. In the ballroom area (lobby level), players may use the doors to the parking area across from the tournament registration desk. (Smoking in the foyer beyond these doors is also prohibited.)

Penalties will be assessed for players smoking indoors.

73 Juniors are going camping for a week

Bridge play, bridge lectures, sporting events, whitewater rafting, barbecues and picnics. That's what awaits 73 Juniors (56 Americans and 17 Europeans) at the ACBL Junior Bridge Camp. Festivities will begin Monday, July 29, at Frostburg State University in Frostburg MD, and they will continue through August 4.

What's this about whitewater rafting? That's right – the Juniors will go to nearby Youghiogheny River in Ohio PA to ride the rapids. But most of the activities will be bridge.

Transportation will be provided to the camp on July 29 from the Marriott Wardman Park and from Ronald Reagan and Dulles airports in Washington DC. Transportation will be provided to both airports Aug. 5 and buses will arrive at the airports by noon.

The expenses of the American Juniors have been subsidized to the extent of \$200 by the ACBL Educational Foundation.

The two top finishers will represent the United States in the World Youth Team Championships next summer. The event probably will take place in Beijing, China, but final arrangements have not yet been made.

All teams must register with Charlotte Blaiss no later than Friday, July 26, at 8 p.m.

Canada will conduct its own trials to determine its representative.

'Home team' wins highlighted 1993 Summer NABC

Washington DC's last NABC, held in the Summer of 1993, featured some expected and some not-so-expected results, but the highlight of the tournament was the 'home team' wins in Flight B of the Grand National Teams and in the IMP Pairs.

The home team was a five-man squad from District 6: Eric Greco and Philip Greco, Annandale VA; Kefu Xu and Harry Zhou, Baltimore MD, and David Better, Belcamp MD.

In the final round, Philip Greco took advantage of a defensive slip to land a touch-and-go game.

West led the ♠10, ducked to declarer's queen. Greco led a heart from his hand. When West split his honors, Greco won dummy's ace. Next he called for a low spade and East won his king.

A club was returned, taken in dummy. Greco led dummy's ♥J. West won his king and could have defeated the contract by switching to a diamond. He continued with the ♥7, however, and that was all the help Greco needed.

Greco won dummy's ♥10 and cashed two more clubs, ending in his hand. He exited with a spade. East could cash another spade but was forced to play away from the ♦K into dummy's A-Q.

Making nine tricks was worth 10 IMPs for the winning team.

A pair of Precision players from the Washington area won the IMP Pairs with strong games in the final two sessions.

The win was the first national title for Bob Klein, Dunn Loring VA, and David Ruderman, Burtonsville MD. This was a key deal:

South led the ♠9, covered by the 10 and jack. Ruderman ruffed and led a low club. South made the play easier by rising with the king. South led another spade and Ruderman ruffed again.

He led the ♦K and followed with the ♦Q. When the ♦J showed up on the second round, Ruderman overtook with dummy's ace and ruffed a spade with his last trump. He led a club to dummy's queen and drew the last trump, pitching a heart from his hand. He led a heart to his hand and claimed. Plus 920 was worth 11 IMPs to the winners.

Had South ducked the club at trick two, Ruderman would not have had that late entry to draw North's last trump but he could have prevailed. He would ruff a second spade and lead two rounds of trumps, overtaking the ♦Q with dummy's

ace. Now a club to the ace and four rounds of hearts, pitching dummy's last club, would either endplay North or allow Ruderman to score the ♦9 and ♦10 separately.

In the Flight A GNT, three Bermuda Bowl champions teamed with "the three kids" to win the event.

The champions: Hugh Ross, a three-time Bermuda Bowl champion, plus Chip Martel and Lew Stansby, who won the Bermuda Bowl in 1985 and 1987 (and in 2001 in Paris) and the World Open Pairs in 1982.

Ross and "the three kids" – as he described Jeff Ferro, Brad Moss and Ravindra Murthy – nearly didn't make it to the national final. In their District 21 final, they trailed a good team by 45 IMPs with 16 boards to go.

They rallied to win the final quarter by 51. They added Martel and Stansby from the team they defeated in the district semifinal.

Ross led the ♠A and continued with the ♠2. Declarer ruffed and played the ♥J, taken by Ross with the ace. Ross returned a heart, won with dummy's king.

Declarer now played a diamond to his 9. Ross won the jack and exited with another heart.

Declarer played dummy's ♥Q and Ferro ruffed with the ♣10. Declarer pitched a diamond.

Ferro led the ♠K. Declarer ruffed with the ♣2 and Ross overruffed with the ♣7. He returned the ♣8. Declarer won his ♣A and led the ♦10. Ross won the ♦Q and cashed the ♣Q and ♦A for down six and plus 1400.

At the other table, Martel played the same contract but escaped for down five (minus 1100), earning the team a 7-IMP swing.

The Flight C champs – District 3 representatives Stephen Arsham, North Brunswick NJ; Richard Ross, Highland Park NJ; Feng Liu, New Brunswick NJ; Steve Pessin, East Brunswick NJ, and George Shamy, Cranbury NJ – had an 11-IMP swing on this deal from a semifinal match.

Pessin's decision to "super accept" with only three trumps provided the impetus for Liu's leap to slam. He backed his aggressive bidding with excellent play.

West led his singleton spade, won perforce in dummy. The play went quickly: diamond ruff, spade to dummy, diamond ruff, spade to dummy, diamond ruff. Liu returned to dummy with the ♥A and ruffed another diamond, discovering the 5-3 split. This was the five-card ending:

Liu cashed the ♠J and West was forced to pitch a heart – a discard from either minor-suit holding would spell the end for the defense.

Liu pitched dummy's ♦J and the spotlight turned on East. If East retained his heart guard, Liu could play the ♥K and another heart, forcing East to break clubs. Considering West's opening bid, Liu was unlikely to misguess clubs.

In practice, East discarded a heart and Liu's ♥K-9 were both good.

Note that it would have done East no good to hold hearts. If he had bared the ♣J at any point, Liu could play his ♣Q and pin the jack for his slam-going trick.

At the other table, North-South bid 4♠ and made five for plus 450.

When the auction and your hand tell you that declarer is virtually certain to make his contract, it's time for desperate measures.

Rita Shugart, playing in the IMP Pairs with Brian Glubok, found a lead declarer couldn't fathom – and before he knew it, declarer's cold contract was in the dumper.

Shugart knew her ♣K was poorly placed and that the club suit was likely to be a source of tricks. Setting out to throw sand in declarer's face, Shugart led the ♣8.

Declarer, reading the lead as a singleton, won dummy's ace and set about to establish the club suit by leading the queen. Declarer was somewhat surprised when Glubok followed with the ♣10 – and shocked when Shugart won the king.

Shugart took Glubok's ♣10 play as suit preference for hearts and shifted to the ♥10. Declarer won dummy's ace and, hopeful that Glubok had two clubs and three trumps, played the ♠J.

His plan was to discard a diamond if Glubok refused to ruff, then ruff two diamonds in dummy for his contract. If Glubok had three trumps and ruffed the ♠J, declarer could overruff, play two rounds of trumps, ending in dummy, and discard losing diamonds on the good clubs.

When Glubok followed with the ♣6, declarer knew he had been had. He ruffed high and ruffed two diamonds in dummy. The ♦K Q didn't drop and declarer finished down one.

The result produced plus 15 IMPs for Shugart and Glubok.

From grass roots to national final

Qualifications were earned in the grassroots event earlier this year. Flight B winners will have their names engraved on the Sheinwold Trophy while the names of Flight C winners will be engraved on the MacNab Trophy.

Alfred Sheinwold

Alfred Sheinwold (1912–1997) was one of the greatest bridge writers in the history of the game. He was inducted into the Bridge Hall of Fame in 1996.

His syndicated bridge column was considered by many to be the best – he had a knack for getting his point across to even the least experienced players. He managed this by making sure that every column had only one main point, marking it easier for his readers to focus.

“You could read a Sheinwold column and know in an instant that nobody else could have written it,” said Frank Stewart, co-author of the column. “He enlightened and entertained players through seven decades and earned millions of fans.”

Sheinwold was an editor of *The Bridge World* from 1934 to 1963 and editor of *The Bridge Bulletin* from 1953 to 1958. He was also the author of perhaps the most successful bridge book ever written, *5 Weeks to Winning Bridge*, a book that sold in the millions.

Sheinwold served as chairman of the ACBL Laws Commission from 1964 to 1975, as chairman of the appeals committees at NABCs and as chairman of the ACBL Board of Governors from 1970 to 1973. He was named ACBL *Honorary Member of the Year* in 1983.

Robin Mac Nab

Robin Mac Nab (1915–1985) served as a member of the ACBL Board of Directors from 1956 to 1981. He was ACBL president in 1965. He was a past president of the Western Conference, a member of the ACBL Laws Commission and a member of the executive council of the World Bridge Federation.

Mac Nab, a graduate of Cornell University, was a member of the U.S. Olympic track and field squad in 1936.

Battling for Morehead Trophy

The GNT was originally a North American contest with all 25 ACBL districts participating. Now it is a United States event, with only the 23 U.S. districts participating.

In 1985 the event was subdivided into three separate events. Another change came in 2001 when the GNT Championship Flight -- for players with more than 5,000 masterpoints -- was created. Flight A is now a 0-5000 event.

The winners in each event will have their names engraved on the Morehead Trophy, donated by *The New York Times* in memory of its longtime bridge editor Albert H. Morehead.

Albert H. Morehead

Morehead (1909-1966) was born in Flintstone GA and educated at Baylor and Harvard. Ely Culbertson hired him in 1932 because of his outstanding ability as a player and analyst and made him technical editor of *The Bridge World* in 1933. He proved so invaluable that in 1934 he was made general manager of all Culbertson enterprises. He was only 25 when he played on the Culbertson team that defeated the British in the second international match for the Schwab Cup.

Morehead was the first bridge editor of *The New York Times* with a Sunday column from 1935 and a daily column from 1959. He resigned from the *Times* late in 1963 to devote full time to writing, editing and publishing of the dictionaries, encyclopedias and thesauruses that made him one of the foremost American lexicographers.

During those years, Morehead found time for tremendous service to organized bridge. He was an officer of the United States Bridge Association when that organization amalgamated with the American Bridge League in 1937.

He became a governor of the newly formed ACBL and served as president in 1943 and chairman of the board from 1943 to 1945. He was named *ACBL Honorary Member* in 1946.

Morehead was a member of the National Laws Commission and was in charge of production of the International Laws of Contract Bridge. He was also the author of the constitution of the World Bridge Federation -- the first formal definition of the scope, structure, powers and duties of that organization.

Morehead was named to the ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame in 1996.

Some insight into the man behind all this talent can be found in his obituary in the November 1966 issue of the *Bridge Bulletin*. Editor Dick Frey wrote:

“No one ever saw him lose his temper at the bridge table or heard him speak an unkind word to a partner. He smiled often, but the only player he ever laughed at was himself.

“Rarely if ever did he turn down a plea for help. Writing this, I am proud to acknowledge the debt I owe him and to claim that he was my best friend. The secret of his greatness was that there are scores of others who will truly say exactly this of Albert Hodges Morehead.”

teers. I find them to be loving human beings, always willing to help.”

He is taking action to show the volunteers just how much they are appreciated. He gives certificates of merit and appreciation to outstanding persons wherever he goes. Not a lot of certificates – they go only to those who truly deserve them.

He especially remembers Yuki, a Japanese volunteer who is suffering from cancer. She volunteered to drive George and his wife Mari on a five-hour drive to Penticton, BC. She even prepared a picnic lunch that she served as they stopped in a beautiful spot in a national park.

Retek winces a bit when he thinks of all that has to be done to make the world championships go smoothly. It appears that the European delegation is going to be smaller than originally expected – another result of 9/11. “The host hotels are sold out on certain days, but some still have rooms. They have extended the deadline for applying for rooms to Monday night.” (That’s a change from yesterday’s Bulletin where the deadline was listed as tomorrow night. Retek called the convention bureau and pointed out that Sunday was an unreasonable day since the office is closed on Saturday and Sunday).

“We will welcome everyone who comes to Montreal, whether they have registered in advance or not,” said Retek. He added a reminder than players MUST register at least a day early for any event in which they wish to compete.

Retek is fully aware that the ACBL has an age problem – our members are growing old! “We’re taking action,” he said. “Mini-bridge, which was developed in Europe, is gaining popularity here. Our Bridge at Schools program should help school officials realize that bridge could be a helpful part of the curriculum.” He talked about the work Barbara Heller has done to promote this program. Others who have been active include Gerard Wood, Charity Sack, Beth Maloney-Refaie and David Idleman.

Retek feels that the ACBL is moving forward under the new management – “Jay Baum has some encouraging plans.” However, he feels that the ACBL should get some help from the cities where we hold tournaments. They should provide us with some sort of incentive to interest us in coming to their city.”

He also is hoping for good things from the sponsorship committee, headed by Al Levy. Another committee that may help is the Canadian Affairs Committee under Harriette Buckman as chair. “The purpose of this committee is to facilitate friendly interaction between the Canadian Bridge Federation and the ACBL,” said Retek.

Retek also told us his idea for a replacement for the Retek Knockout Teams – those are events in which you lose in the first round, “like me,” said Retek. On the first day the 16 teams play a Swiss to reduce the field to four teams. Those four play board-a-match in the first session the following day. In the last session, the top two teams play in a KO for first and second place, and the other two teams fight it out for third. The method makes sure that everybody plays a full day each day, rather than being left dangling after losing an afternoon match.

That proves Retek is a bridge player as well as an administrator. Here’s a hand he played recently where he had to come up with a second plan when the first one failed.

Retek and Brian Fraser don’t play transfers – 2♦ was two-way Stayman. East was suggesting a lead

with his 2♥ bid, but his action was turned against him.

West of course opened his singleton heart, won by Retek. He led a diamond, and West ducked in tempo. Retek as a result was quite sure West didn’t have the ♦Q, so he finessed the 8 and was unhappy to see East win the 10. East could have taken his two heart tricks here, but then Retek could score his 10th trick by ruffing a fourth heart with the king. He was quite sure West had the trump queen as a result of East’s overcall.

East, Bill Preble, saw the problem and returned his second diamond instead of cashing hearts. Retek took the ace, cashed the ♠K and passed the ♠J. He continued with a spade to the ace and cashed the ♣A. He crossed to the ♦K and put West in with the ♦Q. West was able to cash the ♣K, but then had to give Retek his 10th trick with the ♣Q.

What if East had cashed one heart before shifting back to diamonds? “I would have won and led the ♠J following by a finesse to the ♠10. That would remove East’s last trump, so now I would get out with a heart. East would not be able to prevent me from ruffing the fourth heart with the king for my game.”

ACBL allows the use of Braille cards, but they must be supplied by the player who requests their use, so Timanus and Hertz created several of the special decks.

Modifying game components to allow Timanus to participate is nothing new to Hertz. “When we were younger, we played all kinds of board games, but the trick was to find ways to include Eddie,” he said. The group even came up with their own name for the process — “Eddie-fying”.

“Eddie-fying a game requires imagination, but we always came up with a solution, even for games like football,” said Hertz. Their football solution was to make Timanus the quarterback for *both* teams, so that the real strategy lay in which side could best plan the blind player’s pass attempts during the huddle.

Timanus was able to parlay his love of games and trivia into multiple *Jeopardy* championships. In 1999, Timanus won five days in a row on the popular game show earning \$69,700. He was invited back to play in the program’s Tournament of Champions (open only to other strong contenders) later that year, and made it to the semifinal round to earn another \$5000.

With all of his accomplishments, Timanus has recently added one more. He was married two weeks ago to his girlfriend, Kelli.

“Even though I’m a newlywed, I do have my wife’s permission to be here. She’s not a bridge widow yet!”

Timanus and Hertz will continue to play this weekend and next weekend.

Slow Play

Slow play, as opposed to careful or thoughtful play, is discourteous to your opponents – and to all other competitors as well. Players and pairs who take more than their allotted time are subject to penalty. In general, pairs who are rarely late will be warned while pairs who are habitually tardy and/or pay no attention to time limits will be penalized.

Play Misty For Me

When you’ve flown over from London the day before, sometimes the play becomes a little rusty. Alas, I can recall all the details subsequently — its just getting them right at the time that’s the problem.

I was South. The auction went 3♥ by North, 3♠ by East. In retrospect I don’t think my jump to 5♥ was totally silly — I wanted to sacrifice over a club slam but I was happy to defend spades. When my left-hand opponent jumped confidently to 6♠ I thought for some time before sticking with my original decision.

Now it was up to me to lead. I settled for a mundane heart and conceded 1430. Of course 7♣ (or an unlikely 7NT) can’t be set, but if I had led a diamond against 6♥ declarer (Grant Baze) might still be thinking....

Only my initial misplay made this deal interesting. I opened 1NT as South and played there on a diamond lead to my 10. West ducked the ♦K and won the third round of diamonds to play a fourth diamond as East pitched two spades. It should have been obvious to me to pitch a club and run the ♣Q — but blame the jet lag.

I actually pitched a club and led a spade to the queen and king. Back came a spade and I realized I did not have the entries for a club finesse — a third spade would block the entries. Still, the ♣A and another club would have been quite enough to collect plus 150.

But I missed that too. Instead I cashed the rest of the spades. This was the position on the fourth round:

But all West has to do is to pitch a heart in the ending. Now when I throw a heart from the dummy to play the ♥A and another heart, East can overtake and cash a heart and I still have a club to lose. Perhaps West was jet-lagged too.
